- Which institution has entered into an agreement with United Nations World Food Program (WFP) to address issues related to inclusion of millets in government programmes _____ NITI Aayog. Note:
 - ➤ The partnership focuses on mainstreaming of millets and supporting India in taking lead globally in knowledge exchange using the opportunity of 2023 as an International Year of Millets.
 - Further, the partnership will aim at building resilient livelihoods for small-holder farmers and adaptation capacities to climate change and transforming food systems.
- 2. What amount has been announced by the World Bank to help the poorest countries respond to the raging

Coronavirus (Covid-19) crisis and boost economic growth ______\$93 billion.

Note:

- It was the biggest replenishment ever for the International Development Association (IDA), which provides grants for 74 countries
- The package includes \$23.5 billion of contributions from 48 high and middle-income countries as well as financing raised in the capital markets
- > It will help countries better prepare for future crises.
- **3.** Hero Electric has tied up with which non-banking financial company (NBFC), to offer easy financing options for the purchase of electric scooters _____ HDB Financial Services.

Note:

 - The 3-year partnership with Udemy Business will offer courses on in-demand skills such as tech, domain, behavioural, and leadership skills to all NPCI employees.
 - Through the mission 'Talent Development for All' of NPCI, it provides capacity building programmes in Artificial Intelligence (AI), Machine Learning (ML), Blockchain, Distributed Ledger Technology (DLT), Robotic Process Automation (RPA), etc.
- 5. Which bank has signed a Memorandum of Understanding (MoU) with Care Health Insurance Ltd to market health insurance products for customers of the bank _____ Karnataka Vikas Grameena Bank. Note:
 - > Under the partnership, the bank focuses on its rural customers by covering maximum people, including farmers, artisans and rural population under health insurance.
 - The bank was also working on a tailor-made product to suit farmers and Kisan Credit Cardholders to face challenges arising out of illness and hospitalisation, through products at an affordable premium.

- It was felicitated by the Ministry of Electronics & Information Technology (MeitY) at the Digital Payments Utsav which was held to commemorate the 75th anniversary of the Independence of India.
- BoB has been conferred with five DigiDhan awards for FY 2019-20 & 2020-21 in various categories.
- 8. Which bank has acquired a minority stake in JSW Cement Limited for an investment of INR 100 crore through Compulsory Convertible Preference Shares (CCPS) _____ State Bank of India.

Note:

- The SBI is working as a strategic investor at JSW Cement and has invested in the company through CCPS. The conversion of CCPS into common equity will link with the JSW Group to provide valuation determined at the time initi qal public offering (IPO).
- This amount will support the expansion of JSW Cement from taking its production from the current 14 MTPA (million tonnes per annum) to 25 MTPA.
- 9. With which public sector bank has the MSME lending fintech platform, U GRO Capital signed a co-lending agreement **Central Bank of India.**

Note:

- Under this partnership, the two entities aim to disburse up to Rs 1000 crore to U GRO Capital's varied MSME segments under its programmes like Pratham, Sanjeevani, Saathi, GRO MSME and Machinery financing, in the next 12 months.

 - With this partnership, MoneyGram users abroad can now conveniently transfer money to full KYC Paytm wallet users in India from the comfort of their homes.
- Government of India has signed an agreement with which bank for a Finance Contract for the first tranche loan of Euro 250 million for Agra Metro Rail Project _____ European Investment Bank.

Note:

- The Project is working under the Ministry of Housing and Urban Affairs (MoHUA) and Uttar Pradesh Metro Rail Corporation Ltd. (UPMRCL) is the implementing agency.
- The project aims to provide a safe, reliable, affordable and environment-friendly public Mass Rapid Transit System for Agra city which will improve mobility and support endeavour for planned urban development in Agra.
- 12. State-owned Rural Electrification Corporation (REC) Ltd has signed a pact with which bank to avail USD 169.5 million to the power finance sector and renewable energy projects ______ KfW Development Bank.
 Note:

Note:

- Both organisations will jointly undertake various projects in Power sector & Renewable Energy (RE) projects.
- > The approval was passed by the Department of Economic Affairs, Ministry of Finance.
- > This is the fifth line of credit signed between KfW Bank and REC Limited to finance power sector projects and the third line of credit for financing renewable energy (RE) projects.

Note:

- > It is the first Indian bank to go live on UPI for cross-border payments/NRI remittances.
- Under this arrangement, the MTOs will be using the IndusInd Bank channel to connect with NPCI's UPI payment systems for validation and cross-border payment settlement into beneficiary accounts.
- 17. Which bank has entered into a co-lending arrangement with Lendingkart Finance Limited to improve the flow of credit to the unserved and underserved sector of the economy _____ Punjab National Bank.
 Note:
 - This partnership is part of its efforts to improve the flow of credit to the unserved and underserved sector of the economy.

 - e-RUPI will be used to ensure a leak-proof delivery of education fees of eligible students by paying digitally to the college/institute by Karnataka Government.
 - Karnataka government will get e-vouchers delivered to the mobiles of eligible students. The voucher code can be received on the feature phone also.
- **27.** RBL Bank announced the signing of an agreement with which Non-Banking Financial Companies (NBFCs) to for the extension of the partnership of co-branded credit cards for 5 years to December 2026 _____ Bajaj Finance Ltd. Note:
 - In FY2018, the Bank had entered into a partnership with Bajaj Finance, launching a series of co-branded credit cards.
 - As per the Bank's FY2019 annual report, FY2019 also saw the RBL Bank Bajaj Finance co-brand portfolio cross the 10 lakh cards mark, making it one of the largest co-branded card partnerships in the country.

- Further, card users can withdraw up to ₹75,000 at ATMs abroad and perform purchases globally worth up to ₹3 lakh at POS and international online merchants.

1. Renowned personality Richard Rogers passed away recently, he was a veteran _____ Architect.



- He was known for designing some of the world's most famous buildings including Paris' Pompidou Centre in 1977.
- He changed London skyline with distinctive creations such as Millennium Dome and 'Cheesegrater', that won a series of awards for his designs, including the 2007 Pritzker Prize, and is one of the pioneers of the 'high-tech' architecture movement.
- 2. Nobel Peace Prize Winner Renowned personality Desmond Tutu passed away recently he was a veteran ______ Human Right Activist.

Note:

- Tutu was diagnosed with prostate cancer in the late 1990s and in recent years he was hospitalized on several occasions to treat infections associated with his cancer treatment.
- > In 1984 Tutu won the Nobel Peace Prize for his non-violent opposition to apartheid.
- 3. Renowned personality Karolos Papoulias was former president of which country who passed away recently _____ Greece.

Note:

- Papoulias, who was also foreign minister in 1985-89 and 1993-96, was a high-ranking member of socialist PASOK party and a close associate of its late leader and former prime minister Andreas Papandreou.
- He served as President during the crisis that plunged the country into the most grave political and economic turmoil of recent decades.
- **4.** Renowned personality T. Mark Taylor passed away recently he was a veteran _____ **artist.** Note:
 - > He-man was the muscled frontman for toy manufacturer Mattel's Masters of the Universe franchise
 - He-Man was the epitome of hulking superhero warrior but also became an icon within the LGBTQ+ community, who saw parallels in the secret life of Prince Adam, He-Man's alter ego.
- Renowned parliamentarian and industrialist Mahendra Prasad passed away recently he was seven time Rajya Sabha MP from which political party _____ Janata Dal (United).

Note:

- > Prasad was a seven-term Rajya Sabha MP from Bihar and was also elected to the Lok Sabha once.
- Prasad was first elected to the Lok Sabha on a Congress ticket in 1980.
- He remained associated with the party for a long time and shifted his loyalties later as its fortunes declined in the state.
- 6. Renowned personality Edward O Wilson passed away recently, he was a noted _____ biologist. Note:
 - He was "called 'Darwin's natural heir,' and was known affectionately as 'the ant man' for his pioneering work as an entomologist.
 - > He was a true visionary with a unique ability to inspire and galvanize.
 - > He articulated, perhaps better than anyone, what it means to be human.

7. Renowned personality Keri Hulme passed away recently, she was a note _____ **novelist.**

Note:

- Hulme worked as a tobacco picker, dropped out of law school and was a charity worker before becoming an unusual literary star when The Bone People, her first novel, won one of fiction's greatest prizes.
- The novel was rejected by several publishers before being picked up by the obscure publisher Spiral, a New Zealand feminist collective.
- 8. Renowned personality Sabine Weis passed away recently, she was a veteran _____ photographer. Note:
 - Weiss was the last of the French humanist photography school of post-World War II that reimagined the evocative powers of images, which included Robert Doisneau, Willy Ronis and Brassai.

1. Which ministry has launched the Open Acreage Licensing Programme (OALP) Bid Round-VII for International Competitive Bidding ______ Ministry of Petroleum.



- > Eight blocks are being bid out under the round.
- These include five on-land blocks (four in Category-I Basin and one in Category-III Basin), two shallow water blocks (both in Category-I Basin) and one ultra-deep-water block (Category-I Basin).
- "It is expected that OALP Round VII would generate an immediate exploration work commitment of around \$ 300-400 million.
- 2. The Central Public Health and Environmental Engineering Organisation (CPHEEO) organized a "Technical Conference cum Exhibition on 24x7 Water Supply Systems" in which city _____ New Delhi.

Note:

- > Organized by: Central Public Health and Environmental Engineering Organisation (CPHEEO)
