

CAT 2023 Study Plan

100 Days to CAT 2023

To begin your preparation journey, start with getting your basics clear. The first step to acing the CAT 2023 exam is to have absolute clarity in the fundamentals of every topic of QA, VARC & DILR. It is crucial for aspirants to regularly test themselves to know where they stand in their preparation

Practicing mocks become an integral part of your CAT preparation. In the month of August, aim at writing 3-4 mocks.

60 Days to CAT 2023

With only 60 days to CAT 2023, your preparation should be enough to take 1-2 sectional tests during the week and 1 mock over weekends. Figure out the topics you are having difficulty in and revise those using our Recorded sessions. It is crucial that you now know what are your strengths and weaknesses in terms of CAT topics

Focus on Arithmetic & Algebra in the Quant section. A total number of 10 net correct answers in Algebra & Arithmetic would mean a 95%ile. It is crucial that you don't miss any of these 2 topics in Quant.

Focus on Linear Arrangement, Grid based games, matrix & Venn diagrams in Data Interpretation & Logical Reasoning section. These have been identified as important topics by our Experts after careful analysis of CAT papers over the past 6-7 years. A total number of 2 net correct sets in DILR and you score 95%ile in DILR.

In Reading Comprehension, focus on Science & Technology, Sociology, Zoology & Biology genres.

You can solve questions from the previous years papers of CAT as well as XAT. Ideally, look at the last 5 years of CAT and XAT to get a good mix of questions.

Your performance should escalate to a level where you can get done with a question within 100 seconds. Most likely, NMAT and IIFT will happen before CAT and you must begin taking the NMAT and IIFT mocks during this time.

Aim at writing one CAT mock per week and 1-2 NMAT and IIFT mock in a fortnight.

30 Days to CAT 2023

This is the compilation stage. By now you should have taken enough mocks (15-18) to know your D-Day strategy. Similarly, you should have taken 4-5 mocks of IIFT & NMAT to know the D-Day strategy for them as well.

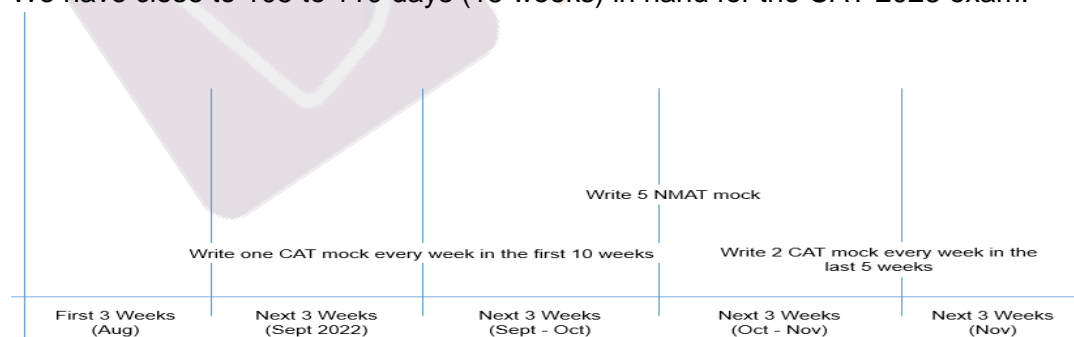
This time is more about getting acquainted with the CAT/NMAT/IIFT test taking. Ideally, all the mocks that you take during this time should be attempted during the hours of your actual exam slot. Please note that each of these three exams need to have a very different approach. Your mock strategy should be finalized based on the nature of the exam.

You could consider taking leave from work for the last 2-3 weeks if possible. This will most likely calm your mind and provide some change to your mind.

Four days before the D-day you must put an end to the preparation. Watch a movie or tv series and relax. By now you would've done more than enough to score a 99+ percentile. Do NOT attempt any full length mock 3-4 days before any exam.

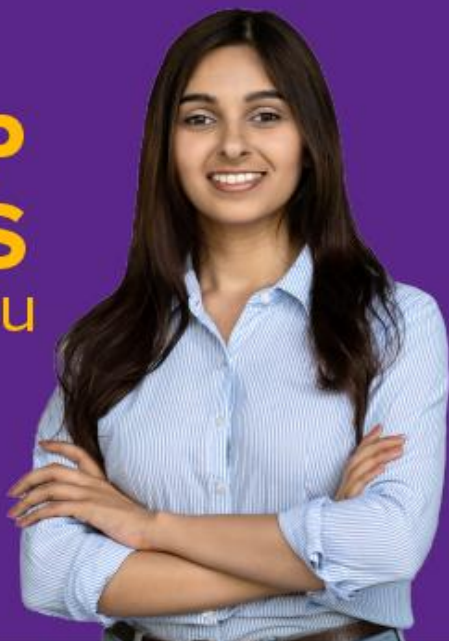
Mocks Strategy
