#### 1. Gustavo Petro elected as the firstleftist President of Colombia

- Leftist party, Gustavo Petro has won presidential election of Colombia and becomes the first ever leftist president in the history of country.
- He defeated construction magnate, Rodolfo Hernandez with a margin of more than 700,000 votes.
- Petro is a former mayor of capital Bogota and current senator.
- He was also a former member of the M-19 guerrilla movement.
- Francia Marquez has become the first Black woman Vice President of Colombia.

- Australia will provide 22 million dollars to the World Food Programme (WFP) for




