Bihar Agricultural University National Seminar

Why in News:

Why in News:

key points:

- Under the 'She is a Changemaker' project, capacity-building programs for women representatives have been organized by the Commission in collaboration with sector-wise training institutes, aimed at improving their decision-making ability, communication skills, effective management, etc.
- Under this project, 49 training batches have been organized by the Commission in eight states so far, under which about 1700 women representatives of Panchayati Raj Institutions/Urban Local Bodies have been trained so far.

Why in News:

Floor test law

Why in News:

• The powers of the Governor under the Constitution call for a floor test to prove the party's majority in Parliament, possibly if the Shiv Sena loses its majority as chief minister in Maharashtra.



key points:

- Article 174(2)(b) of the Constitution empowers the Governor to dissolve the Assembly on the aid and advice of the Cabinet.
- Article 174 provides that the Governor shall from time to time summon the House or each House of the State Legislature to meet at such time and place as he thinks fit.
- However, Article 163 requires the Governor to act on the "aid and advice" of the Cabinet.







• An exception has also been included in the Constitution for summoning the House, which provides that when it appears that the Chief Minister has lost the majority and the legislative members of the House move a motion of no-confidence against the Chief Minister, The Governor himself can decide on the summoning of the House.

• Superfoods of the future for India

Why in News:

• National Millet Conference on the theme 'Super Food of the Future for India' inaugurated by Shri Prahlad Singh Patel, Minister of State for Food Processing Industries.



key points:

- The conference, organized by industry body ASSOCHAM in collaboration with the Ministry of Food Processing Industries, aims to deliberate on the opportunities and challenges of ensuring food and nutritional security.
- India is the 5th largest exporter of millet in the world and the major millet-producing states in India are Haryana, Uttar Pradesh, Chhattisgarh, Gujarat, Rajasthan, Madhya Pradesh, Maharashtra, Andhra Pradesh, Karnataka, Tamil Nadu, and Telangana.
- The production of coarse cereals in India has increased to 17.96 million tons in the year 2020-21 from 14.52 million tons in 2015-16 and the production of millet (pearl millet) also increased to 10.86 million tons in the same period.

- G20 health ministers meeting
- The inaugural session of the G20 Health Ministers' meeting organized in Yogyakarta, Indonesia by the Union Minister of Health and Family Welfare and Chemicals and Fertilizers, Dr. Mansukh Mandaviya, was addressed through a virtual medium.









- Indonesia hosted two Health Working Group meetings in Yogyakarta and Lombok to discuss priority issues such as 'coordinating global health protocol standards' and 'building the resilience of the global health system'.
- G20 countries account for 80 percent of the world's GDP and 80 percent of global cross-border trade, so the engagement and leadership of the G20 are critical to strengthening the global health infrastructure and management of any future health emergency.
- G20 countries aim to strengthen the need for health ecosystem assessment, health financing, and their engagement, based on experience gained in managing pandemics.

BRICS Business Forum 2022

Why in News:

• Prime Minister Narendra Modi Virtually participated in the meeting of the BRICS Business Forum organized in Beijing, the capital of China.



key points:

- BRICS is an acronym for a grouping of the world's leading emerging economies Brazil, Russia, India, China, and South Africa.
- The innovative idea of three mantras "Reform, Perform and Transform" was introduced by the Prime Minister at the BRICS Business Forum 2022 held in China to deal with the economic problems arising out of the pandemic.







- The 14th BRICS summit this year assumes significance as it has been held at the time of the Russo-Ukraine war and the US imposing harsh economic sanctions against Russia, a member of BRICS.
- Currently, the BRICS organization includes Brazil, Russia, India, China, and South Africa, although the new development bank of BRICS has expanded its scope to include the United Arab Emirates, Bangladesh, Uruguay, and Egypt.

Northern Ireland Protocol (NIP)

Why in News:

• A new law, the Northern Ireland Protocol Bill, has been introduced by the Boris Johnson administration aimed at enabling Britain to override the provisions of the Brexit deal relating to the trade arrangement in Northern Ireland.



key points:

- In accordance with the Northern Ireland Protocol, goods arriving in Northern Ireland will be checked at this 'sea border' before entering the island and will continue to comply with EU regulations in the Northern Ireland Product Standards.
- The main impediment to the UK in the current version of the Northern Ireland Protocol was the creation of "unacceptable barriers" to trade between Great Britain and Northern Ireland within the UK's internal market, which the Protocol seeks to reduce.
- Northern Ireland is the only part of the UK that shares a land border with the European Union.


- All India Consumer Price Index for Agricultural and Rural Laborers May 2022
- All India Consumer Price Index for Agriculture and Rural Labor released for the month of May.

- The All-India Consumer Price Index for Agricultural and Rural Laborers is at 1119 and 1131 points respectively with an increase of 11 and 12 points for the month of May.
- The main contributor to this change in the index is the food group with a score of 7.44 and 7.65 points respectively, mainly due to an increase in prices of rice, wheat-atta, jowar, bajra, milk, meat-goat, fish fresh/dry, chilies dry, mixed spices, vegetables & fruits, etc.
- In the released index for agricultural workers, the state of Tamil Nadu tops with 1294 points while Himachal Pradesh is at the bottom with 883 points.
- In the released index for rural workers, Tamil Nadu state tops with 1281 points, while Himachal Pradesh is at the bottom with 934 points.

• The unemployment rate in India

Why in News:

 According to the Periodic Labor Force Survey (PLFS) for the year 2020-21 released by the Ministry of Statistics and Programs, India has registered a decrease of 0.6% in the unemployment rate during the year 2020-21.



key points:

• As per the survey, the unemployment rate has been recorded at 3.3% in rural areas and 6.7% in urban areas.







- According to the report, the Labor Force Participation Rate (LFPR) in the year 2020-21, the percentage of persons in the labor force in the population was 41.6% as against 40.1% in the previous year.
- In the periodic labor force survey released under the Ministry of Statistics and Programs, the worker population ratio is defined as the percentage of employed persons in the population.
- The survey defines migrants as a member of a family whose last common place of residence was, at any time in the past, different from the current place of enumeration.

BRO Cafe

Why in News:

• The Ministry of Defense has approved the setting up of roadside facilities at 75 locations along the border roads of Border Roads Organization (BRO) in 12 States/Union Territories.









- The purpose of BRO Cafe is to provide basic facilities to the tourists as well as to accelerate economic activities in the border areas.
- BRO Cafe has been constituted with the objective of meeting the strategic needs of the border areas as well as working towards socio-economic advancement in the northern and eastern borders.
- The facilities provided under BRO Cafe include two-wheeler and four-wheeler parking, a food plaza/restaurant, separate toilet facilities for women, men, and differently abled, and a first-aid facility/MI room, etc.
- Under this scheme, roadside facilities will be developed and operated in a public-private partnership with agencies, the period of agreement with the agencies will be 15 years and can be extended for a period of five years.

- This new variant of BRATA uses advanced technology (APT) and allows hackers to stay on infected networks for a long time.
- The BRATA Trojan malware allows cybercriminals to monitor a smartphone, triggering the Trojan as soon as a person logs into the banking app and copies the banking credentials to hackers.

Why in the News:

Four new corals recovered from Indian waters



- Four species of Azoxanthellate corals were recorded for the first time from the waters of the Andaman and Nicobar Islands.
- All four groups of corals belong to the same family Flabellidae.
- Azooxanthelate corals are a group of corals that do not contain zooxanthellae and obtain nutrition from the capture of various forms of plankton, not from the sun.
- These groups of corals are found in the deep sea, with most species between 200 m and 1000 m, and they also get a lot of nutrition from shallow coastal waters.

'Jail Filling Station' scheme

Why in News:

• The Haryana government has planned to set up fuel stations in the outer campuses of 11 jails of Haryana on the lines of the fuel stations set up by the Telangana government.









- These jail filling stations will be set up by the state of Haryana in collaboration with Indian Oil Corporation Limited and at present, a petrol pump has been set up at Kurukshetra Jail as a pilot project by the government.
- After Kurukshetra, similar fuel stations will be operated from the jails of Ambala, Yamunanagar, Karnal, Jhajjar, Faridabad, Gurgaon, Bhiwani, Jind, and Hisar.
- Prisoners convicted of good conduct who have spent a considerable amount of time in prisons in proportion to their prison term will be allowed to work at these fuel stations, and prisoners working at petrol pumps will be paid wages as per prison manuals. will be provided.
- The main objective of the 'Jail Filling Station' scheme is to make prisoners a part of society.

• Inauguration of Historic Torch Relay for 44th Chess Olympiad at Indira Gandhi Stadium

Why in News:

• The historic torch relay for the 44th Chess Olympiad was inaugurated by the Prime Minister, Shri Narendra Modi, at the Indira Gandhi Stadium in New Delhi.



key points:

- This year, for the first time, the Chess Olympiad torch has been launched by the International Chess Federation-FIDE in line with the Olympic tradition.
- Presented by Prime Minister Shri Narendra Modi to Grandmaster Viswanathan Anand during the conference, the torch will be carried over 40 days to 75 cities where the torch will be handed over to the Chess Grandmaster of the respective state at each location.
- The final destination of this torch is Mahabalipuram near Chennai and this year the 44th Chess Olympiad will be held in Chennai
- Under-17 Asian Championship



- India's women's wrestling team won the Under-17 Asian Championship title held in Bishkek, Kyrgyzstan.
- India topped the points table with 235 points with eight gold, one silver, and one bronze medal in this championship.
- After India, Japan is second with 143 points and Mongolia with 138 points is placed third in the points table.







• In the Under-17 Asian Championship, Ritika won gold in the 43 kg category, Ahilya Shinde gold in the 49 kg category, Shiksha in the 57 kg category, gold by Priya in the 73 kg category while Pulkit won silver in the 65 kg category.

The year 2022 edition of the Reuters Institute Digital News Report has been released.










- The Reuters Institute Digital News Report, commissioned by the Reuters Institute for the Study of Journalism, is an annual study that tracks how news is consumed in different countries.
- This year's Reuters Institute Digital News Report, Eleventh, is based on a survey conducted by British market research and data analytics firm YouGuv.
- This year's report identified six key trends that could have wide-ranging socio-political implications.
 - 1. According to the report, people are trusting news content the least, with the average level of trust in the news at 42%, which is lower than the previous year.
 - 2. According to the survey, there has been an average decline in the use of traditional news media in almost all countries.
 - 3. The proportion of news consumers according to the report has been overworked, with the report describing the phenomenon as "selective avoidance".
 - 4. Despite a small increase in the proportion of people willing to pay for online news (mostly in wealthy countries), the level of growth in digital subscriptions to news content has decreased.
 - 5. The "smartphone has become the dominant way most people read the news first thing in the morning", replacing the traditional newspaper.
 - 6. According to the survey, there has been an increase in the number of people reading news through social media platforms like Facebook and Tiktok instead of traditional media.

• Dr. Syama Prasad Mookerjee (July 6, 1901 - June 23, 1953)



- Prime Minister Shri Narendra Modi pays tribute to Dr. Syama Prasad Mookerjee on his death anniversary.
- Dr. Syama Prasad Mookerjee was born on July 6, 1901, in Calcutta.
- Dr. Syama Prasad Mookerjee was appointed as the Vice-Chancellor of the University of Calcutta in the year 1934 and in the year 1944 he was appointed as the President of 'Hindu Mahasabha'.
- Dr. Shyama Prasad Mookerjee was inducted as Minister of Industry and Supplies in the interim government by Pandit Nehru, however, later Dr. Shyama Prasad Mookerjee resigned from this position, and in 1951'Bharatiya Jana Sangh' was established by Dr. Shyama Prasad Mookerjee in Delhi.
- A movement was launched by Dr. Shyama Prasad Mookerjee to abolish Article 370 in Jammu and Kashmir, in which he gave the slogan "Ek Nishan, Ek Vidhan, Ek Pradhan".







• Dr. Shyama Prasad Mookerjee died on June 23, 1953.

- The Jyotirgamaya festival is also attended by street performers, train entertainers, and temple artists.
- The festival has been conceived with an aim to sensitize people about the experience of playing rare musical instruments as well as the need to preserve the skills of making them and recognize those 'unknown' artists.
- This is a unique effort by the Sangeet Natak Akademi to once again bring the lost arts from India into the limelight and this unique initiative will continue even after the celebration of World Music Day.
