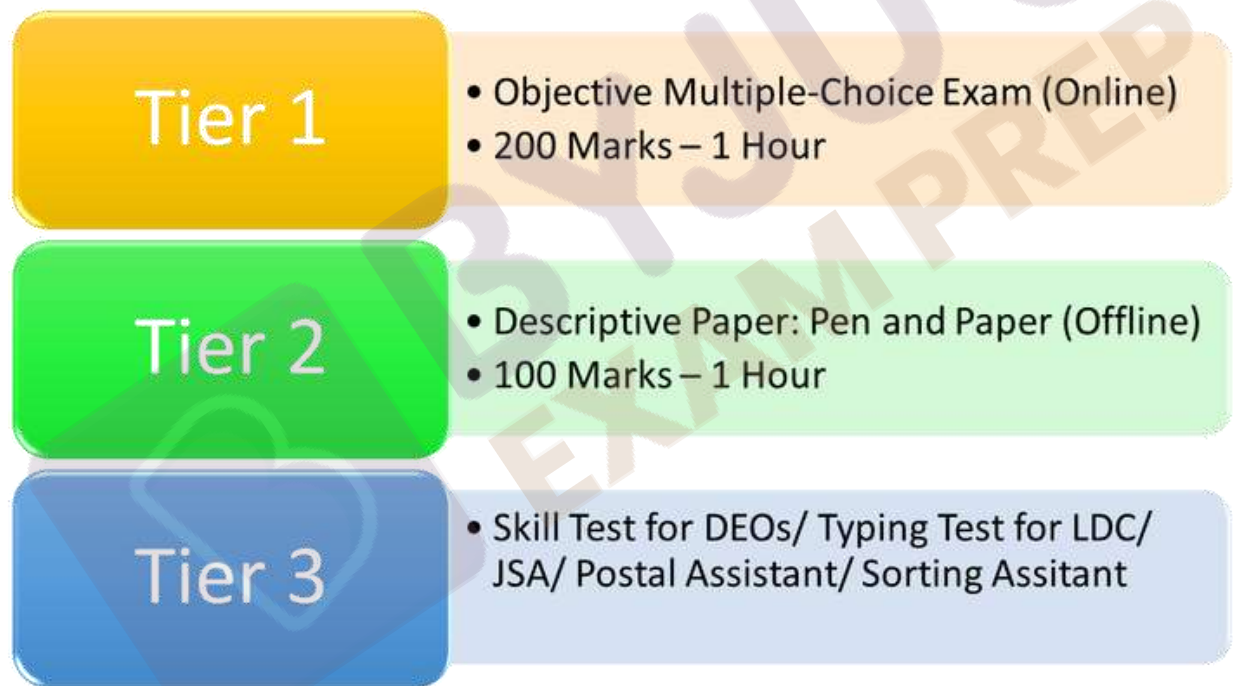

The Tier-I paper will be **objective type**. There will be **100 questions** for which candidates will get **60 minutes**.

SSC CHSL Syllabus 2021-22 for Skill Test/Typing Test

Skill Test (DEST) Pattern

For DEO Post

- It is of **Qualifying** nature.
- Candidates should possess Data Entry Speed of 8,000 key depressions per hour on the computer.
- They will be given printed matter in English which they have to type on the computer.
- The test is for 15 minutes and candidates should have a minimum speed of 2000-2200 strokes/key-depressions in order to qualify.

For DEO Post in C&AG

- Candidates should possess Data Entry Speed of 15,000 key depressions per hour on the computer.
- You will be given printed matter in English which they have to type on the computer.
- The test is for 15 minutes and candidates should have a minimum speed of 3700-4000 strokes/key-depressions in order to qualify.

Typing Test Pattern for LDC/JSA & PA/SA

- Typing Test will be conducted only in English or Hindi and candidates while applying for the Examination will have to indicate his/her choice/option for Typing Test Medium in the Application Form.
- Candidates opting for English medium should have a typing speed of **35 words per minute** and those opting for Hindi medium should have a typing speed of **30 words per minute** corresponds to 10500 key depressions per hour and 30 wpm corresponds to 9000 key depressions per hour respectively.
- The speed will be adjudged on the accuracy of typing on the computer of a given text passage in 10 minutes.

Important FAQs regarding SSC CHSL 2021-22 Syllabus

Q. What is the total duration for SSC CHSL 2021-22 Tier 1 Exam?

A. A candidate gets 60 minutes to solve 100 questions for SSC CHSL Tier I.

Q. Is there any normalisation for SSC CHSL 2022-22 Tier 1 Exam?

A. Yes, as per the latest notification by SSC board, marks will be normalised for SSC CHSL Tier I.

Q. Is SSC CHSL Exam tough?

A. No, as per the aspirants who are preparing for exams conducted by SSC board, the exam is quite easy. Aspirants who are well prepared can easily attempt over 85 questions. On analysis of the previous year papers, the exam level has been moderately difficult.

Q. Which all posts are offered through the SSC CHSL 2021-22 Exam?

A. A candidate can get any one of the following posts after qualifying SSC CHSL Exam: Lower Division Clerk (LDC), Junior Secretariat Assistant (JSA), Postal Assistant (PA), Sorting Assistant (SA), Data Entry Operator (DEO), and DEO (Grade A).

Q. Which all Departments/ Ministries can a candidate get posted after clearing SSC CHSL 2021-22 Exam?

A. A candidate after clearing SSC CHSL Exam qualify to get posted as LDC/ JSA/ JPA/ PA/SA or DEO in around 44 departments/ Ministries. The major departments or Ministries include Canteen Store Department (Ministry of Defence), Central Bureau of Investigation, Central Electricity Authority (Ministry of Power), Controller General of Defence Accounts, Election Commission of India and a few others.

Q. When are admit cards available for SSC CHSL 2021-22 Exam?

A. Admit card for SSC CHSL Exam is available one week before the exam date. Candidates can download the admit card by visiting the official website of SSC board.

Q. Where can I get SSC CHSL 2021-22 Exam previous year paper?

A. Aspirants can easily get the list of SSC CHSL Exam previous year papers with a solution by visiting BYJU'S Exam Prep or following [this link](#).

Q. Is it necessary for a candidate to have passed Class 12 to apply for SSC CHSL Exam?

A. Yes, candidates need to have passed Class 12 from any recognised board to apply for SSC CHSL Exam. However, candidates who are appearing for the Class 12 exam are also eligible provided they furnish the passing certificate before the specified time.

Q. Can a candidate with Commerce or Arts background apply for the post of DEO in the C&AG department through SSC CHSL 2021-22 Exam?

A. No, candidates with Science background are only eligible to apply for the post of DEO in C&AG department through SSC CHSL Exam.

Q. What is the age limit for SSC CHSL 2021-22 Exam?

A. Candidates who wish to apply for SSC CHSL Exam should be between 18 to 27 years. More details about the age limit for SSC CHSL Exam are specified in the official notification released by the SSC board.



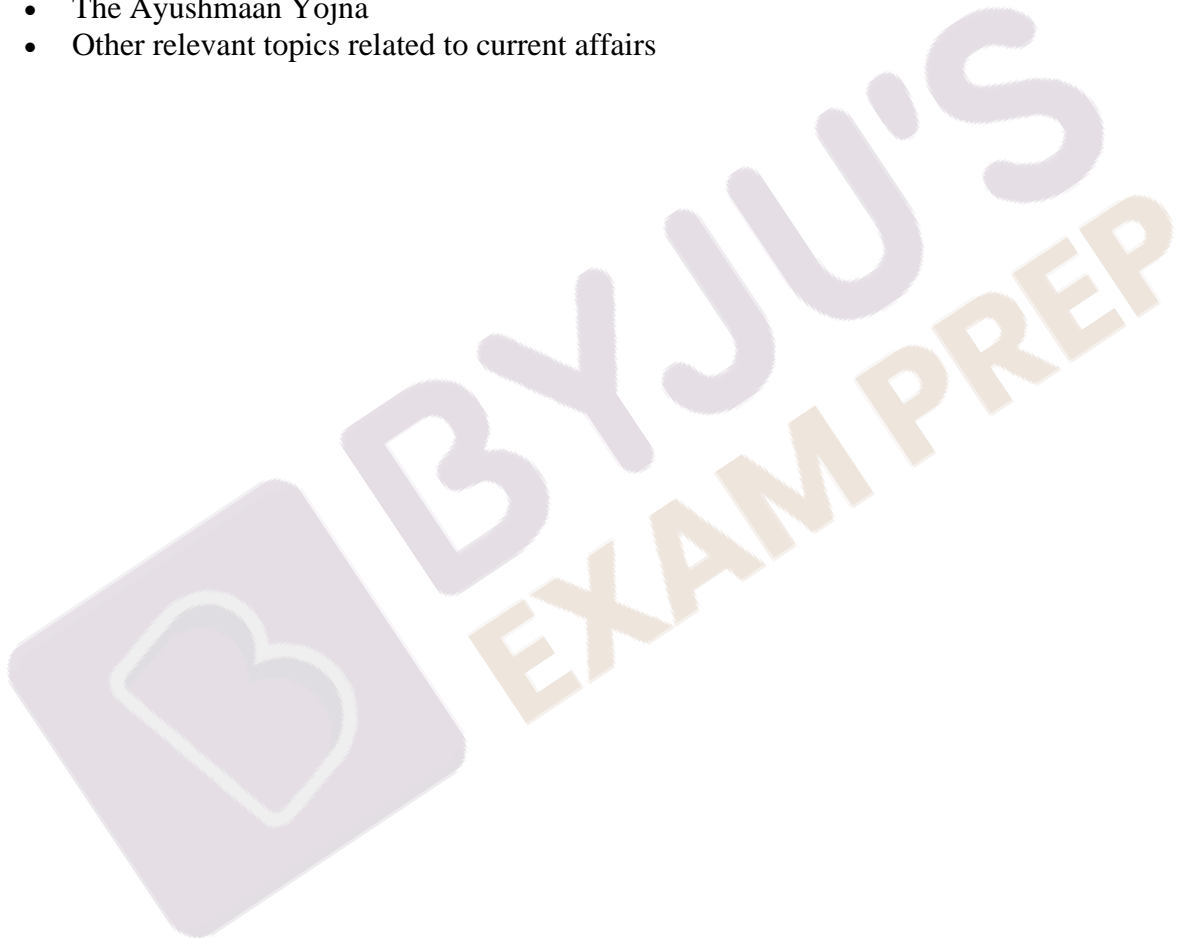
