

NMAT Analysis 2021 - 14

October 2021

NMAT 2021 test-taking window opened on October 14, 2021. NMAT 2021 had 108 questions in total spread over 3 sections – each containing 36 questions. The topic-wise questions in each of the sections show variation for each of the students. In this detailed NMAT analysis article, we will discuss the following aspects:

Overall, the difficulty level of NMAT 2021 was MODERATE in terms of the questions asked. However, it also depends on the ability of the candidate, as NMAT 2021 is a “Computer-Adaptive” exam. All these sections have been modified in accordance with different parameters.

Important Highlights of NMAT 2021 Exam

- The number of questions remained the same as last year, i.e., 108 questions (36 questions in each of the sections)
- NMAT 2021 has an 88-day test window starting from October 14, 2021, and ending December 27, 2021.
- Similar to last time, candidates can take the exam online or by visiting the exam centres.

The topic-wise compartmentalization was in accordance with the sample test published on the website.

Expected NMAT Cut Off 2021

For NMAT 2021, the expected cut-offs for NMIMS Mumbai are expected to be 232 - 238 (something similar to what we have seen in NMAT 2020). The sectional cut-offs for the same are expected to be 78- 82 for Language Skills, 74-77 for Logical Reasoning & 73-76 for Quantitative Skills. For the Bangalore and Hyderabad campus of NMIMS, the overall cut-off is expected to be 220+ and 225+ respectively while other colleges accepting NMAT scores shall be around 205+.
