Why in News:

• The Operations Manual of Beti Bachao Beti Padhao has been released by Union Minister Smriti Irani.



key points:

- Under the Beti Bachao, Beti Padhao programme, the Central Government has announced to include the skills of girls in non-traditional livelihood (NTL) options.
- The Beti Bachao, Beti Padhao scheme will now also focus on increasing the enrollment of girls in secondary education, especially in STEM (Science, Technology, Engineering, Maths) subjects.



 The initiative aims to ensure that teens complete their education, build skills, and enter the workforce in a wide variety of occupations, including STEM fields.

key points:

- On October 11, 1902, Loknayak Jayaprakash Narayan was born in Sitabdiara, Bihar.
- The socialist cry of Loknayak Jayaprakash Narayan, who was the personification of sacrifice, is being echoed today.
- No movement can succeed, in the opinion of Loknayak Jayaprakash Narayan, without the backing of the middle class.
- At the Gandhi Maidan in Patna, Loknayak Jayaprakash Narayan recited another well-known catchphrase: "Take away caste-paat, leave tilak-dowry, redirect the flow of society in a new path."

CJI UU Lalit recommends Justice DY Chandrachud as the next Chief Justice of India

Why in News:

 Justice DY Chandrachud has been recommended by the Chief Justice of India UU Lalit as the next Chief Justice of India.



key points:

- Chief Justice Lalit's recommendation to the government will start the process of appointing Justice Chandrachud as the 50th Chief Justice of India.
- If approved by the government, Justice Chandrachud will be the first second-generation Chief Justice.



Justice Chandrachud's father, Justice Y.V. Chandrachud was the 16th Chief
Justice and also one of the longest serving Chief Justices.


