International Relations

WHO releases first-ever list of health-threatening fungi

Why in News:

 A report has been published by WHO that highlights the first list of fungal "priority pathogens" – a list of 19 fungi that represent the greatest threat to public health.



key points:

- The WHO Fungal Priority Infections List (FPPL) is the first global initiative to systematically prioritize fungal pathogens, taking into account perceived public health importance and non-research and development (R&D) needs.
- In order to boost the international response to fungi infections and antifungal resistance, the WHO FPPL seeks to direct and motivate more research and policy measures.
- The majority of fungal diseases lack quick and accurate diagnostics, and those that do exist are neither widely accessible nor reasonably priced on a worldwide scale.
- Critically sick patients and those with major underlying immune systemrelated disorders frequently have invasive versions of these fungi infections.
- Those who have cancer, HIV/AIDS, organ transplants, chronic respiratory diseases, and primary tuberculosis infections are most at risk for developing invasive fungal infections.
- WHO has ranked the pathogens and divided them into three priority groups (critical, high and moderate).
- The involved pathogens were ranked and then divided into three priority categories (severe, high and moderate).
- Aspergillus fumigatus, Candida Auris, Cryptococcus neoformans, and Candida albicans are among the significant organisms included in the WHO report.

A Special meeting of the UNSC Counter-Terrorism Committee

Why in News:

• The UNSC Counter-Terrorism Committee will have a special meeting in India.

Key Points:

- The UNSC's two-day counterterrorism summit in India will take place on October 28 and 29, respectively, in Mumbai and Delhi.
- The Anti-Terrorism Committee (CTC) is gathering outside of New York for the eighth time this year.
- In July 2015, the Anti-Terrorism Committee convened its final extraordinary gathering outside from the UN building in Madrid, Spain.
- At this meeting, which will take place in Mumbai, the victims of the terrorist attacks of 26/11 will be remembered.
- On the topic of "Combating the use of new and emerging technologies for terrorist goals," a special meeting will be held in New Delhi.
- The seminar will pay particular attention to three topics: unmanned aerial systems, financing of terrorism, and the internet and social media.
- Additionally, emerging technologies like cryptocurrencies will be covered at the seminar.
- The purpose of the special meetings is to bring together government representatives, representatives from multilateral organizations, think tanks, and independent specialists to debate issues relating to terrorism.
- Foreign ministers from the UK, UAE, Ghana, Albania, and other nations will attend the summit.
- A division of the United Nations Security Council, the UNSC Counter-Terrorism Committee was founded in 2001 in the wake of the 9/11 attacks in the United States (UNSC).
- The 15-member UNSC Counter-Terrorism Committee was established to carry out a United Nations resolution that makes it illegal to assist terrorist activities and prohibits providing member nations with financial aid or safe haven for terrorists.

"The Coldest Year of the Rest of Their Leaves" Report

Why in News:

 A report titled "The Coldest Year of the Rest of Their Leaves" has been released by the United Nations International Children's Emergency Fund (UNICEF).



key points:

- In the report, for the first time, UNICEF estimated how many children could be exposed to 4 measures of heatwave (high heatwave frequency, high heatwave duration, high heatwave severity and extremely high temperature) by the year 2050.
- The Coldest Year of the Rest of Their Leaves report assessed them on the basis of a "low greenhouse gas emission scenario" and a "very high greenhouse gas emission scenario" (2.4 °C warming).
- According to the report, climate change-induced heat waves could become an inevitable threat that would be able to affect every child on Earth.
- Currently, at least 559 million children experience four to five dangerous heat waves each year.
- According to The Coldest Year of the Rest of Their Leaves report, children are more vulnerable to extreme heat events than adults.
- According to the report, extreme atmospheric heat could result in drought, which would hinder access to clean drinking water and healthy food.
- The United Nations Children's Fund (UNICEF) is a unique UN program that supports national initiatives to enhance children's health, nutrition, education, and general welfare.
- In order to aid children impacted by World War II, the United Nations Relief Rehabilitation Administration established the International Children's Emergency Fund (ICEF) in 1946.

Diwali To Be a Public School Holiday in New York City from 2023

Why in News:

 According to the announcement released by New York Mayor Eric Adams, Diwali will be a public-school holiday in New York City from 2023.



key points:

- New York's mayor announced plans to include the holiday in the public-school schedule at a press conference with state legislature member Jennifer Prince and Education Department Chancellor David Banks.
- The aim of the government is to encourage children to know about the festival of lights.
- In the past few years, there has been a demand from hundreds of thousands of Hindu communities living in New York to declare Diwali as a school holiday.
- According to the Diwali holiday bill at New York City Public Schools, instead of Anniversary Day, Diwali will be a school holiday.
- Anniversary Day has been celebrated since the year 1829, on which a holiday was made in the schools in the mid-1900s.
- Every year on Anniversary Day, the first Thursday of June was a holiday in schools.

Asia's largest Compressed Biogas plant

Why in News:

 Asia's largest Compressed Biogas (CBG) plant has been inaugurated by Union Petroleum and Natural Gas Minister Hardeep Singh Puri at Lehragaga, Punjab.



- Compressed Biogas (CBG) plant at Lehragaga has been constructed on 20 acres of land at a cost of Rs 230 crore.
- The project has been commissioned by Foreign Direct Investment (FDI) of Verbid AG.









- The Compressed Biogas Plant is currently capable of processing 6 tons of paddy straw each day.
- The capacity of the Compressed Biogas Plant will later be increased to 300 tons of paddy straw per day to produce 33 TPD of compressed biogas using eight digesters of 10,000 cubic meters each.
- The CBG plant will consume 100,000 tons of paddy straw, which will be procured from 6 to 8 satellite locations within a 10 km radius of the plant.
- Every day 600-650 tons of FOM (Fermented Organic Manure) will be produced from the Compressed Biogas Plant which will be used for organic farming.
- The government aims to reduce carbon dioxide emissions by 150,000 tons each year from the compressed biogas plant.
- The SATAT scheme was launched by the Government of India in 2018 to set up CBG production plants in the country through potential investors.
- CBG can be used for automotive sector
- Compressed Biogas (CBG) is produced naturally through the process of anaerobic decomposition of biomass sources like crop residues, cattle dung, sugarcane press soil, sewage treatment plant waste etc.

14th World Spice Congress

Why in News:

 The 14th edition of the World Spice Congress will be held in Mumbai, Maharashtra from 16 to 18 February next year.

- The World Spice Congress (WSC) is a grouping of the global spice industry to create a forum to improve understanding of the situation and challenges of the spice sector.
- The World Spice Congress was first organized in the year 1990, since then, 13 editions have been organized in the last 30 years.
- The 14th edition of the event will be organized by Spices Board of India, which works under the aegis of Union Ministry of Commerce and Industry.









- The theme of the 14th World Spice Congress is "Vision 2030: Spices (Sustainability - Productivity - Innovation - Collaboration - Excellence and Safety)".
- This biennial event will focus on trade, sustainability, quality and food safety initiatives, recent developments, concerns and prospects of the spice industry.
- The 14th World Spice Congress will be attended by about 1,000 delegates from more than 50 countries.
- The goal of the 14th World Spice Congress is to promote new business opportunities and promote trade relations by showcasing the potential of the Indian spice industry.
- Spices Board of India is a regulatory and export promotion body for Indian spices.
- Spices Board of India was established in the year 1987 under the Spices Board Act, 1986 to promote the production and development of cardamom and export of other species mentioned under the Schedule of the Act.
- The Spices Board of India is headquartered in Kochi, Kerala.

Global status report on physical activity 2022

Why in News:

• The Global Status Rep<mark>ort 2022 on Physical Activity has been released by the World Health Organization.</mark>

- According to the report released by the World
 Health Organization, lack of exercise and
 healthy physical activity can cost the world's governments more than USD 27
 billion each year.
- According to the World Health Organization report, less than half of the 194 countries have a solid national policy in place to promote physical activity.
- According to the report, less than 30 percent of children under the age of 5 have supervised physical activity.
- According to the report, the number of cases of diabetes, dementia and hypertension is expected to increase by the end of this decade.
- The report recommends governments to actively encourage citizens to adopt a healthy lifestyle to prevent the occurrence of these diseases in the future.









- In the wake of the COVID-19 pandemic, healthcare costs around the world have risen and this trend is expected to continue in the future.
- According to the report, cost-effective actions such as exercise significantly reduce these expenses.
- According to the report, despite evidence of economic, social and environmental benefits associated with exercise and physical activity, there has been little attention by governments to raising awareness of them to the general public.

Freedom House: India's internet freedom improves after 4 years downturn

divide in the country.

Why in News:

 According to the US governmentfunded NGO Freedom House, India's Internet freedom score has risen two points to 51 in the overall rankings, following the initiative to close the digital

- According to the report, the low frequency and intensity of nationwide internet outages have also contributed to the improvement in India's overall score.
- The Information Technology (Intermediate Guidelines and Digital Media Code of Conduct) Rules, 2021, among other laws allowing the government to censor online content, have reportedly been challenged in court, leading to restrictions on certain powers of the government has given.
- According to a US government-funded NGO, world internet freedom was at a standstill for the 12th year in a row, with the biggest declines in Russia, Myanmar, Sudan and Libya.
- According to the report, China had the worst internet freedom situation in the world for the eighth year in a row, while internet freedom in the United States has recovered for the first time in six years.
- In Washington, DC, a non-profit organization called Freedom House conducts research and works for political freedom, democracy, and human rights.
- Wendell Wilkie and Eleanor Roosevelt served as the organization's first honorary president in October 1941.









- The Freedom House organization has regional offices in several countries, including Ukraine, Hungary, Serbia, Jordan, Mexico, and the nations of Central Asia.
- The Freedom House organization's main office is located in Washington, DC.

- Sarang Festival of India in the Republic of Korea as a part of the festival, an attempt is made to showcase India's rich cultural diversity through various art forms including dance, drama, music, films and cuisine.
- This festival has been organized every year since 2015 in collaboration with various local bodies.
- Sarang The festival of India in the Republic of Korea aims to introduce the people of Korea to Indian dance, music, film, cuisine and art.
- Sarang has become a much-awaited event in the Korean cultural calendar at present, which is held for more than a month.

22nd World Blockchain Summit Begins in Dubai

Why in News:

• The World Blockchain Summit in Dubai will be held at Atlantis, The Palm on October 17 and 18, 2022.

key points:

- It is one of the most exclusive conferences of the global crypto and blockchain ecosystem.
- The 22nd Global Edition of the World Blockchain Summit aims to bring together some of the world's leading crypto influencers, policy makers, key government representatives, media, family offices, HNIs and other curated investors to promote the crypto and blockchain community in the world.



- Blockchain technology is a technology that leads to a series of blocks containing digital information stored in a public database.
- Blockchain technology is a distributed database existing on multiple computers at the same time, which is constantly growing as new sets of blocks are recorded or added to it.
- Blockchain consists of three important concepts, which include blocks, nodes and miners.
- Each chain consists of several blocks and each block has three basic elements.
- When the first block of a chain is created, generates a non-cryptographic hash.
- The data in the block is assumed to be signed and is forever associated with nonce and hash until it is mined.
- Miners create new blocks on the chain through a process called mining.
- When a block is successfully mined, the change is accepted by all nodes on the network and the miner is rewarded financially.
- One of the most important concepts in blockchain technology is decentralization.
- Each node has its own copy of the blockchain, and the network has to algorithmically approve any newly mined blocks in order to update, trust and verify the chain.

2022 Mercer CFA Institute Global Pension Index survey (MCGPI)

Why in News:

 The 2022 Mercer CFA Institute Global Pension Index Survey (MCGPI) has been released.

key points:

- Iceland tops the list with the highest composite index value of 84.7.
- The Netherlands (84.6) and Denmark (82.0) are in second and third place respectively.
- Thailand is the worst performer in the index, with an overall value of 41.7.
- India ranks 41 out of 44 countries in the index, while in the previous edition, India was ranked 40 out of 43 countries.
- There has been a slight improvement in the overall index value by India with an increase of 44.4 in the year 2022 from 43.3 in the year 2021.
- India scores 33.5, 41.8 and 61.0 in the three sub-indices in adequacy, stability and integrity, respectively.
- According to the report, the regulatory framework may be strengthened to make private pension plans more reliable in India.
- According to the report, the implementation of the Labor Code will increase
 access to social security for the unorganized workers, who constitute 95 per
 cent of the total Indian workforce.
- The MCGPI assesses the pension system in various countries of the world.
- The MCGPI benchmarks retirement income systems, highlights the shortcomings of each of these systems, and provides recommendations for ensuring adequate and sustainable retirement benefits.

DefExpo 2022: India-Africa Defence Dialogue to be held in Gandhinagar

Why in News:

 DefExpo 2022 India-Africa Defense Dialogue was held on 18 October in Gandhinagar, Gujarat.











key points:

- The theme of DefExpo 2022 is 'India-Africa: synergy and adoption of strategies to strengthen defense and security cooperation'.
- India's approach to Africa is guided by the Kampala Principles enunciated by Prime Minister Shri Narendra Modi in 2018.
- The Kampala Principles promote the ownership of private sector partnerships (PSEs) through development cooperation by partner countries and ensure the alignment of PSE projects and programs with national sustainable development priorities.
- The first ever India Africa Defense Ministers Conclave (IADMC) was held on February 6, 2020 in Lucknow, Uttar Pradesh in conjunction with the DefExpo.
- The conclave was the first in a series of pan-Africa events at the ministerial level in the order of the India-Africa Forum Summit IV.
- During this conclave, a joint declaration called 'Lucknow Declaration' was adopted as the outcome document of the conclave.
- India and Africa share close and historical ties, the foundation of defense ties between the two countries is based on two guiding principles namely 'Sagar' (Security and Growth for All in the Region) and 'Vasudhaiva Kutumbakam'.

India to host 90th General Assembly of INTERPOL

Why in News:

 This year, from October 18 to 21, India will host the 90th General Assembly of the International Criminal Police Organization in New Delhi.

Key Points:

- The Interpol General Assembly is being held in India for the first time in 25 years.
- Amit Shah, the union home minister, put out the idea in 2019 to commemorate the 75th anniversary of Indian Independence.
- The 195 member states are represented in the General Assembly, which is Interpol's highest governing body.
- Interpol meets once a year with the Chief of Police and senior Ministry officials in attendance to foster collaboration among all police officers toward the prevention and repression of common crimes worldwide.









- The Interpol General Assembly's goal is to decide on the guidelines and strategies the organization will use to accomplish its goals.
- During the Interpol General Assembly, prominent law enforcement officers get the chance to exchange experiences and best practices.
- International collaboration in law enforcement and crime prevention is encouraged through Interpol, often known as the International Criminal Police Organization.
- It is the oldest international police organization, having been founded in 1923.
- During the inaugural International Criminal Police Congress in 1914, the International Criminal Police Organization was proposed, and India joined this organization in 1949.

NATO announced its annual nuclear exercise "Steadfast Noon"

Why in News:

 The North Atlantic Treaty Organization (NATO), also known as the North Atlantic Alliance, has announced the launch of its annual nuclear exercise code "Steadfast Noon".



- The Steadfast Noon nuclear exercise will be conducted in Southern Europe this year in which aircraft and personnel from 14 NATO countries will participate.
- The Steadfast Noon involved training flights with dual-capacity fighter jets as well as conventional jets supported by surveillance and refueling aircraft.
- The goal of the Steadfast Noon exercise is to ensure that NATO's nuclear deterrents are safe, secure and effective.
- No live weapons are used in the Steadfast Nun exercise.
- Like previous years, this year also the Steadfast Noon exercise will be attended by a US Air Force B-52 long-range bomber.
- In order to offer collective security against the Soviet Union, the United States, Canada, and many Western European nations signed the North Atlantic Treaty in April 1949, creating the North Atlantic Treaty Organization (NATO).
- The headquarters of the North Atlantic Treaty Organization (NATO) are in Brussels, Belgium.









• Despite having 30 members today, the North Atlantic Treaty Organization (NATO) was founded by Belgium, Canada, Denmark, France, Iceland, Italy, Luxembourg, the Netherlands, Norway, Portugal, the United Kingdom, and the United States.

key points:

- Times Higher Education formerly known as Times Higher Education Supplement (THES) is a magazine reporting exclusively on news and issues related to higher education.
- Oxford University has been ranked first in the Times Higher Education Ranking 2023.
- India is the sixth most prestigious performing nation in the Times Higher Education Ranking 2023 with 75 universities.
- Indian Institute of Science (IISc) has been ranked top among Indian institutions
 for its performance score for teaching and research, Shoolini University of
 Biotechnology and Management Sciences in Himachal Pradesh is second and
 Tamil Nadu's Alagappa University has been ranked third this year.
- IIT Ropar which was the second highest ranked Indian institute in the year 2022 ranking, has been placed at the sixth position in the list this year.
- The criteria on which institutions are ranked in the Times Higher Education Ranking 2023 include teaching (30%), research (30%), citation (30%), international outlook (7.5%), and industry outcomes (2.5%).

Global Hunger Index 2022

Why in News:

 The Global Hunger Index 2022 has been released jointly by Concern Worldwide and Welthungerhilfe.










key points:

- India has been ranked 107th out of 121 countries in this year's Global Hunger Index 2022.
- India's score in the Global Hunger Index 2022 is 29.1, and India has been placed in the 'severe' category this year.
- Earlier, India was ranked 101st out of 116 countries in the Global Hunger Index 2021.



- The Global Hunger Index is a tool to comprehensively measure and track hunger at the global, regional and country levels.
- The Global Hunger Index is calculated on the basis of four indicators which include undernutrition, child wasting, child stunting and child mortality.
- The Global Hunger Index is an annual report, and each set of Global Hunger Index scores is prepared using data over a period of 5 years.
- The year 2022 Global Hunger Index score has been calculated using data from 2017 to 2021.
- Belarus, Bosnia and Herzegovina, Chile, China and Croatia are the top five countries in the 2022 Global Hunger Index, while Chad, the Democratic Republic of Congo, Madagascar, the Central African Republic and Yemen are the worst performers in the index.
- In the Global Hunger Index 2022, Sri Lanka (64), Nepal (81), Bangladesh (84) and Pakistan (99) have been ranked better than India.
- Afghanistan (109) is the only country in South Asia, which performs worse than India in the index.

Discovery of 'The Trapping Zone' in Maldives

Why in News:

 Maldives, India's southern neighbor, is home to "The Trapping Zone," as identified by scientists.











Key Points:

- A new environment known as the "trapping zone" that was discovered around 500 meters below the surface is being referred to as an "oasis of marine life."
- Scientists working on the Nekton Maldives mission have found the trapping zone.
- Nektons are kinds of pelagic animals that can swim against wind and currents.
- Scientists used the Omega Seamaster II's cameras to investigate the ecology while also collecting biological samples for additional study.
- Numerous mega-creature predators, including sharks and other sizable marine fish that devour micro-nekton, were found, according to the survey.
- These micro-nektons frequently engage in "vertical migration," which is the movement from deep water to the surface at dusk and vice versa.
- Large predators like shark, alphonsin, spiky Oreo, and tuna can find plenty of food in the habitat.
- The discovery is important because it will increase support for conservation efforts and promote sustainable ocean management through significant knowledge of sub-surface biodiversity.
- The country's fishing industry and tourism industry will both benefit from the trapping zone.

Indestructible Brotherhood-2022

Why in News:

 Kyrgyzstan has called off the military exercise called Indestructible Brotherhood-2022 of CSTO, which was to be conducted in the Central Asian country from October 10 to 14.

- Kyrgyzstan, a former Soviet republic, called off the "Indestructible Brotherhood 2022" command and staff exercise a day before the start of a multinational military exercise on its territory.
- The Indestructible Brotherhood exercise is a joint military exercise involving the collective Security Treaty Organization (CSTO) personnel from the 6-









member security alliance of Russia, Belarus, Armenia, Kyrgyzstan, Kazakhstan and Tajikistan.

- Non-member states such as Syria, Serbia and Uzbekistan were also invited as observers for the Indestructible Brotherhood military exercise.
- The Indestructible Brotherhood multilateral military exercise was to be held in the Eastern Highlands of Kyrgyzstan.
- Currently, the coalition is focused only on increasing security preparedness for the potential adverse consequences of a US military withdrawal from Afghanistan.
- Currently, about 5,000 troops are deployed by Russia along Tajikistan's border with Afghanistan.
- The Collective Security Treaty Organization (CSTO) is an intergovernmental military alliance established as an alternative to the US-led North Atlantic Treaty Organization (NATO) headquartered in Moscow.

"Education 4.0 Report" 2022, released by the World Economic Forum (WEF)

Why in News:

• The school-to-work (S2W) transition process in India continues to face significant challenges, and a lack of coordinated efforts has led to a different skill set. system that has not been able to reach its full potential, according to the report titled Education 4.0 Report 2022 published by the World Economic Forum (WEF).



- The Education 4.0 report shows how digital and other technologies can bridge learning gaps and make education accessible to all.
- The "Education 4.0 India" initiative has been launched by the World Economic Forum in partnership with the United Nations Children's Fund (UNICEF) and YuWaah (Generation Unlimited India).
- The Education 4.0 India initiative aims to bridge inequalities in access to education and improve education among Indian school children through the Fourth Industrial Revolution technology.









- The Education 4.0 report is based on four themes: Foundational Literacy and Numeracy, Teacher Professional Development, S2W Transition and Disjointed.
- According to the Education 4.0 report, India has over 60 million secondary and higher secondary students, yet only 85% of schools include vocational courses in their curriculum.
- According to the report, many students and parents prefer vocational education as the second-best alternative to mainstream education.
- There are also many government-run online education platforms and tools available for education in India, such as DIKSHA, ePathshala, SWAYAM and Samagra Shiksha Abhiyan etc.
- Earlier the government-run Padhe Bharat ("India Learns") campaign focused on improving reading proficiency among children to improve learning.

Financing Platform Launched by IFC in response to Global Food Crisis

Why in News:

• In order to increase the ability of the private sector to boost production and lessen the global food crisis, the International Finance Corporation (IFC), the World Bank's private sector investment arm, has unveiled a new USD 6 billion lending facility.



Key Points:

- The new Global Food Security Platform, which will assist the trading of food commodities, the delivery of inputs to farmers, and effective food production in countries facing food crises, is responsible for providing the majority of the funds.
- The creative project spearheaded by IFC will also emphasize long-term action to strengthen the food ecosystem's resilience and lessen its impact on the environment and the climate.
- Investments in more effective agricultural production, better fertilizer access, cleaner fertilizer manufacture and use, decreased crop loss and food waste, increased supply chain efficiency, and decreased infrastructural bottlenecks are some long-term activities.
- It will make use of IFC's regional expertise in trade finance, manufacturing, infrastructure, and agribusiness.









• The cutting-edge platform run by IFC will endeavor to fulfil the World Bank's pledge of \$30 billion to address the food crisis.

Global Forest Sector Outlook 2050

Why in News:

• The report titled "Global Forest Area Approach 2050: Estimating Wood Sources for Future Demand and Sustainable Economy" has been released by the United Nations Food and Agriculture Organization (FAO) at the 26th session of the Food and Agriculture Organization Committee on Forestry.



- The Global Forest Sector Outlook 2050 released report forecasts a growing demand for wood products such as large-scale timber and man-made cellulose fibers that are used as alternatives to non-renewable materials.

• In the year 2020, the global consumption of fuel wood was 1.9 billion cubic meters, and this figure is expected to increase by 11 to 42 percent, reaching 2.1 to 2.7 billion cubic meters in the year 2050.

- On the lines of the Global Multidimensional Poverty Index, the publication of India-specific Multidimensional Poverty Index was started by NITI Aayog in the year 2021.
- The India-specific Multidimensional Poverty Index is based on the reference period of the National Family Health Survey (NFHS)-4 for the year 2015-16.
- Multidimensional poverty is a measure of poverty that reflects income or consumption at the international poverty line (according to the World Bank) of US\$1.90, as well as lack of access to education and basic infrastructure.
- The Global Multidimensional Poverty Index (MPI) is a leading international resource that measures acute multidimensional poverty in more than 100 developing countries.
- The Global Multidimensional Poverty Index is published by the Oxford Poverty and Human Development Initiative (OPHI) and the UNDP's Office of Human Development Reports.
- Scores on the Global Multidimensional Poverty Index range from 0 to 1, and higher values indicate higher poverty.









- The Global Multidimensional Poverty Index for the year 2022 uses the latest comparable data available for 111 countries.
- According to the report, in 111 countries, 2 billion people live in acute multidimensional poverty, of which half (593 million) are children under the age of 18.
- The developing region where the poorest people live is sub-Saharan Africa (about 579 million), followed by South Asia (385 million).

Living Planet Report 2022

Why in News:

• The Living Planet Report 2022 has found a drastic decline in the global wildlife population.

- The Living Planet Report 2022 is a joint effort of the World Wildlife Fund and the Zoological Society of London.
- According to the report, the global wildlife population declined by 69 percent between 1970 and 2018.
- About 32,000 populations of 5,230 species have been analyzed in the Living Planet Report 2022.
- Along with providing a comprehensive picture of declining wildlife populations in the Living Planet Report 2022, the Living Planet Report also highlights the importance of tackling biodiversity loss and the climate crisis as two separate issues, rather than one.













- According to the Living Planet Report 2022, the Latin America and Caribbean region, which hosts the Amazon rainforest, has seen the highest wildlife decline of 94 percent between 1970 and 2018.
- Africa recorded the second largest decline of 66 percent during the same period, followed by the Pacific (55 percent).
- North America and Europe recorded fewer declines in nature, with declines of 20 percent and 18 percent, respectively.
- According to the Living Planet Report 2022, the major threats facing terrestrial vertebrates are climate change, pollution, agriculture, hunting, logging and invasive species.
- According to the Living Planet Report 2022, freshwater and tropical ecosystems are facing the worst crisis caused by human exploitation in the past half century.



- Earlier in the year 1952, the cheetah was officially declared extinct in India.

Delhi LG launches one-time property tax amnesty scheme 'SAMRIDDHI 2022-23'

Why in News:

 One-time property tax exemption program Vinay Kumar Saxena, the Delhi Lieutenant Governor, has introduced the SAMRIDDHI 2022–23 program.



Key Points:

- The SAMRIDDHI program was in place from October 26, 2018, through March 31, 2023.
- The SAMRIDDHI scheme is a one-time property tax relief program that applies to both residential and commercial buildings.
- Residential property owners can pay the basic property tax amount for the current and previous five fiscal years (FY 2017–18 to 202–22) through the SAMRIDDHI scheme and receive a 100% waiver of interest and penalty on the unpaid tax amount.
- In accordance with this program, owners of commercial real estate can pay the principal balance for the previous six years (FY 2016–17 to 202–22) and receive an exemption on past-due amounts, including penalties and interest, that were accrued before to 2016–17.
- According to the SAMRIDDHI system, if the taxpayer does not pay his tax arrears by the 31st of March of the following year, he will be responsible for









paying all tax arrears dating back to 2004 or the year in which the property tax is still unpaid, along with penalties and interest.

- According to the SAMRIDDHI system, a taxpayer who has already paid property tax but has not yet been added to the MCD tax database must present proof of payment to have the database updated.
- If the principal, interest, and penalty were paid prior to the start of the program, they will not be re-evaluated or re-evaluated under the terms of the scheme.
- The SAMRIDDHI program tries to persuade property owners to terminate ongoing property tax disputes and the associated harassment.
- By removing long-overdue tax debts, the SAMRIDDHI program will assist in increasing the revenue base and help MCDs create a comprehensive tax database.





- Five missiles—the Prithvi, Agni, Trishul, Nag, and Akash missiles—have been developed as part of the Integrated Guided Missile Development Program.

- Nuclear proliferation was opposed by Andrei Sakharov and called for an end to atmospheric tests.
- Andrei Sakharov was also instrumental in the creation of the Partial Test Ban Treaty, which was signed in Moscow in 1963.





Heaviest rocket of ISRO, LVM3 successfully places 36 satellites in orbit

Why in News:

 The Indian Space Research Organization (ISRO) successfully launched 36 satellites from the LVM3 launch vehicle on 23 October.



key points:

- These satellites belonged to the British company One Web, which were launched from the Srihari Kota Satish Dhawan Space Center in Andhra Pradesh.
- One Web is a UK-based private satellite communications company in which Bharti Enterprises of India is a major investor and shareholder.
- Another set of 36 satellites from One Web are planned to be put into orbit in January 2023.
- LVM3 (Launch Vehicle Mark 3) is India's heaviest rocket, also known as Geosynchronous Satellite Launch Vehicle Mark 3 (GSLV-Mk3).
- LVM3 has become the first Indian rocket to go into space with One Web's 36 satellites weighing 5,796 kg in the mission.
- This was LVM3's first commercial mission under which One Web's 36 satellites were placed in low Earth orbit.
- About 20 minutes after launch, all 36 satellites have been successfully placed in low Earth orbit at an altitude of 601 km.
- Earlier commercial mission was successfully accomplished by ISRO through Polar Satellite Lo bicycle (PSLV), but this was the first commercial mission for GSLV.
- So far 345 foreign satellites have been launched by ISRO, which were sent to space by PSLV.
- The LVM3 rocket is 43.5 meters long and weighs 644 tons and is capable of carrying 8,000 kg.

ISRO's Chandrayaan-2 spectrometer maps abundance of sodium on moon for first time

Why in News:

 According to the Indian Space Research Organization (ISRO), the X-ray spectrometer 'Class' of the Chandrayaan-2 orbiter has mapped the abundant sodium on the Moon for the first time.



key points:

• Earlier, the X-ray Fluorescence Spectrometer (C1XS) of Chandrayaan-1 had detected sodium in X-rays from its









characteristic line, which has raised the possibility of mapping the amount of sodium on the Moon.

- The abundance of sodium was mapped for the first time in 'The Astrophysical Journal Letters' using the National Space Agency CLASS (Chandrayaan-2 Large Area Soft X-ray Spectrometer).
- Manufactured at ISRO's UR Rao Satellite Center in Bengaluru, KLASS offers the clean signature of the sodium line for its high sensitivity and performance.
- According to ISRO, part of the signal may be weakly bound to lunar particles by a thin veneer of sodium atoms, and these sodium atoms can be more easily ejected from the surface by the solar wind or ultraviolet radiation.
- According to ISRO, in the atmosphere of the Moon, there is a region which is so thin that the atoms there are rarely found.
- This region, called the 'exosphere', begins at the surface of the Moon and merges into interplanetary space for several thousand kilometers.
- The new findings from Chandrayaan-2 provide an opportunity to study surface-exosphere interactions on the Moon, which will aid in the development of similar models for mercury and other airless bodies in our solar system and beyond.






Anna May Wong set to become first Asian American to feature on US currency






