BEL or BELLI as a root means war, fight, resistance, opposes

- Bellic warlike
- **Belli**cism The policy or practice of resorting to **war** even when it is not necessary and is avoidable.
- Bellicist Adherent of bellicism, advocate of war, one who is war-centred or war-oriented.
- Bellicose having or showing a ready disposition to fight
- Belligerent hostile ready to fight
- Bellicosity a natural disposition to fight
- **Belli**gerati Literary people, authors literati who promote **wars** of aggression.
- **Belli**gerency **fighting**; acts of overt **war**fare
- Rebel- person who opposes and fights
- Rebellious resisting control or authority
- Re**bel**ler One who rebels or **opposes**

AMI or AMO as a root means LOVE, MORAL, EASY TO TALK TO

- Amor god of love
- Amorist A love knot, love token, or love song.
- **Amo**rally without regard for **moral**ity
- **Amo**rette A petty **love** affair.
- Amorist one dedicated to love and lovemaking especially one who writes about love
- **Amo**ritic of or pertaining to romantic **love**
- Amorous inclined toward or displaying love
- Amity friendly and peaceful relations
- Amiable friendly, pleasant, lovable
- Amiableness a disposition to be friendly and approachable (easy to talk to)
- **Amo**rousness a feeling of **love** or fondness

ANIM as a root means mind, life, spirit, anger

- Animal means all living beings except humans
- Animate give (a film or character) the appearance of movement (life) using animation techniques.
- Animosity strong hostility
- Anima the soul or inner self of a person
- Animadversion strong criticism, censure, and disapproval
- Animadversive Being critical, censuring, or making a censorious comment
- **Animalism** a trait or mode of behaviour typical of animals
- Animalist A believer in, or greater interest, in physical rather than in spiritual needs.

AMBUL as a root means to walk.

- Ambulatory relating to or adapted for walking
- Amble walk or move at a slow, relaxed pace
- **Ambulance** a vehicle equipped for taking sick or injured people to and from the hospital, especially in emergencies
- **Ambulant -** a reference to moving or walking around
- Ambulatorial Being equipped or fit to walk
- Ambulative A descriptive term for walking or for moving forward.
