Blood Relations	Direct & Coded Type

Coding and Decoding	Letter, Number & Symbol Type
Input-Output	LSN Type, Word-number based, Operation based

Important Topics	Details
Number Series	Wrong/ Missing Number Series, Series based on patterns such as double step variation, arithmetic (difference/ multiplication/ division) based, square/ cube/ square root/ cube root based, mixed arithmetic operations based, etc.
Simplification/ Approximation	Based on basic BODMAS rules
Quadratic Equations	Factorization-based and less formula-based
Data Interpretation	Questions will be asked from topics like - Line graph, Bar graph, Pie Chart, Radar Chart, Mixed charts, Tabular charts, Caselet charts, Missing DI The level can be difficult and may be asked in combination with arithmetic problems.
Arithmetic Problems	This will involve questions from topics like- Ratio & Proportion, Averages, Age-based problems, Percentages, Profit Loss & Discount, Mixture & Alligations, Simple & Compound Interest, Time Work & Wages, Speed Time & Distance, Boats & Streams, Probability, etc. Questions can be asked in Caselet or Data Interpretation
Data Sufficiency	Two Statements & Three Statements
Quantity-based Questions	Two Statements & Three Statements









## **English Language**

Topics	Details
Reading Comprehension	Comprehensions topics can be based on a wide variety of topics such as Economy and Related Fields, AI-Based Articles, Research-Based Articles, etc.  Questions from Synonyms/ Antonyms under RC are asked in the prelims phase.
	Students are advised to consult Economic Times/ The Hindu/ The Indian Express for this.
Cloze Test	Word Replacement & Fill in the blanks type.
Error Spotting	Based on Grammar rules.
Para jumbles/Sentence Rearrangement	Questions from para jumbles may be asked based on the old or new pattern.  The level of these questions will be moderate.
Sentence Improvement	Single Error & Multiple Error Type
Fill in the blanks	Double or Triple fill-ups based.  There is another variation of this question where you may be asked to identify one single word that would aptly fill 2 different sentences.
Sentence/ Paragraph Completion	A sentence or paragraph-completion-based questions are usually asked in the Mains. The overall level of these questions may be moderate to difficult.
Sentence Connectors	This is a fairly new topic introduced by RBI.









	The level of these questions may be moderate to difficult, depending on how well you understand this topic.
New Pattern Questions	Many new topics have been introduced in the various bank exams.  Questions about Vocabulary, word usage, and grammar usage can be asked
