**APO or APHO** as a root means away, off, separate, without, absent, loss, regret, lack.

- Aphobia Fearlessness, a lack of fear.
- Aphonic having no voice or sound; mute.
- Aphonous Without a voice, voiceless.
- **Aphorism** a short expression of a general truth.
- Apologetic expressing or showing regretful acknowledgment of an offence or failure.
- Apologeticism An instance uses of an expression of regret.
- Apologian one who regrets.
- Apogeotropic Bending away from the ground.
- **Apostrophe** address to an absent or imaginary person

PATER OR PATRI as a root means father or fatherhood or relating to fathers or father land

- Patriarchy A system (a family/ society) which is run by the male head (father) of the family.
- **Patri**ot One who loves his nation (the word actually originated from Germany where they call their nation as fatherland instead of motherland).
- Compatriot People who belong to the same nation and live together.
- Expatriate People who share the same origin but are living in some other nation.
- Paternity Fatherhood
- Paternal related to father

**CAUST or CAUT** as a root means to burn, caution, careful

- Cautel caution
- Cautelous careful
- **Cauterant** an instrument or substance used to destroy tissue for medical reasons by burning it with a hot iron or an electric current or a caustic or by freezing it.
- Caustic any chemical substance that burns or destroys living tissue
- Causticity The quality of being physically caustic, burning, corrosive.
- **Causticization** The act of making something burn (caustic).
- **Caustically** burnt in a vitriolic manner
- Cauterize to burn with a hot instrument
