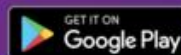

1. Vande Bharat Train To Start From Khajuraho:



- Recently Union Railway Minister Shri Ashwini Vaisnav has announced to initiate first Vande Bharat train from Khajuraho of M. P.

- Vande Bharat Express is also known as Train 18.

- It is an Indian semi-high speed intercity train which will connect Khajuraho with different parts of the country .

- It is noteworthy here that Khajuraho is a historical city of MP.
- It is known for its Chandel Dynasty architecture.
- The most famous among those is the Kandariya Mahadev temple.
- It is believed that this temple belongs to 10th Century C.E.

2. MP To Be Known As Wolf State:

- According to the recently released figures forests of Madhya Pradesh inhabit 772 wolfs.
- This has made MP to become the state with largest number of wolfs in India.

- Wolf is a carnivore which lives in tropical and sub tropical forests.
- Forests of MP offer suitable conditions for this species to survive and breed.
- Nauradehi Biosphere Reserve is considered as the best natural habitat for wolves in MP.
- Prior to wolf MP is also known as Tiger State of India.
- This honour was given to the state to inhabit the largest number of tigers in India.
- According to the figures released by the Government MP has 526 tigers in its forest.
- MP also has 11 forests dedicate as Tiger Reserves.

3. MP Archers To Participate In Asian Games:

- Muskan Kirar of MP has been selected to represent India in the upcoming Asian Games.
- She has been nurtured in MP Archery Academy.
- It is located in Jabalpur of MP.
- Muskan is a resident of Jabalpur city of MP
- Muskan has earlier in the year 2018 Asian Games won Silver Medal.
- She was also honored with Vikram Award for her contribution in sports.



- Along with Muskan Kirar, Ragini Marco is also selected for 2022 Asian Games.
- Ragini Marco also belongs to Jabalpur district of MP.
- It is worth noting here that the next Asian Games shall be held in China in the year 2022.

4. E-Prime Mover Machine:



- It is a multitasking agricultural equipment.
- It has been developed by Central Institute of Agricultural Engineering, Bhopal.
- It is a solar powered machine which will have zero carbon emission.
- It is a multi-purpose equipment which is capable of weeding, hoeing and transplanting.
- It also is able to spray insecticides.
- It is highly efficient eg. it can spray insecticide on one acre of land in just half an hour.



- It is worth noting here that Central Institute of Agricultural Engineering was established in Bhopal in the year 1976.

5. Export Preparedness Index 2021:



- Recently NITI Aayog of India has released Export Preparedness Index 2021.
- According to this index MP stands 7th among Indian States in terms of export preparedness.
- Among big states Gujarat stands at the top of the list.
- It is an initiative to promote Indian states as export destinations so as to better the balance of payment in favour of India.
- It is worth noting here that NITI Aayog is the Central Planning Agency of India.
- It has replaced the erstwhile Planning Commission of India.
- It was formed by a Cabinet Resolution in the year 2015.



6. National Water Award 2020:

- Recently Indore of Madhya Pradesh has received National Water Award 2020.
- It has been awarded as the best district in West Zone in water conservation.
- This award was conferred by President Ramnath Kovind in Vigyan Bhavan of New Delhi.
- Indore has been found doing excellent works in terms of water conservation, water recycling, sewerage system management etc.
- Indore is also known for its upto the mark cleanliness drive.
- It has been consistently securing the seat of cleanest city of the nation.



7. Bhopal To Get Its 5-G Network:

- Bhopal of Madhya Pradesh is all set to become India's first Smart City to have 5-G connections facility.
- It is expected that by the end of the year 5-G connections will be rolled out in public arena.
- 5-G is the fifth generation mobile broad band technology.
- Worldwide it has been implemented in the year 2019 itself.
- In India on pilot project basis the 5 –G connections will be started in 4 cities including the state capital.
- The other three chosen locations are Delhi, Bengaluru and Kandla of Gujarat.

9. Largest Bomb of India:

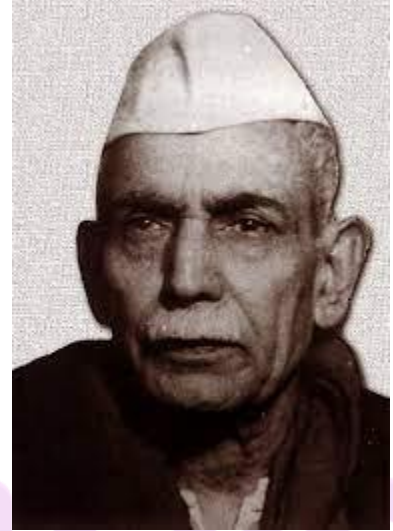


- The largest bomb of India has been manufactured in Ordnance Factory Khamariya.
- Khamariya is located in the Jabalpur District of MP.
- This bomb is named as the General purpose Bomb.
- It weighs around 500kg.
- Its length is 19m.
- It is capable of destroying entire Pakistan.
- It is worth noting that OFK or the Ordnance Factory Khamariya has been established in the year 1942.
- It is also popular for making crucial war equipment supplies during Kargil War.



10. Babai To Be Renamed As Makhannagar:

- Babai of MP is to be renamed as Makhannagar.
- Babai is a city in Narmadapuram District of MP.
- Earlier Narmadapuram was known as Hoshangabad.
- Babai is the birth place famous writer and freedom fighter Shri Makhan Lal Chaturvedi.
- The city is to be renamed in his honour.
- Shri Chaturvedi was born on 4th April 1889 in Babai of Madhya Pradesh.
- He was a famous freedom fighter and a novelist.
- He started publication of Karmveer from Jabalpur in the year 1919 to propagate nationalism.
- Later in the year 1955 he was awarded Sahitya Akademy Award for “Himatarangini”.
