- > JPMorgan Chase & Co has spent \$434.15 billion, followed by Citibank NA, Wells Fargo & Company, and Bank of America Corporation
- Chennai Metro Rail Limited (CMRL) has collaborated with which bank for the National Common Mobility Card or Singara
 Chennai Card as part of the multimodal and ticket integration plan _____State Bank of India.

Note:

- It can be used on metro trains and on MTC buses and suburban trains later, and can also be used in other metros.
- The option to link the card to an SBI bank account will be available soon.
- ➤ It can be preloaded with cash from 100 to 2,000 with a 1.8% commission charged by SBI.
- 3. Which bank has launched a pilot scheme for better financing terms in the electric vehicle space and strengthening the whole ecosystem_____SIDBI.

Note:


- The pilot phase of 'Mission 50K-EV4ECO' aims to strengthen the EV ecosystem, including uptake for two, three, and four-wheelers through direct and indirect lending.
- ➤ Direct lending: SIDBI will directly give loans to eligible MSMEs
- Indirect lending: Targeted at NBFCs, including small unrated focused, and emerging NBFCs.
- 4. Which bank has reintroduced a retail term deposit 'AMRIT KALASH', a special scheme of 400 days tenor _______State Bank of India (SBI).

Note:

- ➤ Earlier, the bank had launched this retail term deposit scheme with a specific duration and it was valid from February 15, 2023, to March 31, 2023.
- ➤ The Rate of Interest on this term deposit is 7.10 % w.e.f. April 12th, 2023.
- ➤ While Senior Citizens are eligible for a rate of interest of 7.60%.
- ➤ The Scheme will be valid till 30-June-2023.
- **5.** Which bank of Russia has expanded its ties with banks in India to expedite trade between the two countries in national currencies, as Russia this year has become the biggest supplier of oil to India______Gazprombank.

Note

- ➤ It is the third-largest lender of Russia by assets and a key conduit of the Russian energy trade.
- ➤ In 2022, India implemented a broader framework to facilitate overseas trade in rupees, and since then many Russian institutions have opened vostro accounts with Indian banks.

Note:


- > Aim: To raise awareness and provide information about hemophilia and other bleeding disorders

- > On this day, the PM will award the officers from the central and state governments for their outstanding contributions to public administration
- On April 21, 1947, Sardar Vallabh Bhai Patel (Home Minister) gave a speech to the first group of civil servants in Independent India at the Metcalf House

New Appointments

1. The Reserve Bank of India (RBI) has approved the appointment of Sekhar Rao as interim managing director (MD) and chief executive officer (CEO) of which bank with effect from April 15, 2023______Karnataka Bank.

Note:

- He has been appointed for a period of three months or till the appointment of regular MD and CEO whichever is earlier.
- ▶ He has replaced Mahabaleshwara M S, whose term ended on April 14, 2023.
- Prior to this role, he was serving as an executive director of the bank.
- 2. Who has assumed charge as Controller of Personnel Services on April 17, 2023 ______Vice Admiral Krishna Swaminathan.

Note:

- He was commissioned into the Indian Navy on July 1, 1987, and is a specialist in Communication and Electronic Warfare.
- Earlier, he served as the Chief of Staff of the Western Naval Command, Flag Officer Defence Advisory Group, and Flag Officer Sea Training.
- ► He was the second Commanding Officer of the aircraft carrier INS Vikramaditya.
- Who has been confirmed as the new chief judge of the Court of Appeals, the state's highest court ______ Judge Rowan Wilson.

- ➤ He is also New York's first Black chief judge.
- ➤ He was appointed by the 57th governor of New York, Kathy Hochul.
- ➤ Since 2017, he has been an associate judge of the Court of Appeals, New York's highest court.
- He studied at Harvard College, and graduated from Harvard Law School in 1984.



4. Miguel Diaz-Canel has become the president of which country for second term____Cuba.

Note:

- ➤ His bid was confirmed by 97.66% of votes cast in the Communist Party of Cuba-aligned National Assembly.
- ➤ He took over the reins in 2018 as the first civilian leader of Cuba.
- His first five years in office were marked by the worst economic crisis in three decades.
- Cuba Capital: Havana; Currency: Cuban Peso
- 5. Tata Group has appointed whom as the CEO and managing director of Tata Electronics Pvt Ltd (TEPL)_____Dr. Randhir Thakur.

Note:

- > Before this, he was associated with the global electronic chip and circuits manufacturing giant Intel.
- ➤ He has also held leadership and technical positions at Applied Materials Inc., SanDisk Corp, and Micron Technology Inc.
- > TEPL was founded in 2020 as a greenfield venture of the Tata Group with expertise in manufacturing precision components.
- 6. Who has been appointed as the brand influencer of HSBC India_____Virat Kohli.

Note:

- ➤ HSBC India is also set to launch a multimedia campaign featuring Kohli, aimed at re-establishing the value proposition of banking with the company.
- ➤ Virat Kohli will help to amplify HSBC's purpose of opening up a world of opportunity as it strives to support the ambitions of an aspirational India going global.
- ➤ HSBC India CEO: Hitendra Dave

1. PM Modi has launched a series of railway projects across the Northeast, a methanol plant, and laid the foundation stone for a bridge over which river______Brahmaputra river.

Note:

- He commissioned a methanol plant at Namrup in Dibrugarh by Assam Petrochemicals Ltd (APL) with 500 tonnes per day (TPD) capacity.
- He has also witnessed a mega-Bihu dance performance, which has made it to the Guinness World Records, at the Indira Gandhi Athletic Stadium, Assam.
- 2. National Highway Authority of India (NHAI) has signed an MoU with which Tiger Reserve, spread across Andhra Pradesh and Telangana_____Nagarjunasagar-Srisailam.

Note:

- > Reason: To facilitate a seamless and efficient entry process for vehicles entering into the forest area.
- ➤ It will provide FASTag based payment system at Forest entry points
- ➤ It will extend the benefit of a collection of Ecosystem Management Coordination fees through FASTag at various entrance points of the Tiger Reserve
- **3.** PM Modi has inaugurated the All Indian Institute of Medical Science (AIIMS) in which North-Eastern state _____Guwahati, Assam.

- > The foundation stone was laid in May 2017 and was built at a cost of over Rs 1,120 crore.
- It has a total capacity of 750 beds, including 30 AYUSH beds, and also has an intake capacity of 100 MBBS students per year.
- ➤ He also laid the foundation of the Rs 546 crore Assam Advanced Healthcare Innovation Institute, a joint initiative of the state government and IIT Guwahati.

- > It will be attended by scholars, Sangha leaders, and Dharma practitioners from all over the world.
- It will also enhance the cultural and diplomatic relationships with other countries.
- **15.** The Union Minister of State for Steel, Faggan Singh Kulaste will inaugurate India Steel 2023, organized in which city from 19-21 April 2023_____Mumbai.

Note:

- > The event will be conducted by the steel ministry, Department of Commerce, and FICCI.
- Aim: To bring together industry leaders, policymakers, and experts to discuss the latest developments, challenges, and opportunities in the steel industry.
- It will showcase advance technologies, products, and solutions from the Indian steel industry.
- **16.** Tribal Affairs Minister Arjun Munda has launched the Marketing and Logistics Development for Promotion of Tribal Products from North-Eastern Region (PTP-NER) scheme in which state_____Manipur.

- > This scheme has been introduced for the benefit of Scheduled Tribes of the North-Eastern Region.
- Vision: To strengthen the livelihood opportunities for tribal artisans through increased efficiency in procurement, logistics and marketing of tribal products from North Eastern States.

- During the launch event, he also hailed the launching of the astronomy lab that has come up in Karnal, Haryana.
- **18.** Which ministry has launched the 'Sangathan Se Samriddhi' campaign to empower marginalized rural households by bringing all eligible rural women into the fold of Self Help Groups (SHGs)_____Union Minister of Rural Development.

Note:

- ➤ The govt is targeting to bring 10 crore women under the purview of SHGs (existing nine crores).
- The govt has also set a target that every woman associated with SHGs should be able to earn 1 lakh rupees per annum.
- ► He also urged women to produce millet.

Important News - State

1. India's tallest statue of Ambedkar, a 125-ft tall bronze statue of BR Ambedkar in which city of India_____Hyderabad.

Note:

- Reason: To mark the 132nd birth anniversary of the architect of the Indian Constitution.
- ➤ It stands next to the State Secretariat on the banks of Hyderabad's famous Hussain Sagar Lake.
- It was built using 360 tonnes of stainless steel and 114 tonnes of bronze, at a cost of Rs 146.50 crore.
- **2.** Arunachal Pradesh CM Pema Khandu has inaugurated the Shar Nyima Tsho Sum Namyig Lhakhang (Gonpa) at Gyangkhar village, located in which district of Arunachal Pradesh______Tawang.

Note:

- The Gonpa has great historical importance for the well-being and betterment of humans, particularly for the people of Shar Nyima Tsho Sum and all Buddhists in general.
- The 11-12th-century Gonpa was on the verge of collapse but it has been restored with a new structure.
- 3. Which state government has renamed the proposed Bhavanapadu port in the Srikakulam district as Mulapeta port at the request of the locals Andhra Pradesh.

Note:

- CM YS Jagan Mohan Reddy will lay a foundation stone for this nearly Rs 4,000 crore project on April 19, 2023.
- > This decision was taken as farmers from Mulapeta and Vishnuchakram villages requested the name change.
- > The state govt also issued an order notifying Bhavanapadu Port as Mulapeta Port with the same limits.
- **4.** Which state has become the first state to adopt a water budget in a bid to come up with a solution to water scarcity in certain regions_____Kerala.

- > The first phase would cover 94-gram panchayats and 15-block panchayats.
- CM Pinarayi Vijayan released Public Water Budget.
- > The third phase of the Ini Njan Ozhukatte (Let me flow now) project for the rehabilitation of irrigation networks in the Western Ghats was also launched.
- The idea of a water budget was first mooted by the state in 2019.
- **5.** The first-ever census of which bird was conducted by the Odisha forest officials in the Bhitarkanika wildlife sanctuary ______Mangrove Pitta Bird.





- In the first census, 179 mangrove pitta birds were sighted.
- The habitats of these beautiful birds are confined to mangrove forest areas in Odisha's Bhitarkanika and Sundarban in West Bengal.
- Mangrove pitta is a colorful bird that has a black head with a brown crown.
- It feeds on crustaceans, mollusks, and insects.
- **6.** Which state government has signed an MoU with the Arunachal Pradesh government to resolve the long pending border dispute between both states______Assam.

Note:

- > The MoU was signed in presence of Union Home Minister Amit Shah in New Delhi on April 20.
- The Assam cabinet has approved the recommendations of 12 Regional Committees formed by the state government to resolve the decades-long border dispute issues with Arunachal Pradesh.
- Assam shares an 804 km long boundary with Arunachal Pradesh.
- 7. Manohar Lal Khattar has launched three online services to digitally empower people, is a CM of which state _______

 Haryana.

Note:

- These online services are Pro-active Divyang Pension Service, 'Tau se Poochho' WhatsApp chatbot, and online booking of government rest houses.
- The Pro-active Divyang Pension Service for the physically challenged is committed to delivering all services for them at their doorsteps.
- The Haryana Parivar Pehchan Authority has created a WhatsApp Chatbot Tau Se Poochho.

Note:

- It was inaugurated by Kerala CM Pinarayi Vijayan at Kallikkad.
- For the first phase of the project, the state government has prepared a list of 113 panchayats.
- Each playground would cost around Rs 1 crore, half will be paid by the Sports department and the rest would be raised from other sources


Important News - World

1. Japan, India, and which country have announced a common platform for talks among bilateral creditors to coordinate the restructuring of Sri Lanka's debt_____France.

Note:

- This move is expected to serve as a model for solving the debt woes.
- > Sir Lanka has secured a 2.9 billion dollar programme from IMF to tackle its huge debt burden.
- ▶ But, the middle-income economy could not apply for relief under the G-20's common framework for debt treatment, which targets only low-income countries.
- 2. Which country has become the world's foremost narco-state, as its economic survival now depends heavily on the production and export of Captagon_____Syria.

- ➤ Captagon is a banned illicit drug recognized by the UNODC (2021) and is a synthetic stimulant that combines amphetamine and caffeine.
- According to the Collins Dictionary, "narco-state" refers to a nation where a significant portion of the economy is reliant on the illicit trade of narcotic drugs.





3.	A World Trade Organisation (WTO) panel has ruled that India has violated global trading rules in a dispute against the European Union, Japan, and which countryTaiwan. Note:
	 The case pertains to import duties for a wide range of products. In 2019, the EU, Japan, and Taiwan challenged the import duties on certain IT products. The EU had challenged India's introduction of import duties between 7.5% and 20% for products such as mobile phones, mobile phone components, and accessories.



- > The mission was carried by an Ariane 5 rocket from Europe's Spaceport in Kourou, French Guiana.
- > It will take an eight-year journey to reach Jupiter.
- > Aim: To understand whether there are habitable environments among those icy moons and around a Jupiter
- > It will make detailed observations of Jupiter and its three large moons: Ganymede, Callisto, and Europa
- 2. The Defence Research and Development Organisation (DRDO) Industry Academia Centre of Excellence (DIA-CoE) has been inaugurated at which IIT______Indian Institute of Technology -Hyderabad.

- ➤ DRDO Chairman Dr Samir V Kamat inaugurated the facility at the campus of the IIT-Hyderabad at Sangareddy in Telangana.
