- Irrigation and Public Health Minister Mahender Singh Thakur introduced the Himachal Pradesh Official Language Bill, 2019 (Amendment) in the ongoing budget session.

- This bill was passed without any discussion.

- The first official language of Himachal Pradesh is hindi.

- Himachal Pradesh was coined from the Sanskrit words 'him' means 'snow' and achal means 'land' or 'abode' by Acharya Diwakar Datt Sharma, one of the state's eminent Sanskrit scholars.
