India Ranking in Different Indexes 2022: Latest Reports

India's performance in the Global Indices Ranking is variable. With a ranking of 112 out of 182, India's standing in the Global Kids Right Index increased by 1 position. Similarly, here are some of the latest reports on **India ranking in different indexes**:

- Recently, the Global Innovation Index (GII) 2022 was announced by the World Intellectual Property Organization (WIPO). India is ranked 40th in the index. India was ranked 46th in the Global Innovation Index for 2021, a leap of 6 positions. In the GI 2022, Switzerland was ranked first.
- Mumbai (127) is listed as the most costly city in India for hiring foreign workers, followed by New Delhi (155), Chennai (177), Bengaluru (178), and Hyderabad (189). Kolkata (203) and Pune (201) are the least costly Indian cities in terms of cost of living.
- The European Intelligence Unit (EUI) released its Global Liveability Index Report 2022. The EUI assessed 173 locations worldwide in its Global Liveability Index 2022. The rating is based on five criteria: infrastructure, education, culture and environment, stability, and healthcare.
- Ookla, a provider of network data and connectivity insights, published the Speedtest Global Index. Norway and Singapore are ranked first for fixed broadband speeds (209.21 Mbps) and global mobile speeds (129.40 Mbps, respectively) in the May Speedtest Global Index.
- An extensive analysis of skills worldwide may be found in the Coursera Global Skills Report 2022. India's overall skills competency is now ranked 68th globally, down four spots from its previous position. India is now ranked 19th in Asia.
- IMD is committed to creating leaders who transform businesses and benefit society. India has experienced the fastest growth among the Asian economies, moving six spots from position 43 to 37, partly due to improvements in economic performance. Denmark has risen to the top of the 63-nation list from third place last year, Switzerland dropped to second place from first, and Singapore moved back up to the third place from fifth.

- The country is ranked according to its environmental performance and sustainability using the Environment Performance Assessment, a biennial index. India received a score of 18.9, placing it 180th overall in the Environmental Policy Index 2022. India is ranked lower than Pakistan, Bangladesh, Viet Nam, Myanmar (19.4), and Bangladesh (23.1). Denmark tops the list with a score of 77.9, followed by the United Kingdom (77.7) and Finland (76.5).
- German-watch, Climate Action Network (CAN), and New Climate Institute issued the Climate Change Performance Index (CCPI) 2022. For the second year in a row, India has remained one of the top 10 nations with the best climate performance.

Index	Parameters
Press Freedom Index	Based on a count of violations against journalists and media outlets and the responses of "press freedom specialists" to an RSF questionnaire.
Environmental Performance Index (EPI)	The ranking uses 40 metrics with criteria for reducing global warming, enhancing environmental safety, and preserving ecosystem vitality.
Global Hunger Index	Undernourishment, Child wasting, Child stunting, Child mortality.
Global Gender Gap Index	Economic participation and opportunity, Educational Attainment, Health and survival, Political empowerment.
Global Climate Risk Index	It examines how much weather-related loss events, like storms, floods, etc., have impacted various nations.
Corruption Perceptions Index	Perceived levels of corruption in the public sector.

India Ranking in Different Indexes 2022 for UPSC: Summary

We have provided the complete list of **India ranking in different indexes 2022** from which a UPSC aspirant can prepare for their current affair section. The most liveable city in the world is Vienna, the capital of Austria, according to this year's edition of the EIU's Global Liveability Ranking. In contrast, Damascus, the capital of Syria, has the least livable cities out of the 173 nations examined.

According to the United Nations Conference on Trade and Development, India rose one spot to seventh place among the top recipients of foreign direct investment (FDI) in the most recent calendar year (2021), despite a decline in FDI inflows into the nation. With a score of 18.9, India is ranked 180th, behind Vietnam, Bangladesh, Pakistan, and Myanmar, the bottom five countries with the worst environmental health records. The US, Spain, France, Germany, Switzerland, Austria, UK, Singapore, and Italy round out the top ten, with Japan at the top of the global charts.

According to the most recent report from international media watchdog Reporters Without Borders, India's ranking in the 2022 World Press Freedom Index has dropped to 150 out of 180 nations (RSF). India dropped five spots from 77th to 82nd in 2021 on a global ranking assessing the likelihood of business bribery. The results for this year show that the countries with the highest risk of commercial bribery are North Korea, Turkmenistan, Venezuela, and Eritrea. In contrast, the countries with the lowest risk are Denmark, Norway, Finland, Sweden, and New Zealand.
