

$$\Rightarrow \frac{208}{52} = ? + 8 - 276$$

$$\Rightarrow 4 = ? + 8 - 276$$

$$\Rightarrow 4 = ? - 268$$

$$\Rightarrow ? = 272$$

Thus, the missing number is 160.

Therefore, cost price of the article is Rs. 600.

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10 women 1 days work = $\frac{1}{8} \Rightarrow 1$ women 1 day work = $\frac{1}{80}$

10 boys 1 day work = $\frac{1}{12} \Rightarrow 1$ boys 1 day work = $\frac{1}{120}$

(6 women + 3 boys) 1 day work = $\left(\frac{6}{80} + \frac{3}{120}\right) = \left(\frac{3}{40} + \frac{1}{40}\right) = \frac{4}{40} = \frac{1}{10}$

So, they can finish the work in 10 days.

$$\text{Required length} = \frac{2.5x+x}{50} - \frac{x}{50} = 16$$

$$2.5x = 50 \times 16$$

$$x = 320$$

The number of new companies registered in the year 2005 = 70 - 20% of 70
= 70 - 14 = 56

Hence, the required ratio = (44 + 56) : (60 + 13) = 100 : 130 = 10 : 13.



19. Ans. B.

The term 'here' is a demonstrative pronoun denoting position, in this case the position of the grave. While 'hear' is the ability to perceive sounds; 'hour' is a measure of time; 'hair' is a bodily growth, and 'honour' denote respect; and are all contextually inappropriate.

20. Ans. B.

In the present perfect tense, it is customary to use the participle form of the verb, in this case 'received', with the auxiliary 'has'.

Thus, option B is the correct answer.

21. Ans. E.

There is no error in this sentence and no correction required. Thus, option E is the correct answer.

22. Ans. C.



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The error is in the third part of the sentence. The term 'persisting' is an adjective. To qualify an adjective, an adverb is needed. 'Stubborn' needs to be changed to 'stubbornly' to make this sentence correct. Thus, option C is the correct answer.

23. Ans. B.

Option B has correctly spelt word i.e. 'grandiose' which means impressive because of unnecessary largeness or grandeur; used to show disapproval.

Meaning of other words with correct spelling are :-

Bequeathed = leave or give by will after one's death.

Limpid = clear and bright.

Impetuous = characterized by undue haste and lack of thought or deliberation.

Astute = very clever; good at judging people or situations

24. Ans. C.

Option C has correctly spelt word i.e. 'magnanimous' which means generous and understanding and tolerant.

Ingenious = showing inventiveness and skill.

Absolution = the condition of being formally forgiven by a priest in the sacrament of penance.

Insomnia = an inability to sleep, chronic sleeplessness.

Crucifixion = the act of crucifying somebody

25. Ans. B.

After an article, we must use a noun. 'Complain' is a verb, the noun form is 'Complaint'.

Also, the correct verb to use with 'complaint' is "file" which means "submit a legal document or application or charge, to be placed on record by the appropriate authority". We 'fill' a form and 'file' a complaint or charge. As the sentence is in past tense the verb will become "filed".

The correct preposition to use here is 'against' because it follows "filed a complaint" always.

Hence, option A is the correct answer.
