

# SNAP Analysis 2022 - Day 3

## (9th January, 2021)

SNAP 2020 Analysis 9th Jan (Session-3): Symbiosis International (Deemed) University [SIU] has successfully conducted the third and final session of SNAP 2020-21 across different exam centres throughout the country on 9<sup>th</sup> January 2021. The detailed SNAP Exam Analysis 2020 is given below. For the year 2020, the SNAP 2020 is conducted in 3 sessions. Today, on 9<sup>th</sup> January 2020, the third and final session was held. According to our experts who have appeared for SNAP 2020 on January 9<sup>th</sup>, the overall exam was of Moderately HIGH difficulty level. The SNAP 2020 Session 3 on 9<sup>th</sup> January was tougher than the previous 2 sessions that were held on 20 December 2020 and 6 January 2021.

### Highlights of SNAP Exam 2020 - Day 3 (9 January 2021)

- Easiest section - General English
- Tough section - Analytical and Logical Reasoning
- The overall difficulty level of SNAP 2020 Session-3 - Moderately-Difficult

### SNAP 2020 Paper Analysis: Difficulty Level

While doing the SNAP Exam Analysis 2020-21, we found that the difficulty level of this session was the highest. Questions from the Analytical and Logical Reasoning were found to be tougher than other 2 sections.

- According to our survey, almost 45-50% of the candidates found General English section to be the easiest amongst all the three sections
- The candidates also said that the exam was lengthy
- The questions in the Quant and DI section were quite lengthy to solve

### SNAP 2020 Exam Analysis: Good Attempts/Score

According to the SNAP exam analysis 2020, a raw score of 38-39 is considered to be a good score to fetch 98 percentile and will allow candidates to get admission to top 5 institutes affiliated under SIU.

## SNAP 2020 Exam Analysis (Section-Wise)

### SNAP General English Exam Review - Session-3 (Jan 9)

This section was of Moderately-Easy difficulty level than the other two sections. Let's find more details about today's questions from the General English section

- A total of 15 questions were asked in this section
- Again there were NO Questions from Reading Comprehension
- 4 Qs from Fill in the blanks
- 4 Qs from Grammar
- 2 Qs of Vocabulary
- 2 Qs from Idioms and Phrases
- 1 question each from Figures of Speech and Para-Jumbles

### SNAP Analytical and Logical Reasoning Exam Review 2021 - Session-3 (Jan 9)

This section was More Difficult than the other 2 sections.

- A total of 25 questions were asked in this section
- Most of the questions (~4 questions) were asked from Critical Reasoning
- 1 Set of 2 questions from Direction Sense
- 1 question each from
  - Blood Relations
  - Direction
  - Visual Reasoning
  - Odd-One Out
- 2-3 questions from Coding-Decoding and Series

### SNAP Quantitative and DI Exam Review 202 - Session-3 (Jan 9)

This section was Moderate to the other 2 sections. Neither easy nor tough. But questions were quite lengthy.

- A total of 20 questions were asked from this section.
- Most of the questions were from Arithmetic
- Surprisingly NO QUESTIONS from Algebra

- 2-3 questions from Number System
- 3 questions from Modern Maths (Permutation and Combination - 2, Probability - 1)
- 1 question each from Geometry and Pythagoras Theorem
- 2 questions from DI (Pie Chart)

## SNAP Expected Cut Off 2020

The SNAP 2020-21 expected raw scores to fetch 98%ile for SNAP 2020 in session 3 (Jan 9) is 38-39 for the General category.

- For the General English section, the sectional scores could be anywhere between 11-12 to fetch 98+%ile
- For the Analytical and Logical Reasoning section, the sectional cut off could be anywhere between 16-17 to fetch 98+%ile
- And for Quantitative and DI section, the section cut off could be anywhere between 13-14 to fetch 98+%ile
