Formation of Yoga Commission in Madhya Pradesh

- Yoga Commission will be set up in Madhya Pradesh.
- The work of education of yoga will be carried out in the form of a campaign, along with its guidance will be received from experts and experienced yogacharyas associated with the science of yoga.
- Yoga will also be included in the activities of the Sports Department.

"PESA Act" implemented in Madhya Pradesh

- This Act is being implemented to strengthen the Gram Sabhas in the scheduled areas of the state in the provisions of the notification.

- Forest dwellers residing in the state, whose possession of forest rights before December 2006 have not yet been given, they will be given a forest rights lease. For this, a campaign will be launched again in the state. No tribal will be deprived of their rights anymore.

- Tribal people who do not have a pucca house to live in, will be given a land lease to build a house.
 - No tribal brother will live on the soil of Madhya Pradesh without land or house. For this, the government will implement the Chief Minister's Residential Land Rights Scheme.
 - Under the Mukhyamantri Udyami Kranti Yojana, a loan of up to Rs 50 lakh will be given to the youth for setting up industries.
 - In this loan, the government will also give guarantee to the banks and 3 percent subsidy on interest will also be given.
 - Under the Akanksha scheme, the fees of the children who are selected in IIT, Medical and Law will be waived.
 - Centers for counseling of tribal students will be opened in Jabalpur, Bhopal, Indore.
- Compensation for resettlement of villages from protected forest areas increased from 10 to 15 lakh per family
- An amount of 75 crores was sanctioned for five years for the "Compensation" scheme for the rehabilitation of villages.
 - Approval of Rs 285 crore for the financial year 2022-23 to 2025-26 from CAMPA item was also approved.

Postal Service Award Ceremony

- The Governor addressed the Postal Service Award-2021 function of Madhya Pradesh Postal Circle at Dr. Shankar Dayal Sharma Auditorium of Dak Bhawan.

Ken-Betwa Link Project

- The Chief Ministers of Madhya Pradesh and Uttar Pradesh signed a historic agreement on 22 March 2021 to implement the Ken-Betwa project.
- This agreement was made to initiate inter-state cooperation to implement the vision of former Prime Minister Late Shri Atal Bihari Vajpayee.

- This project is the first ambitious project of the National Perspective Plan for interlinking of rivers.
- Its purpose is to transfer the surplus water of Ken river of Madhya Pradesh to Betwa river to provide irrigation facility in the drought-prone Bundelkhand region of Uttar Pradesh.
- The cost of the project is Rs 44 lakh 605 crore.
- Chhatarpur, Tikamgarh, Panna, Sagar, Damoh, Datia, Vidisha, Shivpuri and Raisen districts of Madhya Pradesh and Banda, Mahoba, Jhansi and Lalitpur districts of Uttar Pradesh will be benefited by this project.
- With the implementation of this project, the Bundelkhand region will reduce drought conditions, increase power generation, agricultural regeneration, sufficient water to irrigate farmers, and restore biodiversity.
- On the other hand, the central government has taken this decision keeping political differences separate. And the government has also taken into account the environmental factors for the successful implementation of this project, so that there is no damage to the forest wealth.

Education hub will be made in Datia

- Medical College, Nursing College, Polytechnic, Veterinary and Physicians College as well as Police Training Center will be started in Datia.
- With this, the building of the Law College will be built at a cost of seven crores.
- Boating will also start in the Vote Club located at Lala's Tal.

National Energy Conservation Week

- From December 14 to December 21, in the entire Bhopal region and Gwalior region, MP. National Energy Conservation Week was celebrated under the aegis of Madhya Kshetra Vidyut Vitran Company.
- Under this, in the painting competition of school children, pictures were engraved by the school children in relation to the Energy Conservation and Remedy App (Upay App).
