## International Relations

**For the first time, India will assume the presidency of G20 till December 2022**

### Why in News:

- India will serve as the G20 grouping's chair in 2023, and the Union Cabinet has approved the establishment of the G20 Secretariat and accompanying entities.

### Key Points:

- From December 1, 2022, through November 30, 2023, India will serve as the G20's chair. The G20 summit will take place in India the following year.
- The G20 is a loose alliance of 19 nations, including the European Union, as well as the World Bank, and the International Monetary Fund.
- G20 countries account for more than 80% of global GDP, 75% of global trade, and 60% of the global population.
- A ministerial forum, the G20 was created by the G7 with the help of both developed and developing economies.
- Since 1999, the G20 has gathered finance ministers and governors of central banks annually.
- The decision to host a meeting of the leaders of the G20 nations once a year came about as a result of the globe realizing the need for a new political consensus during the 2008 financial crisis.
- Twice a year, representatives of the World Bank and the International Monetary Fund attend meetings of the central bank governors and finance ministers of the G20 countries.
- Argentina, Australia, Brazil, Canada, China, the European Union, France, Germany, India, Indonesia, Italy, Mexico, Russia, Saudi Arabia, South Africa, South Korea, Turkey, the United Kingdom, and the United States are all members of the G20.

## 75th anniversary of India-Egypt diplomatic relations

### Why in News:

- A postage stamp has been issued by Egypt to commemorate the 75th anniversary of diplomatic relations with India.

### key points:

- India's independence was recognized by Egypt on 18 August 1947, three days after its independence, which marked the beginning of diplomatic relations between India and Egypt.
- Relations between the two countries deepened in the 1950s, resulting in a historic friendship treaty in 1955.
- Egypt is one of the largest investment destinations for India in the region with a current Indian investment of USD 3.15 billion.
- India-Egypt bilateral trade stood at a historic record high of US\$ 7.26 billion in FY 2021-22, an increase of 75% from FY 2020-21.
- Currently, under the 5th India-Egypt Joint Business Council meeting, the annual bilateral trade target of USD 12 billion over 5 years has been set by both sides.
- The bilateral military exercise Desert Warrior is also organized jointly by India and Egypt.
- The exercise, organized by India and Egypt, is organized to enhance mutual understanding between the Indian Air Force and the Egyptian Air Force.

## South Korea and the United States begin their largest joint military exercise

### Why in News:

- The largest joint military drill between South Korea and the United States in years has begun with the restart of field training.

### Key Points:



- The annual summer exercise's name has been changed to "Ulchi Freedom Shield" this year, and it will continue through September 1, 2022.
- For the first time since the coronavirus outbreak, South Korea has begun a four-day Ulchi civil defense exercise that is specially intended to improve government preparation.
- With the aid of these civil and military exercises, the government seeks to increase the nation's readiness to accommodate the evolving nature of warfare.
- After South Korea and the US started the exercise's preliminary training, North Korea launched two missiles off its west coast.

- The Allies will conduct a total of 11 regional training programs, including one at the brigade level that will be attended by thousands of soldiers, according to the Seoul Ministry of Defense.

## Greece's exit from the EU's advanced surveillance framework

### Why in News:

- Greece's exit from the EU's enhanced surveillance framework for Greece's economy is meant to end 12 years of suffering and give it more flexibility to formulate its policies.

### key points:

- Greece's economic performance and policies have been closely monitored since 2018 under the framework to ensure that the reforms were undertaken during the three multilateral bailouts from the European Union (EU) and the IMF between 2010 and 2015 to be completed, totaling more than EUR 260 billion.



- It was announced by EU officials that "Athens had largely fulfilled its obligations."
- After being forced to take its first bailout in 2010, Greece was the victim of pension cuts, spending restrictions, tax hikes, and bank regulations that caused the economy to shrink by 25%.
- The monitoring system was designed to ensure that ongoing structural reforms support sustainable economic growth and steps are taken to address potential sources of economic distress.
- The country's objective of achieving an "investment grade" credit rating is also closed to being achieved if Greece emerges from increased supervision.

## Paraguay: Mahatma Gandhi's statue unveiled

### Why in News:

- A statue of Mahatma Gandhi has been unveiled in Paraguay by External Affairs Minister S Jaishankar during his first official visit to South America.

### key points:

- The decision of Asuncion Municipality to put up a statue of Mahatma Gandhi on the main bank of the city was also praised by External Affairs Minister S Jaishankar.
- External Affairs Minister S Jaishankar is on an official visit to Brazil, Paraguay, and Argentina from 22-27 August.
- The newly opened Indian Embassy complex was inaugurated by S Jaishankar during his visit, which started functioning in January 2022 in Paraguay.
- During his visit to Paraguay, S Jaishankar also visited the historic Casa de la Independencies, from where the South American country's independence movement began more than two centuries ago.



- Mr. Jaishankar arrived in Brazil on the first leg of his six-day visit to South America, aimed at boosting overall bilateral ties with the region.
- Shri Jaishankar met envoys from Latin America and the Caribbean in New Delhi, with a focus on promoting holistic bilateral relations.
- The purpose of the External Affairs Minister's visit is to explore new areas of cooperation in the post-pandemic era.

## HAL to set up its first overseas marketing office in Malaysia

### Why in News:

- A Memorandum of Understanding (MoU) has been signed by Hindustan Aeronautics Limited (HAL) to set up its first international marketing and sales office in Kuala Lumpur in anticipation of a possible deal for Light Combat Aircraft (LCA) Tejas in Malaysia.

### key points:

- The HAL's capacity to office in Kuala Lumpur by Hindustan Aeronautics Limited was signed to achieve the agreement, as well as to meet other requirements of the Royal Malaysian Air Force.
- Following a global tender issued by the Malaysian Defense Ministry in October 2021, the supply of 18 FLIT LCAs was proposed by Hindustan Aeronautics Limited.
- Hindustan Aeronautics Limited is also looking at offering RMAF Su-30 spare parts.
- The office will be the first in Malaysia to be focused entirely on marketing and commercial development.
- Egypt and HAL are in discussions on a possible sale of LCA Tejas, India has also promised to build a manufacturing plant in Egypt.

- The aircraft will function as a force multiplier, allowing Sri Lanka to combat a variety of difficulties in its coastal waterways, including human and drug trafficking, smuggling, and other organized forms of crime.

- Reflecting its commitment to the Indo-Pacific region, India stated that as a nation at the heart of the Indian Ocean, India is committed to a free, open, secure, and inclusive Indo-Pacific region and India aims to establish regional and regional developments in the Indian Ocean. ## UK: The first country to approve Omicron vaccine

### Why in News:

- The United Kingdom has approved the COVID-19 vaccination for the Omicron version for the first time.

### Key Points:

- The Omicron vaccination was first authorized in the United Kingdom.
- The UK's Medicines and Healthcare products Regulatory Authority has approved a COVID-19 vaccination that is compatible with the Omicron version, paving the way for an autumn booster campaign utilizing Moderna's two-strain injection.
- Drugs and Health Care Products Regulatory Authority gave the vaccination conditional authorization.
- The permitted vaccination is a supplement to the original coronavirus and the Omicron BA.1 strain.
- People over the age of 18 are permitted to utilize it.
- The UK will currently concentrate its booster program on persons over 50 who are extremely susceptible to getting COVID.
- SARS-Omicron CoV-2's B.1.1.1.529 is a variation.
- The variant was discovered for the first time in Botswana in November 2021 and was initially reported in South Africa by the Network for Genomics Surveillance. Since then, it has spread throughout the world to become a significant variant that is currently in use.

## Russia successfully launches Iran's satellite into orbit

### Why in News:

- An Iranian satellite has been successfully launched into orbit from southern Kazakhstan by a Russian rocket.



### key points:

- An Iranian satellite named Khayyam has been successfully launched into orbit by a Soyuz rocket from Russia's leased Baikonur launch facility in Kazakhstan.
- The satellite was named after the Persian scientist Omar Khayyam, who lived in Iran in the 11th and 12th centuries.
- According to Iran, the satellite is designed for scientific research including radiation and environmental monitoring for agricultural purposes.
- Telemetry data has been received from the first satellite sent by Iran's space agency.
- The satellite, equipped with a high-resolution camera launched by Iran, will be used for environmental monitoring and will be completely under its control.
- If this Iranian satellite operates successfully, the satellite will give Iran the ability to monitor its arch-enemy Israel and other countries in the Middle East.
- The capital of Russia is Moscow, and the official currency of Russia is Rubel.
- The current President of Russia is Vladimir Putin.

## Argentine Rear Admiral Guillermo Pablo Rios named head of UNMOGIP

### Why in News:

- Rear Admiral Guillermo Pablo Ros, a seasoned member of the Argentine navy, has been appointed by UN Secretary-General Antonio Guterres as the UNMOGIP's Chief of Mission and Chief Military Observer in India and Pakistan.



## Key Points:

- Major General Jose Eladio Alcán of Uruguay has handed over command of the mission to Rear Admiral Guillermo Pablo Ro of Argentina. The UNMOGIP is almost finished.
- Rear Admiral Guillermo Pablo Ros has reportedly been a member of the Argentine Navy for a significant amount of time since joining as a middle sailor in 1988 after graduating from the Naval Academy.
- Prior to 2022, Rear Admiral Guillermo Pablo Roa was the General Director of Education, Training, and Doctrine for the Joint Staff.
- During the years 2018 and 2020–21, Rear Admiral Guillermo Pablo Rosas held the positions of Marine Infantry Fleet Commander and Marine Infantry Commander (Years 2020-2021).
- In 2002–2003, Rear Admiral Guillermo Pablo Ros took part in an exchange program with the Argentine Marines while serving as a training officer in a US Marine Corps regiment.
- As of November 2021, 111 people from UNMOGIP, including 68 civilians and 43 mission specialists, were on the ground.

## Sweden and Finland approved by the US Senate to join NATO

### Why in News:

- The NATO membership of Sweden and Finland was conclusively approved by the US Senate.

### key points:

- The proposal for Finland and Sweden's membership in NATO was supported by US President Joe Biden, who sent the proposal to the Senate for consideration in July.
- The application was submitted by Sweden and Finland to join the Western Defense Alliance in the wake of Russia's invasion of Ukraine.
- Earlier, the French National Assembly had also approved the proposal.
- A country requires the support of all 30 NATO member states to become a member of NATO, with Sweden and Finland currently supported by two-thirds of the member states.



- Earlier, Montenegro and North Macedonia were included in NATO in the year 2017 and in the year 2020, with which the number of its member countries has increased to 30.
- NATO, better known as the North Atlantic Treaty Organization, was established on April 4, 1949, in Washington, USA by the 12 founding members.
- NATO is an intergovernmental military organization headquartered in Brussels, the capital of Belgium.
- NATO works on the principle of collective defense, according to which if one or more members are attacked, then this attack is considered an attack on all member countries.
- The principle of collective defense is enshrined in Article 5 of NATO which was implemented after the terrorist attack on the United States.


## ASEAN celebrated its 55th anniversary in 2022

### key points:

A panel discussion to celebrate the 55th anniversary of ASEAN has also been organized by the Research and Information System for Developing Countries (RIS) at the ASEAN-India Center (AIC) in New Delhi.
- The theme of this year's ASEAN Day is "Strong Together" which invites the leaders of ASEAN to work collectively to meet the challenges of the 21st century.
- ASEAN was established with the signing of the 1967 ASEAN Declaration, popularly known as the Bangkok Declaration, by the founding nations.
- The founding nations of ASEAN are Indonesia, Malaysia, the Philippines, Singapore, and Thailand.
- The full name of ASEAN is the Association of Southeast Asian Nations, a regional organization of Southeast Asian nations formed to promote political and social stability amid rising tensions among the colonizing nations of the Asia-Pacific. was.
- The Secretariat of ASEAN is located in Jakarta, the capital of Indonesia.
- Indonesia, Malaysia, Philippines, Singapore, Thailand, Brunei, Vietnam, Laos, Myanmar, and Cambodia are the member states of ASEAN.

## China: launch of reusable spacecraft

### Why in News:

- A pilot reusable spacecraft was successfully launched by China with a Long March-2F carrier rocket.



## key points:

- The spacecraft, which was launched from China's Jiuquan Satellite Launch Center, will return to a planned landing site after being operated in orbit for some time with the aim of providing technical verification for reuse.
- China's Long March 2F Launch Vehicle primarily launches China's Shenzhou Crew Mission with a payload capacity of about 8 metric tons in low Earth orbit.
- The new spacecraft, similar in size to the US Air Force's X-37B space plane, has been modified to assist in the launch of the Long March 2F and its payload as a 'reusable test spacecraft'.
- Prior to this, China conducted an orbital test of a reusable experimental spacecraft in September 2020 which spent just 2 days in orbit.
- This mission is produced by the Chinese main space agency, CASC.

- Listed companies in the Fortune 500 list are ranked based on their sales.

## Sakurajima Volcanic Eruption: Volcano Erupts for three days

### Why in News:

- An increase in the incidence of volcanic eruptions has been recorded in Japan's main southern island of Kyushu.



## key points:

- The alert level for the explosion has been raised to five based on the intensity of the explosion on Japan's main southern island of Kyushu.
- After the eruption, red-hot rocks and dark smoke began to erupt from the Sakurajima volcano in Kagoshima Prefecture, Japan.
- Due to the volcanic eruption, the rocks in the southern part of the city have come out in the form of eruptions up to 2.5 km away.
- A volcano is an opening or rupture in the Earth's surface that ejects hot liquid and semi-liquid rocks, volcanic ash, and gases in the form of magma, and a volcanic eruption occurs when lava and gas erupt from a volcano. The gas sometimes comes out in an explosive form.
- Sakurajima is located on the main southern island of Kyushu in Japan, and Sakurajima is the island with the largest number of active volcanoes in Japan that erupt frequently.
- Sakurajima is located about 1000 km southwest of Tokyo. In the year 1914, Sakurajima experienced an extremely explosive volcanic eruption that made it a peninsula.

### India to have 1.8 lakh km of highways and 1.2 lakh km of rail lines by 2025

#### Why in News:

- According to a report by Bank of America Securities India, India is estimated to have 1.8 lakh km of highways and 1.2 lakh km of rail lines by the year 2025.



#### key points:

- According to the new report presented by Bank of America Securities India, the length of all national highways in India is estimated to reach about 1.8 lakh km, with the target of laying 1.2 lakh km of



railway lines by 2025 if India continues to work at the same pace. will complete.

- Between 1950 and 2015, 4000 km of new national highways were constructed in India, up from 77,000 km in 2015.
- According to a new report presented by Bank of America Securities India, the target of reaching 1.8 lakh km of highways by the year 2025 is more than double the current length.
- In the year 1950, the railway network in India was only 10,000 km of rail lines which had grown to 63,000 km by the year 2015.
- According to the latest report submitted by Bank of America Securities India, the length of the railway line is to reach 1.2 lakh kilometers by the year 2025.

## HPCL launches its first dung-based compressed biogas project

### Why in News:

- The first compressed biogas project based on dung has been started by HPCL.



## Key Points:

- In this HPCL project, biogas, which can be used as fuel for vehicles, will be produced using 100 tons of cow manure per day.
- The framework for the HPCL Compressed Biogas Project Initiative was the GOBAR-Dhan plan, which was unveiled by the Indian government in April 2018 as a part of the Swachh Bharat Mission (Gramin) Biodegradable Waste Management component.
- With the help of livestock and organic waste, the HPCL Compressed Biogas Project scheme hopes to enhance sanitation while producing money and energy.
- The foundation stone laying ceremony for this project run by HPCL was organized by Shree Godham Mahatirth Pathmeda Lok Punyarth Trust, located in the Rajasthani village of Pathmeda in the Tehsil of Sanchore and District of Jalore.
- Agricultural waste, manure, municipal trash, plant material, sewage, green waste, and food waste are all examples of natural materials that can be used to make biogas.
- Methane, carbon dioxide, and hydrogen sulfide are the three major gases found in biogas.
- Methane (CH<sub>4</sub>), a gas found in natural gas, and carbon dioxide make up the majority of biogas, which is a renewable energy source (CO<sub>2</sub>).


## Super Vasuki: Longest Freight Train of Indian Railways

- Indian Railways has tested its latest train named Super Vasuki.

- Super Vasuki is operated by the Southeast Central Railway (SECR) zone of Indian Railways.
- The Southeast Central Railway had run a record long-distance goods train last year in Vasuki and Trisula and before that the 2.8 km long Sheshnag train.

- During the test run, the train carried six locos, 295 wagons, and a gross weight of 25,962 tons, making it the longest and heaviest freight train run by the Railways.
- The Super Vasuki is three times the capacity of the existing railway rakes (90 cars of 100 tons each), which can carry around 9,000 tons of coal in a single journey.
- During testing, the Super Vasuki train has taken 11.20 hours to cover a distance of 267 km.

- As a new feature, Google Maps will also display the speed limit information shared by traffic officials starting from Bengaluru and Chandigarh.



  1. The first step involves making a request in the form of a motion by any Member of the Legislative Assembly (MLA).



2. The second stage involves deliberation on the request to change the name of the city or district.
  3. At the final stage, voting is done on the validity of the resolution. If there is a majority in favor of the motion, then the said resolution is declared passed and the name of the district or city is changed and if the majority of votes are not received for any resolution, then the resolution fails.
- A resolution to change the name of any district must be passed by a simple majority.
  - Babasaheb Dr. Bhimrao Ambedkar was born in the year 1891 in Mhow, Central Province.
  - Babasaheb Dr. Bhimrao Ambedkar is considered the father of the Indian Constitution and he was the first law minister of India as well as the chairman of the drafting committee for constitution making.

### Successfully Fight-Test India VL-SRSAM at Chandipur

#### Key Points:

- Off the coast of Chandipur, in the state of Odisha, the VL-SRSAM flight test was conducted.
- To show the Indian Navy ship's capacity to launch vertically, it was successfully piloted against a fast unmanned aerial target.
- Sea-skimming targets are among the many airborne threats that the VL-SRSAM is designed and developed to defeat at close range.
- Flight data will be used to track the test launch of VL-SRSAM, including the flight route and vehicle performance statistics.
- Several ranges of equipment, including the radar, Electro-Optical Tracking System (EOTS), and Telemetry System placed by ITR, Chandipur, recorded the flight data during the test launch.
- The VL-SRSAM is built to strike high-speed air targets at a height of roughly 15 km and at distances between 40 and 50 km.
- The Astra missile, an air-to-air missile with a range beyond visual range, served as the inspiration for the weapon's design.
- The VL-thrust SRSAM's vectoring system will be crucial in improving its engine's capacity to alter thrust direction to regulate the missile's angular velocity and altitude.
- The VL-SRSAM is a canister system, allowing it to be stored and used from compartments that have been specifically created for that purpose.

- The bomber is capable of infiltrating Pakistan and China and attacking major airports, warships, and aircraft carriers patrolling the seas.
- The Tu-160 bomber, unlike other fighters, can carry big missiles.






## Canadian Jeffrey Armstrong receives 'Distinguished Indologist for 2021' award


## World Day 2022 Against Trafficking in Persons

## Science & Technology

### IIT Guwahati develops technology to make sugar substitute "Xylitol"

#### Why in News:

- Researchers at IIT Guwahati have created a fermentation process that uses ultrasound to safely generate Xylitol from sugarcane bagasse, a byproduct of sugarcane crushing.



## key points:

- This approach would eliminate the operational constraints of chemical synthesis and the time lag of conventional fermentation.
- The use of ultrasound during the fermentation process by IIT Guwahati researchers has not only reduced the fermentation time to 15 hours but also increased the product yield by about 20%.
- Innovative technology to manufacture xylitol has led to an increase in the use of safer alternative sweeteners as awareness of the negative effects of white sugar (sucrose) on individuals with diabetes and general health has increased.
- To make xylitol industrially, D-xylose, a valuable chemical derived from wood, is processed with a nickel catalyst at extremely high temperatures and pressures, which makes the process extremely energy-intensive.
- The process of fermentation used by researchers at IIT Guwahati is not innovative, with many Indian households using a fermentation process to convert milk into curd.
- In fermentation, several types of microbes, including bacteria and yeast, are used to convert one material into another.
- In this process, researchers at IIT Guwahati first employed sugarcane bagasse, which is the remaining fibrous waste product after extracting sugarcane juice.
- A new fermentation technique has been used by researchers at IIT Guwahati, which uses ultrasonic waves to accelerate the microbe-induced synthesis of xylitol.

## NASA's Moon Landing Site for the Artemis III Mission

### Why in News:

- NASA has announced 13 potential landing sites for the Artemis III mission, which will send a woman and a person of color to the Moon for the first time.

### Key Points:

- The following 13 places have been chosen by NASA as probable landing sites for NASA's Artemis III mission: Peak Near Shackleton, Connecting Ridge, Connecting Ridge Extension, Howarth, Malapert Massif, Leibnitz Beta Plateau, Nobel Rim 1, Nobel Rim 2, and the Amundsen rim.
- The lunar South Pole is within six degrees of each region's location, lending scientific significance to these regions.
- Sunlight is required for the Moon's long stay since it serves as a power source and regulates the temperature.
- NASA and large scientific and engineering organisations will negotiate over the 13 prospective landing locations.
- The United States initially attempted to send humans into space in 1961; eight years later, on July 20, 1969, Neil Armstrong became the first human to set foot on the Moon as part of the Apollo 11 mission.



- The astronauts of the Apollo 11 mission left an American flag and a sign on the Moon.
- Along with the goal of space exploration, NASA's mission to return Americans to the Moon aims to demonstrate American leadership in space and build a strategic presence on the Moon.

- For the first time in India, researchers from Hyderabad have 3D printed an artificial cornea (a human cornea) and successfully implanted it in a rabbit's eye.



## Key Points:

- Researchers from the L V Prasad Eye Institute (LVPEI), Indian Institute of Technology-Hyderabad (IIT-H), and the Center for Cellular and Molecular Biology (CCMB) have developed a 3D-printed human cornea manufactured from human donor corneal tissue.
- The (3D-Printed Human Cornea) product is fully natural, free of synthetic components, and safe for use by patients. It was produced locally with assistance from governmental and charitable groups.
- Researchers from LVPEI, IITH, and CCMB used the decellularized corneal tissue matrix and stem cells produced from human eyes to create a unique biomimetic hydrogel.
- The foundation material for the 3D-printed human cornea is this hydrogel.
- Human corneal tissue was used to create the 3D-printed human cornea, which is biocompatible, all-natural, and free of any animal ingredients.

- Two distinct, concurrent clinical trials have been carried out to assess the efficacy of BBV154 as a primary dosage and a booster dose.
- Over 3000 people participated in primary dosage Phase III trials to evaluate the drug's immunogenicity and safety.
- This vaccination may be administered through the nose because of its design.
- The University of Washington and Bharat Biotech are working together to develop the nasal vaccination for BBV154.
- Bharat Biotech was founded in 1996, and the company's headquarters are in Hyderabad.

## SpaceX Launches South Korea's First Moon Mission, Danuri

### Why in News:

- South Korea launched its first lunar mission, which can also be called its first mission away from low Earth orbit.

### key points:

- The mission, formerly known as Korea Pathfinder Lunar Orbiter, launched by South Korea, is currently known as Danuri.
- Danuri is prevalent as a play on the Korean words for "moon" and "bliss".
- The Danuri mission, launched by South Korea, is operated by the Korean Aerospace Research Institute (KARI).
- Danuri was launched from Cape Canaveral Space Force Station on a SpaceX Falcon 9 rocket by the Korean Aerospace Research Institute.
- Before returning to its destination, Danuri will fly toward the Sun and enter lunar orbit in mid-December using gravity generated by the Sun.
- After reaching the Moon in a 62-mile-high orbit, Danuri will carry out research with six of its science instruments (a magnetometer, a gamma-ray spectrometer, an experimental communication system, and three cameras).
- If South Korea successfully completes this lunar mission, South Korea will become the eighth political body to complete a Moon mission after the United



States, the former Soviet Union, China, Japan, India, Luxembourg, and the European Union.

## ISRO launches the smallest rocket to display the tricolor in space

### Why in News:

- The Indian Space Research Organization (ISRO) launched its first Small Satellite Launch Vehicle, SSLV-D1/EOS-02 from the Sriharikota Satish Dhawan Space Center.



### key points:

- This is the first time that the Indian space agency ISRO has demonstrated its capabilities in launching an SSLV to place small satellites in low Earth orbit.
- The SSLV-D1/EOS-02, launched by ISRO, has been developed by a team of students from Earth Observation Satellite and Space Kids India named AzadiSat.
- On the occasion of the 75th anniversary of Indian Independence, girls from government schools across the country participated in the making of this eight-kg CubeSat that will encourage girls to pursue "Science, Technology, Engineering and Mathematics (STEM)" by ISRO. result of efforts.
- The SSLV developed by ISRO uses solid fuel in the first three stages and a liquid propulsion-based velocity trimming module in the fourth stage.
- The newly built AzadiSat requires minimal launch infrastructure as compared to PSLV and GSLV launch vehicles of ISRO.
- AzadiSat also includes a long-range transponder and a solid-state PIN diode-based radiation counter that will be helpful in measuring ionizing radiation in its orbit.
- A ground system built by ISRO Space Kids India has also been employed to engage and interact with AzadiSat in orbit.

## Earth's shortest day: complete rotation in less than 24 hours

### Why in News:

- A new record has been set for the Earth to complete one complete revolution in 1.59 milliseconds and one complete revolution in less than 24 hours.



### key points:

- It took the Earth 1.47 milliseconds to complete its rotation, which is less than the standard time of 24 hours.
- The reason for the increased speed of Earth's rotation is still unknown to scientists, although scientists attribute it to processes in the inner or outer layer of the oceans, tides, and climate change.
- According to some scientists, the reason for the increased speed of Earth's rotation may be related to the motion at the surface of Earth's geographic poles, known as the "Chandler's wobble".
- The Earth's rotation at such a high speed can register negative leap times.
- Negative leap seconds can have misleading results for electronic gadgets such as smartphones, computers, and other communication devices or systems.
- The Earth records the shortest day of the year on July 29.
- Prior to this, the fastest rotation was completed by the Earth on 19 July 2020, in which the time taken by the Earth was 1.47 milliseconds.

- As of 1986, English Heritage took charge of the planning and English Heritage has put up more than 360 plaques in over 900 buildings in London.

- Veer Durgadas Rathore, a Marwari warrior, oversaw the Rathore army during the Rajput War (1679–1707), and he also had a significant impact on the Rajput Rebellion (1708–1710), which was a crucial factor in the fall of the Mughal Empire.
- Veer Durgadas Rathore, a Marwari warrior, and Raja Jai Singh II of Jaipur were chosen as the rebellion's leaders.
- Veer Durgadas Rathore, a Marwari warrior, defeated the Mughals on numerous occasions and forced numerous Mughal officials to offer Chauth as a kind of tribute.

by the President in the exercise of the powers conferred by clause (2) of Article 124 of the Constitution of India.


- Earlier in August 2014, Justice Uday Umesh Lalit was appointed as a judge of the Supreme Court of India from the Bar Council.
- Under the provisions of Article 124(2) of the Constitution of India, the judges of the Supreme Court are appointed by the President after consultation with the Supreme Court and certain judges of the High Courts in the States (as many judges as the President deems fit for the purpose).
- According to the Indian Constitution, the following qualifications are necessary for the Chief Justice-

- Through his research, Prof. Ramadhar Singh also confirmed the fact how many cognitively rich and dynamic people were in the world.

- Jagdeep Dhankhar was working as a Lok Sabha MP from Jhunjhunu from 1989 to 1991 before becoming the Vice President and after that, he took over as the Minister of State for Parliamentary Affairs from 1990 to 1991.
- After this Jagdeep Dhankhar worked as a member of the Legislative Assembly from Krishnagar, Rajasthan from the year 1993 to the year 1998, and from the year 2019 to the present Jagdeep Dhankhar is working as the Governor of West Bengal.
- According to Article 68 of the Indian Constitution, an election to fill a vacancy caused by the termination of the office of the Vice-President must be held before the expiration of the term of the outgoing Vice-President.
- The Election Commission of India superintends, directs, and controls the conduct of the election of the Vice-President under the President and Vice-President's Election Act, 1952 and the President and Vice-President's Election Rules, 1974 as well as Article 324 of the Constitution.
- The Vice-President is elected by an electoral college consisting of elected members of the Rajya Sabha, nominated members of the Rajya Sabha, and elected members of the Lok Sabha.
