Banking & Financial Awareness

1. Which bank has received a three years to comply with the priority sector lending norms (PSL) ____ **HDFC Bank**.
Note:
 - No relaxation is allowed for abiding by the cash reserve ratio (CRR) and statutory liquidity ratio (SLR) rules.
 - As per the RBI norms, commercial banks need to extend 40% of the adjusted net bank credit (ANBC) of the previous year towards the priority sector.
2. Which organization has joined hands with M1xchange to offer a digital invoice discounting solution to farmers, farmer-producer organizations (FPOs), and agri-MSMEs through Farm Pass ____ **Mastercard**.
Note:
 - This platform will enable easy access to credit and working capital.
 - This solution will also allow farmers and FPOs to directly connect with buyers, negotiate the best price for their produce, and get paid faster.
 - Farm Pass is part of Mastercard's broader Community Pass platform.
3. According to the Morgan Stanley report, what would be India's GDP in FY24 ____ **6.2 percent**.
Note:
 - Inflation in India is likely to be below 5% in the second quarter of the calendar year 2024.
 - The headline consumer price index (CPI) for March was in line with expectations.
 - Morgan noted that the key to sustained domestic demand is a pickup in capex, which will help create more jobs, thus leading to a virtuous cycle of more jobs-to-higher income-higher savings-higher investment.
4. Which bank is planning to launch its own digital bank 'Indie' ____ **IndusInd Bank**.
Note:
 - The necessary approvals for all these expansion plans and other logistics by the bank are likely to be completed in 2 years.
 - The bank is also planning to enter the mutual funds, insurance, and broking sector.
 - It is likely to apply for the license in a few days.
 - The Hindujas-promoted bank is likely to approach SEBI, IRDAI, and other regulators to obtain the necessary licences.
 - IndusInd Bank HQ: Mumbai
5. Which organization has imposed penalties totaling Rs 44 lakh on four cooperative banks ____ **Reserve Bank of India (RBI)**.
Note:
 - Bombay Mercantile Co-operative Bank: Penalty of Rs 13 lakh as it failed to transfer the eligible amount to Depositor Education and Awareness Fund (DEAF).
 - Tamil Nadu State Apex Co-operative Bank: Penalty of 16 lakhs as it failed to transfer eligible amounts to DEAF.
 - Baran Nagrik Sahkari Bank: A penalty of 2 lakhs has been imposed for contravention of certain norms.
6. Which bank and HDFC Bank would acquire up to a 9.94 percent stake in Go Digit-Life Insurance ____ **Axis Bank**.
Note:
 - HDFC Bank informed that it has executed definitive agreements to invest ₹69.90 crore in Go Digit-Life Insurance Ltd in two tranches.
 - The bank has made the first tranche of payment of ₹10.93 crore for towards the acquisition.
 - Axis Bank has also executed definitive agreements to invest ₹69.90 crore in Go Digit-Life Insurance Ltd in two tranches.
7. Which central bank will launch a gold-pegged digital currency and legalize them in the country ____ **Reserve Bank of Zimbabwe**.

Note:

- It is believed that the government took this step for stabilizing the local currency after its continuous devaluation in comparison to the U.S. dollar.
- This initiative taken by Zimbabwe will allow the exchange of Zimbabwean dollars with digital gold tokens and secure Zimbabweans against currency volatility.
- Zimbabwe Capital: Harare; President: Emmerson Mnangagwa

8. Which Neobanking platform has received a non-banking financial company (NBFC) license from the Reserve Bank of India to enter into the lending business _____ **Jupiter**.

Note:

- The startup, Jupiter will be offering the loan under Amica Financial Technologies.
- Jitendra Gupta (founder of Jupiter) has informed that there will be an equity infusion of Rs 100 crore from Jupiter to develop the NBFC product.
- The startup will be looking to raise a loan from banks for an additional Rs 100 crore.

9. The Reserve Bank of India (RBI) has canceled the banking license of which co-operative bank with effect from the close of business on April 24, 2023 _____ **Kerala-based Adoor Co-operative Urban Bank**.

Note:

- RBI has allowed Adoor Co-operative Urban Bank to function as a non-banking institution.
- RBI has also stopped to conduct the banking business, including acceptance of deposits from non-members with immediate effect.
- The bank shall ensure to repay unpaid and unclaimed deposits of non-members held by it.

10. Which bank has opened an exclusive branch for startups at the Bandra Kurla Complex in Mumbai _____ **State Bank of India (SBI)**.

Note:

- This is the fourth startup-focused branch, after Bengaluru, Chennai, and Gurugram.
- In Mumbai, the bank has entered into multiple MoU with the Society for Innovation & Entrepreneurship at IIT-Bombay, Centre for Incubation and Business Acceleration, and S.P Jain Institute of Management & Research
- Aim of MoU: To boost the startup ecosystem in the region

11. Which general Insurance company has become India's first general insurance company to accept the RBI's Central Bank Digital Currency (CBDC) e-Rupee for premium payments _____ **Reliance General Insurance**.

Note:

- Aim: To provide customers with an easy, safe, instant, and green payment solution
- The company has partnered with Yes Bank to enable premium collection.
- Customers with an active e-wallet with any bank can scan Reliance General Insurance's e-Rupee QR code to make immediate payments.

12. Which bank has launched the "Shubh Arambh Deposit" retail term deposit scheme for senior citizens _____ **Bank of India**.

Note:

- With this scheme, seniors, including super senior citizens can take benefit of an additional interest rate of 0.50% for senior citizens and 0.65% for super senior citizens.
- It provides super senior citizens seniors with 501-day fixed deposits at a high-interest rate of 7.80%.
- Other senior citizens between the ages of 60 and 80 can invest at a rate of 7.65%.

13. Which FMCG giant has overtaken the market capitalization of Infosys to become India's sixth most valuable company on the stock exchanges _____ **ITC**.

Note:

- ITC's market cap currently stands at ₹5.11 trillion (at the time of writing this report).
- This achievement comes after the share price of ITC rose 59% over the past year and 24% so far in 2023.
- Meanwhile, Infosys shares have fallen by 20% in 2023.
- Top 5: Reliance, TCS, HDFC Bank, ICICI Bank, HUL

14. Which bank has introduced a Digital Distribution Platform, 'Smart Saathi' for its agents and business correspondents to sell services, especially in rural areas _____ **HDFC Bank**.

Note:

- HDFC Bank Smart Saathi provides a secure and user-friendly experience to its users.
- The newly launched feature will use advanced technology solutions to connect Business Correspondents/Business Facilitators to the bank.
- Aim: To boost financial inclusion by taking banking products and services to the last mile

Obituaries

1. Sidharth Rao, who passed away, was a co-founder and former CEO of which organization _____ **Webchutney.**

Note:

- In 1999, he founded India's first and top digital agency WebChutney.
- In July 2021, Rao was chosen to serve as the global CEO of Dentsu McGarrybowen.
- In 2022, he stepped down as group CEO of dentsuMB India and joined hands and launched a new venture in the marketing technology (MarTech) space, called Punt Partners along with serial entrepreneur Madhu Sudan.

2. Trilochan Kanungo, who passed away in Bhubaneswar, was a _____ **Politician.**

Note:

- Kanungo was elected to the assembly in 1971, 1974, and 1985.
- In 1999, he was elected from the Jagatsinghpur Lok Sabha seat on a BJD ticket.
- He was a former chairman of Cuttack Municipality and ex-chairperson of the state finance commission.
- He was born on November 24, 1940, in Badamulei village in Cuttack district, Odisha.

3. Tarek Fatah, who passed away, was associated with which field _____ **Journalist.**

Note:

- He was emigrating to Canada from Pakistan in 1987.
- He worked as a political activist, journalist, and television host.
- He also authored several books including, 'Chasing a Mirage: The Tragic Illusion of an Islamic State' and 'The Jew is Not My Enemy: Unveiling the Myths that Fuel Muslim Anti-Semitism.'
- He won various awards such as the Donner Prize, and Stan Vine Canadian Book Award.

4. Parkash Singh Badal, who passed away, was CM of which of state _____ **Punjab.**

Note:

- He became the CM of Punjab for the first time in 1970.
- Later, he became the chief minister four times, from 1977 to 1980, 1997 to 2002, 2007 to 2012, and from 2012 to 2017.
- He briefly joined Morarji Desai's government as the Agriculture minister at the Centre in 1977.
- He was awarded the second-highest civilian award, Padma Vibhushan in 2015.

5. Mamukkoya, who passed away, was a veteran actor-comedian of which regional cinema _____ **Malayalam.**

Note:

- He started his acting career by doing theatre in 1979, then he went on to become an actor by doing comic roles and was popular for playing characters that spoke Malabar accent.
- He acted in around 500 films, including comedies like Sandesam, Nadodikattu, Innathe Chintha Vishayam, and Varavelpu.
- He won several awards and honours for his various roles during his extensive career.

6. Dr. N Gopalakrishnan, who passed away, was a veteran _____ **Scientists.**

Note:

- He was a scientist at Advanced Seismic Testing and Research Laboratory (ASTaR) of CSIR-SERC.
- He had served as a design engineer at TATA Consulting Engineers, Bengaluru and later joined as scientist in the Structural Dynamics and Machine Foundation division of CSIR-SERC.
- He was the co-author of 61 national and international journal articles and filed for five Indian patents.

Important Days

1. Earth Day is being celebrated every year on which date to honor the environmental movement and raise awareness to protect natural resources _____ **22nd April.**

Note:

- Theme for Earth Day 2023: "Invest in Our Planet".
- American senator Gaylord Nelson founded the Earth Day for environmental education in 1970.
- Generally, Earth Day is either celebrated on 22nd April or on the day when the spring equinox occurs around the world.

2. World Malaria Day is observed every year on which date to commemorate the recognition of global efforts to control malaria _____ **April 25.**

Note:

- WHO Member States instituted this day during the World Health Assembly of 2007.
- Theme 2023: Time to deliver zero malaria: invest, innovate, implement

- Malaria is a disease caused by parasites transmitted to people through the bites of infected female Anopheles mosquitoes.
 - India has registered over 85% decline in malaria cases from 2015 to 2022
3. The world commemorates World Intellectual Property Day on which date for promoting awareness of intellectual property and its safeguarding _____ **April 26.**

Note:

- The theme for the 2023 celebration of World Intellectual Property Day is "Women and IP: Accelerating Innovation and Creativity".
 - This day was initially proposed during the 33rd Assembly Session of the WIPO Member States in September 1988, and it was officially established on August 9th, 1999.
4. International Girls in ICT Day is celebrated annually on which day of April to encourage and empower girls and young women to explore and pursue careers in the field of Information and Communication Technology (ICT) _____ **Fourth Thursday.**

Note:

- In 2023, it is being observed on April 27.
 - 2023 theme: Digital Skills for Life
 - It raised awareness about the gender gap in the tech industry and inspires women to consider careers in ICT.
 - This day was declared by ITU on April 8, 2011.
5. World Day for Safety and Health at Work is observed every year on which date to promote safe and decent work environments across the globe _____ **April 28.**

Note:

- 2023 theme: A safe and healthy working environment as a fundamental principle and right at work
 - It coincides with the anniversary of the 1971 adoption of the Occupational Safety and Health Convention by the International Labour Organization (ILO)
 - It was first observed in 2003 after the ILO declared it an annual international campaign.
6. World Veterinary Day is celebrated on which day of April to mark the importance of veterinary doctors who serve to protect animal's _____ **Last Saturday of April.**

Note:

- In 2023, this day was observed on April 29.
 - 2023 theme: Promoting Diversity, Equity, and Inclusiveness in the Veterinary Profession
 - The World Veterinary Association (WVA) established World Veterinary Day in 2000 to recognize the role of veterinarians in safeguarding the health and well-being of animals, people, and the environment.
7. India observed Ayushman Bharat Diwas every year on which date to promote the Ayushman Bharat Yojana values _____ **April 30.**

Note:

- In 2018, PM Modi announced the Ayushman Bharat Yojna to give healthcare coverage to all Indians who cannot afford basic medical services.
 - This initiative was established along the lines of universal health care to satisfy one of the United Nations' SDGs - "leave no one behind."
 - This scheme covers all expenses of patients.
8. India celebrates National Panchayati Raj Day every year on which date to commemorate the constitutional change that established the Panchayati Raj Institutions (PRIs) _____ **April 24.**

Note:

- PRIs are considered the third tier of the government.
- It manages the local-level administration in rural areas.
- The first Panchayati Raj system was initiated in the year 1993.
- 2023 theme: Sustainable Panchayat: Building Healthy, Water Sufficient, Clean & Green Villages

New Appointments

1. In the exercise of the power conferred by Article 223 of the Constitution of India, the President has appointed Justice Sarasa Venkatanarayana Bhatti as Acting Chief Justice of which high court with effect from April 24, 2023 _____ **Kerala High Court.**

Note:

- He would replace the current Chief Justice S Manikumar, who will retire on the aforementioned date.

- He served as a Judge from the Andhra Pradesh High Court and is presently working as the senior-most judge of the Kerala High Court.
2. Who has been named the new deputy prime minister of the United Kingdom _____ **Oliver Dowden**.
- Note:**
- He has replaced current Dy PM and Justice Secretary, Dominic Raab, who has resigned.
 - Before this role, he had been serving as the Chancellor of the Duchy of Lancaster and Cabinet Office secretary, under the present UK government.
 - He will continue in the roles alongside his new responsibilities.
 - While Alex Chalk becomes the 10th justice secretary in 10 years.
3. Who has assumed the charge of Secretary, Department for Promotion of Industry and Internal Trade, Ministry of Commerce and Industry _____ **Rajesh Kumar Singh**.
- Note:**
- He is an IAS officer of the 1989 Batch from the Kerala cadre.
 - Before this, he served as Secretary in the Department of Animal Husbandry & Dairying, Ministry of Fisheries, Animal Husbandry & Dairying.
 - He has replaced Anurag Jain, who was appointed secretary in the Ministry of Road Transport and Highways.
4. Who has been appointed as the chairperson of Nasscom for 2023-24 _____ **Microsoft India President, Anant Maheshwari**.
- Note:**
- Earlier, he served as the vice-chairperson of Nasscom'.
 - He has succeeded the president of business and technology services at TCS, Krishnan Ramanujam.
 - Meanwhile, Nasscom has also appointed chairman and managing director of Cognizant India, Rajesh Nambiar as its vice-chairperson for 2023-24
 - Nasscom refers to National Association of Software and Service Companies
5. Who has taken charge as the new chairman of Karnataka Vikas Grameena Bank (KVGB) _____ **Shreekant M Bhandiwad**.
- Note:**
- KVGB is an Indian RRB sponsored by Canara Bank headquartered in Dharwad, Karnataka.
 - He has replaced the current chairman P Gopikrishna, who was repatriated to Canara Bank as Circle Head, Bengaluru, in Karnataka.
 - He has an experience of 29 years in Canara Bank, having worked across India (Haryana, Rajasthan, Bihar, and Karnataka) in various capacities.
6. The Reserve Bank of India (RBI) has approved the reappointment of whom as Managing Director and CEO of City Union Bank _____ **N Kamakodi**.
- Note:**
- The tenure of his re-appointment would be for a period of three years with effect from May 1, 2023.
 - He joined the bank as deputy general manager in 2003 and was elevated to general manager in 2005.
 - In 2006, he was appointed as executive director.
 - From May 2011, he was serving the bank as its managing director and chief executive officer.
7. Who has been appointed as the new Chief Executive Officer (CEO) of the Association of Asset Reconstruction Companies (ARCs) _____ **Hari Hara Mishra**.
- Note:**
- He has started his career with the State Bank of India in 1982 and worked there until 2004.
 - He is an experienced professional in the field of asset reconstruction.
 - The ARCs are the voice of all Asset Reconstruction Companies in India.
 - Currently, there are 28 ARCs registered with the Reserve Bank of India.
8. The government has confirmed the appointment of whom as a Managing Director (MD) of the Bank of Baroda for three years _____ **Debadatta Chand**.
- Note:**
- Currently, he is serving as Executive Director of the bank.
 - He has succeeded Sanjiv Chadha, whose term was extended for five months till June 30 by the government.
 - In January 2023, the Financial Services Institutions Bureau (FSIB) recommended Debadatta Chand as MD & CEO of the Bank of Baroda.
 - Headquarters: Vadodara
9. Who has been appointed as the chairman of the Atomic Energy Commission and the secretary of the Department of Atomic Energy _____ **Ajit Kumar Mohanty**.

Note:

- He has replaced K N Vyas.
- He was appointed as the BARC director in March 2019.
- In 1983, he joined the Nuclear Physics Division of the BARC after graduating from the 26th batch of the BARC Training School.

Important News - India

1. The Centre has launched over 254 network towers to provide 4G mobile connectivity in border areas of which state _____ **Arunachal Pradesh**.

Note:

- It will provide 4G coverage in uncovered villages of the state, thereby bringing digital connectivity to 336 villages, including several areas which have remained unconnected since Independence.
- Over 70,000 subscribers are expected to benefit from the service.

2. Which country has improved its ranking in the World Bank's Logistic Performance Index (LPI) 2023 by six places from 44 in 2018 to 38 in 2023, among 139 countries _____ **India**.

Note:

- LPI is an interactive benchmarking tool created to help countries identify the challenges and opportunities on trade logistics and the scope of improvement.
- India's category-wise ranking: International shipments: 22; Logistics competence and equality: 48; Timeline: 17; Tracking and tracing: 38

3. The government has launched which round of the regional air connectivity scheme, UDAN to further enhance the connectivity to remote and regional areas _____ **Fifth**.

Note:

- Under this scheme, viability gap funding (VGF) will be capped at 600 km stage length for both priority and non-priority areas, which was earlier capped at 500 km.
- Besides this, no pre-determined routes would be offered and only network and individual route proposals by airlines will be considered.

4. PM Modi has laid the foundation stone and inaugurated projects worth more than 17,000 crores in which state _____ **Madhya Pradesh**.

Note:

- He has also inaugurated the integrated e-Gram Swaraj and GeM portal for public procurement at the Panchayat level.
- Objective: To enable Panchayats to market their goods and services through GeM
- With the handing over of around 35 lakh Swamitva Property Cards, about 1 crore 25 lakh property cards have been distributed under this scheme in the country.

5. Which ministry has conducted the first-ever census of water bodies across the nation _____ **Ministry of Jal Shakti**.

Note:

- Aim: To provide a comprehensive inventory of India's water resources, including natural and man-made water bodies like lakes
- Over 24.24 lakh water bodies have been enumerated in the country out of which more than 23 lakh water bodies are in rural areas and nearly 69,000 are in urban areas.
- Top 5 (number of water bodies): WB, Uttar Pradesh, Andhra Pradesh, Odisha, and Assam

6. Union Minister of Ports has inaugurated National Technology Centre for Ports, Waterways and Coasts, IIT - Discovery Campus at Chennai. Who is he _____ **Sarbananda Sonowal**.

Note:

- Under the Sagarmala Programme, the centre has been established in IIT Chennai at a cost of 77 Crore rupees.
- The institute acts as a technological arm of the Ministry and develops cutting-edge technologies and application products to provide solutions to various challenges faced by the Ports and Shipping Sector.

7. The Unique Identification Authority of India and which organization are setting up an aggregator platform for eKYC (electronic know-your-customer) _____ **National Payments Corporation of India**.

Note:

- The process of Aadhaar-based eKYC is used for paperless verification of a customer's credentials to get a mobile connection or open a bank account.
- The process can be completed using biometrics or through the use of OTP.
- It is being used by financial services players, and government agencies.

8. The Ministry of Petroleum has successfully completed the Bihar portion of the Barauni Guwahati pipeline (BGPL) under which scheme _____ **Pradhan Mantri Urja Ganga project.**

Note:

- It will connect six districts in Bihar to the National Gas Grid.
- Pradhan Mantri Urja Ganga Project is also known as Jagdishpur – Haldia & Bokaro – Dhamra Pipeline Project (JHBDPL) project.
- Launched: 2016
- Aim: Caters to the energy requirements of five states (UP, Bihar, Jharkhand, Odisha, and WB).

9. Which steel production plant has signed a Memorandum of understanding with Telecommunications Consultants India (TCIL) to explore the potential of the application of 5G/ IT/ telecom and other wireless communication technologies _____ **SAIL-Bokaro Steel Plant.**

Note:

- This project would include SAIL's Mines and Collieries, Central Coal Supply Organization, and the SAIL refractory unit in Jharkhand.
- SAIL Chairperson: Soma Mondal

10. PM Modi has inaugurated India's first water metro in which city _____ **Kochi (Kerala).**

Note:

- The metro project will start with eight electric hybrid boats developed under Cochin Shipyard Limited.
- It was funded by the Kerala govt and the German company KfW.
- It consists of 38 terminals and 78 electric boats.
- The first phase of this project started from the High Court-Vypin and Vyttila-Kakkanad terminals.

11. India has launched a rescue operation named Operation Kaveri to evacuate its stranded citizens from which country _____ **Sudan.**

Note:

- Two C-130s aircraft and the navy ship INS Sumedha is on standby to evacuate Indians.
- The name for rescue operations in Sudan has been kept Operation Kaveri for the same purpose that Prime Minister Modi chose to name rescue ops in Ukraine Operation Ganga.
- Kaveri is one of the major Indian rivers flowing through Karnataka and Tamil Nadu.

12. Union Minister for Labour has launched new features in eShram Portal. Who is he _____ **Bhupender Yadav.**

Note:

- Aim: To enhance the utility of the portal and facilitate ease of registration for unorganized workers
- A feature for capturing the family details of migrant workers has been added to the eShram portal.
- Through the portal, the eShram-registered workers can now connect with employment opportunities, pension schemes, digital skilling, and states' schemes.

13. Who has launched IFFCO's nano liquid Di-ammonium phosphate (DAP) fertilizer for commercial sale at Rs 600 per 500 ml bottle _____ **Cooperation Minister, Amit Shah.**

Note:

- Aim: Farmers to use nano urea and DAP extensively to make the country self-reliant and reduce import dependence
- One bottle (500 ml) of nano-liquid DAP is equivalent to one bag (50kg) of conventional granular DAP, which is currently being sold at Rs 1,350.
- In 2021, IFFCO launched the world's first nano urea fertilizer.

14. What is the name of the policy, which was approved by the union government to reduce India's heavy import dependence on the medical sector _____ **National Medical Devices Policy, 2023.**

Note:

- It will help the Medical Devices Sector, grow from the present 11 billion USD to 50 billion USD in the next five years.
- It also aims to facilitate orderly growth of the medical device sector to meet the public health objectives of access, affordability, and innovation.
- The Cabinet has also approved establishing 157 nursing colleges

15. Which organization has released a report titled Promoting Millets in Diets: Best Practices across States and Union Territories of India _____ **NITI Aayog.**

Note:

- The report was released by NITI Aayog Vice Chairman Suman K. Bery.
- Report's theme:
- State Missions and initiatives to promote millets;

- Inclusion of millets in ICDS;
 - Research and development and use of technology for innovative practices
 - It will serve as a guiding repository to revive and mainstream millets in our diets.
16. India's first cable-stayed bridge _____ will be completed by May 2023 _____ **Anji Khad bridge.**
- Note:**
- It connects Katra and Reasi via tunnels T2 and T3 on the Katra-Banihal section.
 - Aim: To connect J&K to the rest of the country with all-weather rail connectivity
 - The cables weigh 848.7 MT and the total length of cable strands involved is 653km.
 - The asymmetrical cable-stayed bridge crosses the deep gorges of Anji river, a tributary of river Chenab.
 - Total length of the bridge: 725m
17. Which tribal insurgent group signed the tripartite agreement with the Centre and the state government of Assam to avoid the violence and join the mainstream _____ **Dimasa National Liberation Army (DNLA).**
- Note:**
- According to the MoU, the DNLA will lay down its arms and abide by the Constitution.
 - It was decided to set up a Dimasa Welfare Council and grant a special financial package of Rs. 1,000 crores (Rs. 500 crores each by the Centre and Assam government).
18. Which ministry has launched 'City Beauty Competition' portal _____ **MoHUA.**
- Note:**
- Urban Local Bodies (ULBs) across the country can participate in this competition through an online process.
 - Objective: To encourage and recognize the transformational efforts made by cities and wards across the country to create beautiful, innovative and inclusive public spaces
 - Five broad pillars: (i) accessibility (ii) amenities (iii) activities (iv) aesthetics and (v) ecology
19. Which ministry has given its approval to upgrade Rail Vikas Nigam Limited (RVNL) to Navratna Central Public Sector Enterprise (CPSE) from Category-I Miniratna _____ **Union Finance Ministry.**
