#### 1. Economic Survey Report:

 According to the recently conducted
 Economic Survey 2020-21 Patna stands first among districts of Bihar in terms of Per Capita
 Income.



- The per capita income of residents of Patna is Rs. 1.31 lacs per anum.
- In this statistics Shivhar District stands at last position.
- Per capita income of Shivhar is Rs. 19.6 thousand per anum.
- Whereas the per capita income of Bihar as a whole is Rs. 50,555.
- It is worth noting that Economic Survey is an annual exercise conducted by the Government of India.
- Under this exercise 38 districts of the state were taken under consideration under various economic development parameters.

#### 2.100% Literacy Rate in Bihar:

 Recently while presenting the Economic Survey Report in state Legislative Assembly, CM Neetish Kumar stated that the Government aims to achieve a 100% literacy rate for Bihar by









the year 2030.

- Currently literacy rate of Bihar is 63.82 %.
- Among these the literacy rate among Males is 73.39%.
- Whereas that of Females is 53.3%.
- Bihar at present stands as the third lowest rate state in India.

# 3. Plantation Drive in Bihar:

Recently released 2020-21 Economic Survey
 Report highlights that nearly 1.25 crore plants have
 been planted across Bihar.

• This drive has been conducted under the aegis of MGNREGA scheme.

 Under this drive plantation has been done alongside roads, conventional water tanks, public and private properties.

- Under this initiative, arrangements for the maintenance of plant saplings has also been done.
- It is worth noting that MGNREGA is an employment generation scheme initiated by Government of India as employment guarantee scheme at local level.










#### 4. Mithilesh Tiwari:

- It will make the tiresome task of police patrolling a bit more comfortable.







### 7. Women Skill Center:

- Recently Bihar
  Government has announced to open Skill
   Development Center in
   Bihta, Bihar.
- This is an initiative under HRD Ministry Bihar.
- Under women across the state shall be given



professional training in various streams.

- It will create various self employment opportunities among women of the state and will make them self depended and empowered.
- This will provide job opportunities for about 20 lac.
- Notably this announcement was made by the concerned Minister Shri Jeevesh Kumar Mishra.

# 8. Varanasi-Howra Corridor:

- Recently Government of India announced the construction of Varanasi-Howra Rail Corridor.
- It will be a High-Speed Rail corridor extending from










Varanasi in U. P. to Howra in West Bengal.

- It will also include 5 districts of Bihar.
- The districts which will be included are Buxar, Bhojpur, Patna, Nalanda and Navada.
- The tracks which will be laid down in these districts will only run high Speed Trains.
- The High Speed Trains are also popularly known as "Bullet Trains".

# 9. Mahendra Singh Dhoni:

- Recently former Indian Captain Mahendra Singh Dhoni has left the Captaincy of IPL team Chennai Super Kings(CSK).
- Indian All-Rounder Ravindra Jadeja has replaced him as the captain.
- Mahendra Singh is considered as the second best captain in IPL history.



- He has successfully led his team in 2010, 2011, 2018 and 2021 versions of IPL by leading CSK to the IPL titles.
- By now Mumbai Indians is the most successful team of IPL with five IPL titles.
- IPL was established in the year 2007.
- It's first trophy was organized in the year 2008

- This scheme based on 3-E principle i.e., EDUCATION, EGALITARIANISM and ENTREPRENEURSHIP.


