

Bihar Specific Current Affairs January 2022

Rohit Kumar honoured with Bihar Vibhuti Samman

- Media Trendz's founder Rohit Kumar has been honoured with "Bihar Vibhuti Samman" at the Bihar Entrepreneurship Conclave 2021.
- The event was held at NDMC Convention Centre New Delhi and was organized by Let's Inspire Bihar.
- The conclave aimed to connect such committed individuals, who have on a voluntary basis opted to contribute towards future building on any of the core themes.

Amir Subhani appointed as the new Chief Secretary of Bihar

- Development Commissioner Amir Subhani will be the new Chief Secretary of Bihar. Subhani is a 1987 batch Indian Administrative Service officer.
- Atul Prasad, Additional Chief Secretary, Social Welfare Department, has been given the responsibility of Development Commissioner.

Bihar's first model floriculture center

- The state's first model floriculture center will be built in Bhaganbigha. Flower crop nurseries will be prepared with hi-tech technology.
- After getting approval from the government, the Horticulture Department has started in the exercise of taking the model center off the ground. Hi-tech nursery will be set up to prepare improved seedlings of flower crops.
- Here according to the roster, training will be given to the farmers of different districts. There will also be a pond, in which lotus and other aquatic flowers will be cultivated. About 2.80 crore will be spent on the scheme.

Dr. Rekha Kumari again became the Director of Higher Education

- Dr. Rekha Kumari has once again been appointed as the Director of Higher Education by the Education Department of the State Government. He is a Professor in the Department of Post-Graduate Zoology at AN College Patna.
- It is noteworthy that Rekha Kumari completed her three-year term on this post on 16 December 2021. After consultation at the top level, it was decided to entrust this responsibility to Dr. Rekha Kumari again.

'Koi bacha piche nahi, mata bhi chhute nahi' program will be implemented in entire Bihar

- Under the government-run Mahadalit, Dalit and Minority and Extremely Backward Class Akshar Anchal Yojana, the program 'koi bacha piche nahi, mata bhi chhute nahi' will now be implemented in the whole of Bihar.
- Presently this program is going on in Nalanda, Vaishali, Arwal, Jehanabad, Katihar, Kishanganj, Araria, Purnia and Supaul districts.
- Seeing the positive results of the program, the Education Minister directed to run this program in the remaining 29 districts as well.

Padma Shri award to Acharya Chandnaji of Bihar and posthumous Shawal Gupta

- The Government of India announced to give Padma Shri to 2 people of Bihar in the Padma Awards for the year 2022.
- It was announced to give Padma Shri to Acharya Chandnaji for social work.
- While this award is being given posthumously to Shawal Gupta for his distinguished contribution to literature and education.

Sanjay Kumar appointed chairman of Backward Classes State Commission

- The Bihar government has appointed Justice Sanjay Kumar, retired judge of Patna High Court, as the chairman of the State Commission for Backward Classes constituted at the state level.
- He has been appointed for the next three years from January 05, 2022. This order shall be deemed to be effective from the date of assumption of charge.

Bihar's second tiger reserve to be built in Kaimur

- The Union Ministry of Environment, Forest and Climate Change is executing the works for the second Tiger Reserve in Kaimur after Valmikinagar in Bihar.
- This was discussed in the 19th meeting of the National Tiger Conservation Authority (NTCA) held in Delhi. It was presided over by Union Environment, Forest and Climate Change Minister Bhupendra Yadav.
- Bihar will soon get its second tiger reserve in Kaimur after Valmikinagar.
