

SNAP Analysis 2020 - Day 2

(6th January, 2021)

SNAP 2020 Analysis: Symbiosis International (Deemed) University [SIU] has successfully conducted the second session of SNAP 2020-21 across different exam centres throughout the country on 6th January 2021. Check the detailed SNAP Exam Analysis 2021 below. The SNAP 2020 is conducted in 3 sessions, the second of which is held today on 6th January 2021. Now, the 3rd and last session for this season of SNAP 2020 will be held on 9th January 2021. According to the BYJU'S Exam Prep experts who have taken SNAP 2020 on January 5th, the overall exam was of MODERATE difficulty level.

Highlights of SNAP 2020 - Session-2 (6 January 2021)

- Easiest section - Logical Reasoning
- Tough section - Quant and DI was comparatively tougher than other 2 sections
- Overall difficulty level of SNAP 2020 Session-2 - Moderate

SNAP 2020 Paper Analysis: Difficulty Level

While doing the SNAP Exam Analysis 2020-21, we found that the difficulty level of the exam was MODERATE. Questions from the Quant and DI section were found to be tougher than other 2 sections.

- According to our survey, almost 45-50% of the candidates found Logical Reasoning section to be the easiest amongst all the three sections
- The candidates also said that Quant and DI section was comparatively tougher than other 2 sections
- Session 2 of SNAP 2020 was overall slightly tougher than Session 1 that was held on December 20, 2020.

SNAP 2020 Exam Analysis: Good Attempts/Score

According to the SNAP exam analysis 2021, a raw score of 38-40 is considered to be a good score to fetch 98 percentile and will allow candidates to get admission to top 5 institutes affiliated under SIU.

SNAP 2020 Exam Analysis (Section-Wise)

SNAP General English Exam Review - Session-2 (Jan 6)

This section was of MODERATE difficulty level than the other two sections. Let's find more details about today's questions from the General English section

- A total of 15 questions were asked in this section
- Surprisingly, there were NO QUESTIONS from
 - Reading Comprehension
 - Figures of Speech
 - Odd-One Out
- 5-6 questions of Fill In The Blanks
- 2-3 questions based on Vocabulary
- 1-2 questions based on Idioms and Phrases
- 1-2 questions from Para-Jumbles

SNAP Analytical and Logical Reasoning Exam Review 2021 - Session-2 (Jan 6)

This section was MODERATELY-EASY of all the sections. A total of 25 questions were asked in this section.

- A lot of questions were asked from Series (~5-6 questions) and Coding-Decoding (~3-4 questions)
- 2 questions each from Analogies and Direction Sense
- 1 question from Blood Relations
- 3-4 questions from Miscellaneous topics

SNAP Quantitative and DI Exam Review 2021 - Session-2 (Jan 6)

This section was MODERATELY DIFFICULT than other 2 sections. A total of 20 questions were asked from this section.

- Majority questions (~8 questions) were asked from Arithmetic
- 5 questions from Algebra
- 2 questions each from Trigonometry and Number System
- 1 question each from Mensuration, Probability and DI

SNAP Expected Cut Off 2021

The SNAP 2020-21 expected raw scores to fetch 98%ile for SNAP 2020 in session 2 (Jan 6) is 38-40 for the General category.

- For the General English section, the sectional scores could be anywhere between 11-13 to fetch 98+%ile
- For the Analytical and Logical Reasoning section, the sectional cut off could be anywhere between 17-18 to fetch 98+%ile
- And for Quantitative and DI section, the section cut off could be anywhere between 15-16 to fetch 98+%ile
