MAT Syllabus

The Management Aptitude Test (MAT) is a national-level entrance test for admission into more than 600 B Schools. In the year 2003, MAT was approved by the Govt. of India, Ministry of HRD as a national level test. MAT is usually conducted 4 times a year - February, May, September, and December. Candidates can take the MAT exam in any of the modes given below:

- Remote Proctored Internet-Based Test (IBT)
- Double Remote Proctored Internet-Based Test (IBT)
- Paper-Based Test (PBT)
- Paper-Based Test and Remote Proctored Internet-Based Test (PBT+IBT)
- Double Paper Based Test (PBT)
- Computer Based Test (CBT)
- Computer Based Test and Remote Proctored Internet-Based Test (CBT+IBT)
- Paper-Based Test and Computer Based Test (PBT+CBT)

The MAT exam consists of 5 sections with a total of 200 questions. The duration of the exam is 150 minutes. Each question has four options out of which the candidate has to choose the correct one. Candidates can check the MAT Exam Pattern given below:

All questions carry equal marks and there is negative marking for the wrong answer. The marking pattern is however not given in the official website but based on previous year trends it has been seen that +1 mark is awarded for every correct response and -0.25 marks is deducted for every incorrect response.


Section-wise MAT Syllabus

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
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
