### 1. 12th meeting of BRICS Agriculture Ministers

#### Why in News:

• In the 12th meeting of the BRICS Agriculture Ministers, India was represented by the Minister of State for Agriculture, Ms. Shobha Karandlaje.

#### key points:

• This year the 12th meeting of the BRICS Agriculture Ministers was held through a



virtual medium in which the ministers of China, South Africa, Brazil, Russia, and India participated.

- The theme of the 12th meeting of BRICS Agriculture Ministers was "Strengthening BRICS Cooperation for Integrated Agriculture and Rural Development".
- During the 12th meeting of the BRICS Agriculture Ministers, the BRICS Strategy on Food Security Cooperation amongst the BRICS member countries along with the Joint Declaration of the 12th Meeting was also adopted by the member countries.
- This year India has emphasized its resolve to meet the Sustainable Development Goals of ending hunger and increasing production and productivity of agriculture through sustainable use of natural resources and called upon member countries to adopt the same.

### 2. 4th State Food Security Index

#### Why in News:

• The Union Minister of Health and Family Welfare, Dr. Mansukh Mandaviya has released the Fourth State Food Security Index (SFSI) for the year 2021-22.

#### key points:



- Tamil Nadu topped the list of large states for the year 2021-22 while Gujarat and Maharashtra stood second and third respectively.
- Goa has got first place in the list of small states, followed by Manipur and Sikkim.
- In the list of Union Territories, this year Jammu and Kashmir, Delhi, and Chandigarh have secured first, second and third place respectively.
- The State Food Security Index was launched in 2018-19 with an objective to bring about a competitive and positive change in the food security ecosystem in the country.
- The State Food Security Index ranks states on the basis of their performance on five parameters of food security set by the Ministry of Health.
- This ranking is done by the Food Safety and Standards Authority of India (FSSAI).

### 7. Ban on use of coal in Delhi-NCR

#### Why in News:

• The Air Quality Management Commission (CAQM) has ordered a ban on the use of coal for industrial, domestic, and other miscellaneous applications across the Delhi-NCR region with effect from January 1, 2023.



### key points:

- The Air Quality Management Commission (CAQM) has been exempted from the ban on the use of coal as well as the use of low sulfur coal in thermal power plants.
- It aims to reduce the emission of greenhouse gases in Delhi NCR.
- Delhi was recently placed on the list of most polluted cities according to the pollution index, so this move will help in improving the ranking of the capital Delhi and will also save around 17 lakh tonnes of coal annually.
