Banking & Financial Awareness

1. As per the Crisil rating agency report published in November 2022, what would be the India growth forecast for 2022-23 _____ **7%**.
Note:
 - Reason: The slowdown in global growth and its impact on India's exports and industrial activity.
 - As per the Crisil, the growth of country's gross domestic product (GDP) will slow considerably to 6% (FY24) from 6.5%.
2. As per the Goldman Sachs report published in November 2022, what would be the economic growth forecast of India in 2023 _____ **5.9%**.
Note:
 - Reason: As the boost from the post COVID reopening fades and monetary tightening weighs on domestic demand.
 - Goldman Sachs has also expected that inflation will drop to 6.1% in 2023, from 6.8% in 2022.
 - Recently, RBI has also pegged the domestic growth rate at 7% for 2022-23.
 - India economist at Goldman Sachs: Santanu Sengupta
3. Which Payments Bank has launched face authentication-based savings bank account opening for customers _____ **Airtel Payments Bank**.
Note:
 - Aim: To ease the account opening process and provide better customers experience.
 - It is the first payments bank in the country to offer this facility.
 - It will also help business correspondents of the bank to open an account just by undertaking face authentication e-KYC.
 - The authentication is processed by using a newly developed mobile application by UIDAI.
4. As per the Organisation for Economic Co-operation and Development (OECD), what would be the India's gross domestic growth forecast for the current financial year (FY23) _____ **6.6%**.
Note:
 - Reason: Higher medium-term global uncertainty and slowing domestic economic activity.
 - As per the OECD, the headline inflation remains above 6% mostly due to the trend increase in the price of food.
5. Which government owned organisation has recommended Reserve Bank of India to limit the volume cap of UPI _____ **National Payments Corporation of India (NPCI)**.
Note:
 - Currently, there's no cap on volume and Google Pay and PhonePe, which hold the market share of about 80 per cent.
 - The NPCI had proposed a 30 per cent volume cap for third-party app providers (TPAP).
 - NPCI in 2020 came up with a directive to cap the share of transactions TPAP.
6. As per the Reserve Bank of India (RBI), the overnight balances under the SDF will be eligible as 'Level 1 High Quality Liquid Assets (HQLA)' for computation of the Liquidity Coverage Ratio (LCR). What is the full form of SDF _____ **Standing Deposit Facility**.
Note:
 - Reason: To enhance the ability of banks to achieve LCR.
 - LCR promotes short-term resilience of banks to potential liquidity disruptions.
 - It also ensures that banks have sufficient HQLAs to survive an acute stress scenario lasting for 30 days.
7. As per the recent RBI data, the CD ratio of the Northern and Western Regions have been declined in 2022. What is the fullform of CD ratio _____ **Credit-Deposit**.

Note:

- While the North-Eastern, Eastern, Central and Southern Regions improved.
- CD ratio indicates that how much of each rupee of deposit goes towards credit markets in a particular region.
- Low CD ratio: It suggests relatively poor credit growth compared with deposit growth.
- High CD ratio: Strong demand for credit, relatively slower deposit growth.

8. Which payment organisation has launched TapTap, a wearable device that enables contactless payments _____ **BillBox**.

Note:

- This card was launched in association with NSDL Payments Bank and Visa.
- Aim: To simplify payments and offer users convenience.
- It has been launched with silicon band, silicon strap and silicon loop which will be available in white, black and blue colours

9. Which has launched a sticker-based debit card named FIRSTAP _____ **IDFC First Bank**.

Note:

- It was launched in association with National Payments Corporation of India (NPCI).
- Aim: To facilitate transactions by simply tapping the sticker on a Near Field Communication (NFC) enabled point-of-sale terminal.
- The sticker-based debit card is one third the size of a regular debit card.

10. Which bank has launched an Electronic Bank Guarantee (e-BG) in partnership with National E-Governance Services Limited (NeSL) _____ **Canara Bank**.

Note:

- With this, bank can offers an API based digital workflow of Bank guarantees.
- It will eliminate physical issuance, stamping, verification and paper-based record maintenance of Bank Guarantees paving the way to augment integration of Environmental and Social Governance (ESG) framework into Business.

11. As per the data of the Department for Promotion of Industry and Internal Trade (DPIIT), how much Foreign Direct Investment (FDI) equity inflows into India has been recorded during the April-September 2022 _____ **\$26.9 billion**.

Note:

- Singapore emerged as the top investor with USD 10 billion FDI.
- It was followed by Mauritius (USD 3.32 billion), UAE (USD 2.95 billion), USA (USD 2.6 billion), the Netherlands (USD 1.76 billion), and Japan (USD 1.18 billion).

12. How much amount has been released by the central government to states and UTs towards the balance Goods and Services Tax compensation for the April-June 2022 period _____ **₹17,000 crore**.

Note:

- The total amount of compensation released to states and UTs so far this fiscal is ₹1.15 trillion (including the latest tranche).
- This is despite the fact that total GST cess collection till October 2022 was only ₹72,147 crore.
- And, the balance of ₹43,515 crore is being released by the Centre from its own resources.

13. IRDAI has approved the amendments to rules on registering insurance companies and investing in them, to enable the Insurance for All by which year _____ **2047**.

Note:

- Private equity (PE) funds can now directly invest in insurance companies and investment by PE through special purpose vehicles (SPVs) has been made optional.
- Investment up to 25% of the paid up capital by single investor will now be treated as ‘investor’ and above 25% single investor will be treated as promoter”.

14. Which regulatory body has amended norms to bring buying and selling of mutual fund units under the insider trading rules and became effective from 24th November 2022 _____ **SEBI**.

Note:

- Any person who is connected with a fund house and comes into possession of unpublished, price-sensitive information shall not be permitted to trade in MF units.
- AMCs will have to disclose the details of holdings in the units of its MF schemes (trustees and their immediate relatives on the platform of stock exchanges).

15. Hyundai Construction Equipment India has signed an agreement with which bank to broaden the Bank's MSME funding prospects _____ **Karnataka Bank**.

Note:

- This MoU will allow both Hyundai and Karnataka Bank to provide consumers with customised financial solutions.
 - With this tie up, Bank will be designated as a financial partner and will be able to meet the needs of customers by providing loans at competitive interest rates for purchase of equipments from Hyundai Construction Equipments India.
16. As per the S&P Global Ratings report, published in November 2022, what would be the India's economic growth forecast of India for current fiscal year (FY23) _____ **7%**.
- Note:**
- The firm has also announced that the domestic demand-led economy will be less impacted by the global slowdown.
 - S&P had in September (2022) projected the Indian economy to grow 7.3 per cent in 2022-23 and 6.5 per cent in next fiscal year (2023-24).
17. The RBI will launch the first pilot for the retail digital Rupee on _____ **1st December 2022**.
- Note:**
- Presently, eight banks have been identified for phase-wise participation.
 - First phase: SBI, ICICI, Yes Bank and IDFC First
 - Subsequent phase: BoB, Union Bank of India, HDFC and Kotak Mahindra.
 - This pilot project would initially cover Mumbai, New Delhi, Bengaluru and Bhubaneswar.
 - Later, it is extended to Ahmedabad, Gangtok, Guwahati, Hyderabad, Indore, Kochi, Lucknow, Patna and Shimla.
18. The Reserve Bank of India (RBI) has imposed a penalty of Rs 1.25 crore on Zoroastrian Co-operative Bank, Mumbai for the non-compliance of _____ **Discounting of bills**.
- Note:**
- The RBI has imposed penalty of Rs 20 lakh on Indian Mercantile Co-operative Bank, Lucknow for non-compliance with the certain norms related classification of non-performing assets.
 - The central bank also imposed penalties on five other cooperative banks.
19. SEBI has set up a high-level panel to review the takeover norms in a move to simplify and strengthen the current rules by adopting appropriate global practices. Who is the head of this panel _____ **Shiavax Jal Vazifdar**.
- Note:**
- Members: 20-member committee
 - The SEBI regulator will also assess the current rules in the light of past judicial pronouncements and various informal guidelines issued by the capital markets regulator.
20. Which insurance company has launched Star Out Patient Care Insurance Policy, which aims at providing complete health and wellness benefits to customers at an affordable cost _____ **Star Health and Allied Insurance**.
- Note:**
- The claims processing procedure will be entirely digital.
 - The policy is available on individual or floater basis and cover up to six family members
 - Age: 18 - 50 years (adults) and 31 days to 25 years (dependent children)
 - Four sum insured (SI) options: ₹25,000, ₹50,000, ₹75,000 and ₹1 lakh

- Note:**
- Khambatta had established the popular orange-flavoured beverage brand in 1976.
 - He was awarded the President of India's Home Guard and Civil Defence Medal, as well as the Paschimi Star, Samarseva, and Sangram Medals.
 - He was honoured with the National Citizen's Award for his outstanding contribution in the field of commerce.
2. Golak Bihari Naik, who has been passed away, was a _____ **Politician**.
- Note:**
- He started his political career with BJP and later joined the Biju Janata Dal.
 - He was elected to Odisha Assembly thrice, twice as BJP candidate from Khunta and once as BJD nominee from Udala constituency.
 - He served as a minister in the Naveen Patnaik-led government from 2000 to 2009.
3. Vikram Gokhale, who has been passed away, was a/an _____ **Actor**.
- Note:**

- Vikram Gokhale was made his film debut in 1971 with Amitabh Bachchan's Parwana.
 - He was known for his on-screen roles in films like Hum Dil De Chuke Sanam.
 - In 2010, he received the National Award for Best Actor for his work in the Marathi film Anumati.
 - He also forayed into direction with the Marathi film Aaghaat.
 - The actor was last seen in the Marathi film 'Godavari'.
4. Vikram S Kirloskar, who has been passed away, was a vice chairman of which motor company _____ **Toyota Kirloskar Motor Pvt Ltd.**

Note:

- He became the vice chairman of Toyota Kirloskar in 1998.
- He has also served as president of the Society of Indian Automobile Manufacturers from 2013-15.
- He also served as the President of the Confederation of Indian Industry (CII) for 2019-20.

Note:

- On this day, PM Modi has launched various initiatives
- Virtual Justice Clock: To exhibit vital statistics of the justice delivery system at the Court level
- JustIS Mobile App 2.0: Tool for judicial officers for effective court and case management by monitoring pendency and disposal
- Digital court: The court records available to the judge in digitised form

2. The International Day for the Elimination of Violence against Women has been observed every year on which date to pay tribute to the Mirabal sisters, the Dominican Republic activists who were murdered at the order of Rafael Trujillo in 1960 _____ **November 25.**

Note:

- 2022 theme: UNITE! Activism to End Violence against Women & Girls
- On 7 February 2000, the General Assembly has adopted the resolution 54/134 to officially designate 25 November as day for Elimination of Violence against Women

3. International Jaguar Day is observed annually on which date _____ **November 29.**

Note:

- Aim: To raise awareness about the increasing threats facing the jaguar and the critical conservation efforts ensuring its survival.
- International Jaguar Day celebrates the Americas' largest wild cat as an umbrella species for biodiversity conservation.
- It is an icon for sustainable development and the centuries-old cultural heritage of Central and South America.
- This is the third largest Cat Predator of the World and an important species of Amazon Rainforest.

4. Day of Remembrance for all Victims of Chemical Warfare is commemorated on which every year _____ **November 30.**

Note:

- It was adopted by the United Nations to remember the victims of chemical warfare.
- Aim: To encourage efforts for eliminating the use of chemical weapons and remember those who have suffered because of such warfare.

New Appointments

1. Kassym-Jomart Tokayev has secured a second term in snap presidential election after winning 81.31% of the vote. He became the president of which country _____ **President of Kazakhstan.**

Note:

- He came to power in 2019, before that, he has served as acting president after the resignation of president, Nursultan Nazarbayev.
- During his tenure, he had changed the name of capital from Nur-Sultan (2019) back to Astana.
- He has also approved a constitutional amendment to increase the presidential term from five years to seven.

2. Who has been appointed chairman of the All India Council for Technical Education (AICTE) for three years or till he attain the age of 65, whichever is earlier _____ **T G Sitharam.**

Note:

- He will replace UGC chairman, Jagadesh Kumar, who was holding the interim charge of the AICTE chairman after the retirement of Anil Sahasrabudde on September 1, 2021.
- Sitharam tenure as an IIT director will expire in July 2024.

3. Who has been appointed executive director of the Bank of India with effect for three years _____ **Subrat Kumar**.
Note:
 - He has an experience of 27 years in commercial banks and asset management companies.
 - Other ED appointments (by govt):
 - Lalit Tyagi (BoB); Binod Kumar (PNB); Ashok Chandra (Canara Bank); Ramasubramanian (Union Bank)
 - Mahesh Bajaj (Indian Bank); M Paramasivan (PNB); Malladi Venkat Murali Krishna (CBI); Rahendra Saboo (UCO); Sanjay Mudaliyar (Indian Overseas Bank)
4. Who has taken charge as the chief executive officer of Khadi & Village Industries Commission (KVIC) _____ **Vinit Kumar**.
Note:
 - He is an IRSEE officer of 1993 batch, has served as the Chairman of Syama Prasad Mukherjee Port, Kolkata from 2018-2020.
 - He has also served as Chief Electrical Engineer in Mumbai Railway Vikas Corporation Ltd. and looked after World Bank funded MUTP project.
5. Who has been elected as a member of the International Committee for Weights and Measures (CIPM) _____ Prof. **Venu Gopal Achanta (Director of CSIR-National Physical Laboratory (CSIR-NPL))**.
Note:
 - He is the 7th Indian to be elected to the CIPM.
 - The 27th General Conference on Weights and Measures (CGPM) meeting was held on 15-18 November, 2022 at Paris, France.
 - The first Indian to be elected as a member of CIPM was Dr. K.S. Krishnan (Founder Director of CSIR-NPL).
6. Who has been sworn-in as the 10th Prime Minister of Malaysia, by King Sultan Abdullah Sultan Ahmad Shah at the palace in Kuala Lumpur _____ **Anwar Ibrahim**.
Note:
 - Neither Anwar nor ex-premier Muhyiddin Yassin had won the simple majority (112 seats) needed to form a government.
 - Anwar started his political career as a student leader before joining United Malays National Organisation (UMNO), where he rose to become deputy PM and finance minister.
7. Who has been appointed as the national ambassador of TB Mukht Bharat campaign _____ **Deepa Malik**.
Note:
 - She has also extended her support to the campaign by becoming a Ni-Kshay Mitra to provide aid to TB afflicted patients.
 - She has adopted 5 TB patients herself as a Ni-Kshay Mitra.
 - The TB Mukht Bharat campaign was launched by Prime Minister, Narendra Modi in March 2018.
8. Who becomes the first woman President of the Indian Olympic Association (IOA) _____ **PT Usha**.
Note:
 - She is a multiple Asian Games gold medallist and a fourth-place finisher at the 1984 Olympics 400m hurdles final.
 - Usha will also become the first Olympian and first international medallist to head the IOA in its 95-year-old history.
9. BSE Ltd has received an approval from the Securities and Exchange Board of India (SEBI) for whom as the MD & CEO _____ **Sundararaman Ramamurthy**.
Note:
 - The top position was vacant since July when Ashishkumar Chauhan, who stepped down as the chief executive of BSE.
 - His appointment is subject to the approval of the shareholders.
 - At present, he is the chief operating officer of the India arm of Bank of America Corp, and has previously worked as a senior vice president at NSE.
10. Who has been elected as the President of the Advertising Agencies Association of India (AAAI) for 2022-23 _____ **Prasanth Kumar**.
Note:
 - While, Rana Barua (Group CEO of Havas Group India) has been elected as the Vice-President of the Association.
 - Immediate Past President, Anupriya Acharya has been appointed as the ex-officio member of the AAAI Board for 2022-23.
 - AAAI is a national advertising agencies, which was formed in 1945.

Important News – India

1. Who has launched the India's first National Centre of Excellence for Green Port & Shipping (NCoEGPS) _____ **Sarbananda Sonowal (Union Minister of Ports, Shipping & Waterways).**

Note:

- The announcement was made by minister at the recently concluded "INMARCO 2022" in Mumbai.
- Aim: To develop a regulatory framework and alternate technology adoption road map for Green Shipping to foster carbon neutrality and circular economy (CE) in shipping sector in India.

2. According to the seventh edition of RBI statistical publication titled 'Handbook of Statistics on Indian States 2021-22', which state has topped the total installed capacity of grid-interactive renewable power of all the states of the country _____ **Karnataka.**

Note:

- The state had a total installed capacity of 15,463 megawatts (mw).
- TN (15,225 mw) placed second, followed by Gujarat (13,153 mw), Maharashtra (10,267 mw).

3. Which edition of the Indian Film Festival in Busan was held from Nov 18-20, 2022 in South Korea _____ **10th.**

Note:

- It was organized by the Swami Vivekananda Cultural Centre, Embassy of India Seoul and supported by the Directorate of Film Festival, Ministry of I&B.
- This Film Festival is a part of the ongoing annual flagship cultural programme of Embassy of India (Seoul) 'SARANG- The Festival of India in Republic of Korea'.
- The first was screened on this platform was Padmavat (Hindi movie).

4. The Ministry of Ayush has established the Ayurveda Academic Chair at Western Sydney University's NICM Health Research Institute for how many years _____ **Three years.**

Note:

- The Ministry has selected All India Institute of Ayurveda, New Delhi's Associate Professor Dr. Rajagopala S. for the post of Academic Chair in Ayurvedic Science at Western Sydney University.
- Aim: To strengthen India's collaborations in promoting academic and collaborative research activities in Australia.

5. Department of Civil Engineering (IIT Madras) and which shipping port authority have developed a Continuous Marine Water Quality Monitoring Station (CMWQMS) and launched Electric Environmental Monitoring Vehicle (EV) _____ **Jawaharlal Nehru Port Authority (JNPA).**

Note:

- The monitor station and vehicle were inaugurated by Chairman of JNPA, Sanjay Sethi.
- Aim: To assist in managing the marine water and air quality in the port area.
- With this, JNPA will be able to reduce the greenhouse gas footprint of vehicles.

6. The Department for Promotion of Industry and Internal Trade (DPIIT) has launched startup applications for registration on the MAARG portal. What is the full form of MAARG _____ **Mentorship, Advisory, Assistance, Resilience and Growth.**

Note:

- Purpose: To provide further boost the startup ecosystem by catalysing the startup culture and building a strong and inclusive ecosystem for innovation and entrepreneurship in India.
- The MAARG is National Mentorship Platform by Startup India.

7. As per the NSO 16th Periodic Labour Force Survey, what is the unemployment rate of India for people aged 15 years and above in urban areas in the fiscal second quarter (July - Sep 2022) _____ **7.2%.**

Note:

- Indication: Sustained economic recovery following the coronavirus pandemic.
- The survey also showed that the unemployment rate among females (aged 15 years and above) in urban areas slowed to 9.4% and among males in urban areas eased to 6.6% (July-September).

8. Which city is ready to host the first G20 Sherpa Meeting in India from 4 to 7 December 2022 _____ **Udaipur.**

Note:

- Aim: To foster growth and build bonds amongst the twenty nations.
- The G20 Sherpa meeting is expected to be held at the Darbar Hall at the City Palace Udaipur.
- The Sherpa Meeting of the G20 Summit is a preliminary meeting of the government representatives before the main G20 Summit.

9. Nitin Gadkari (Minister for Road Transport and Highways) has approved the 4-Laning of Bhiwani-Hansi road section of which national highways under Bharatmala Pariyojana in Bhiwani and Hisar districts on HAM in the state of Haryana with a budget of Rs.1322.13 Crore _____ **NH-148B**.

Note:

- The project would provide fast movement & good inter-district connectivity in Haryana.
- It would also improve the overall efficiency of the long route traffic and freight movement that would ensure smooth traffic flow.

10. The Indian Railways has planned to introduce 'tilting trains' by which year _____ **2026**.

Note:

- Aim: To maintain higher speed on curvy stretches.
- According to the officials, 100 new units of the semi-high speed Vande Bharat trains are being manufactured using this technology.
- Tilting trains: Mechanism enables higher speed on regular broad-gauge tracks, which tilt while undergoing a curve on the track.
- Such locomotives operate in the UK, Italy, Portugal, Slovenia, Finland, Russia.

11. As per the Ministry of External Affairs, India has invited Abdel Fattah Al Sisi as the chief guest on 2023 Republic Day. He is a president of which country _____ **Egyptian President**.

Note:

- It would be the first time that an Egyptian president would be the chief guest at the Republic Day celebrations.
- This year, both countries are celebrating the 75th anniversary of the establishment of diplomatic relations.

12. The Clean-a-thon 2022 has been organized at which beach of Goa _____ **Miramar Beach**.

Note:

- The event is a collaborative effort by Government of Goa, IFFI, Divyaj Foundation and Bhamla Foundation.
- Union Minister for Information and Broadcasting Anurag Singh Thakur and Goa CM, Pramod Sawant will be flagging off the clean up drive.
- Aim: To make the entire coastline of Goa pristine again.

13. The Food Safety and Standard Authority of India (FSSAI) has approved which animal as a 'food animal' _____ **Himalayan Yak**.

Note:

- Reason: To help check decline in the population of the high-altitude bovine animal
- Food Animals are those that are raised and used for food production or consumption by humans.
- The decision comes after the latest census (2019), showed that India has 58,000 yaks.

14. R.K. Singh (Minister of Power) has inaugurated REC's CSR initiative for procurement, operation and maintenance of ten Mobile Health Clinics (MHC) in which state _____ **Bhojpur, Bihar**.

Note:

- Total cost of project: Rs. 12.68 crore
- Out of 10 MHCs, three are exclusively for women, that will provide door-step primary health care service to the underprivileged population across all 14 blocks of Bhojpur, Bihar.
- Each MHC will organize over 20 camps per month and check 50-70 patients every day.

15. Which ministry has launched a scheme for procurement of aggregate power of 4500 MW for five years under SHAKTI Policy _____ **Ministry of Power**.

Note:

- Aim: To help states that are facing power shortage and help generation plants to increase their capacities.
- PFC Consulting Limited has been designated as the nodal agency.
- Under the scheme, PFC Consulting Ltd has invited bids for the supply of 4,500 MW.
- Supply of electricity will commence from April 2023.

16. KVIC Chairman, Manoj Kumar has inaugurated the ambitious Re-Hab Project (Reducing Human Attacks using Honey Bees) by Khadi and Village Industries Commission in which city _____ **At village Chausla, District Nainital, Uttarakhand**.

Note:

- He has also distributed 330 Bee-boxes, bee-colonies and toolkits along with the honey extractors to the rural beneficiaries in Chausla village, free of cost.
- As a new initiative, the Re-Hab project will be run by KVIC at selected locations for a period of one year.

17. 'Nai Chetna' campaign was launched by which ministry _____ **Ministry of Rural Development**.

Note:

- It involves sensitizing women, especially in rural areas.

- Aim: To enable women to acknowledge, prepare, and take support in situations of comprise.
 - This campaign was launched on the International Day for the Elimination of Violence against women on 25th November 2022.
18. Which organisation has launched the report title, 'carbon capture utilisation and storage (CCUS) policy framework and its Deployment Mechanism in India' _____ **Niti Aayog**.
- Note:**
- The report explores the importance of CCUS as an emission reduction strategy, to achieve the deep decarbonization from the hard-to-abate sectors.
 - The report was launched by Vice Chairman of Niti Aayog, Suman Bery.
19. Which university has launched a Financial Support Scheme (FSS) for those students who come from an economically weaker background and have enrolled in full-time undergraduate and postgraduate courses at the university _____ **Delhi University**.
- Note:**
- Category 1: Students whose family annual income is less than Rs 4 lakh will get up to 100% of fee relaxation.
 - Category 2: Candidates whose family income is between Rs 4 and 8 lakh will get a fee waiver of 50%
20. Which state government has launched the Har Ghar Gangajal project _____ **Bihar**.
- Note:**
- This project was launched in Rajgir with an aim to provide Ganga water on tap in the parched areas of the state
 - The scheme will help to harvest the excess water of the Ganga during the monsoon season.
 - The water will be stored in reservoirs in Rajgir and Gaya before being channelled to three treatment-and-purification plants.
 - This scheme is part of the Jal, Jeevan, Hariyali scheme of Bihar govt.
