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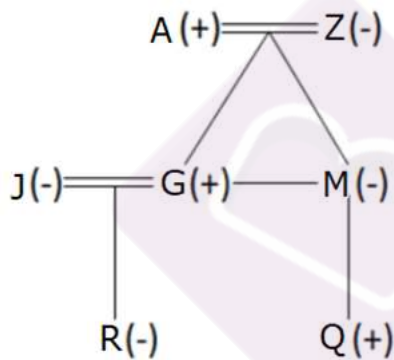

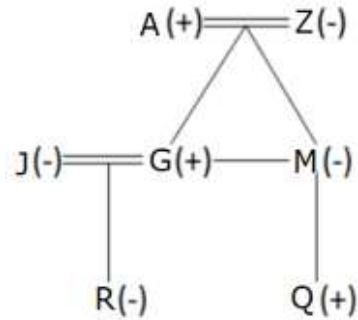

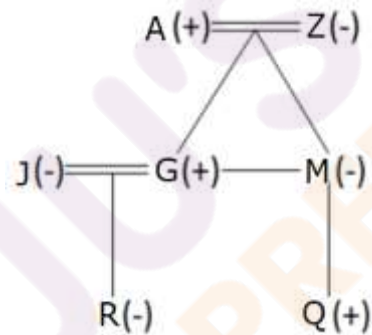

b. There are two types of it – Kari Ishad, which has thinner skin, more pulp and sweeter, and Billy Ishad, which has thicker skin and less pulp and sweetness.

c. Kari ishад is acknowledged as one of the finest quality mangoes due to its unique aroma, delicious taste, high volume of pulp, shape and shape.

d. It is a sign used on products that have a specific geographical origin and have qualities or reputations that are due to that origin. It is commonly used for agricultural products, foods, wine and spirit drinks, handicrafts and industrial products.

e. The Geographical Indications of Goods (Registration and Protection) Act, 1999 aims at registration and better protection of geographical indications relating to goods in India. This GI tag is valid for 10 years after which it can be renewed.

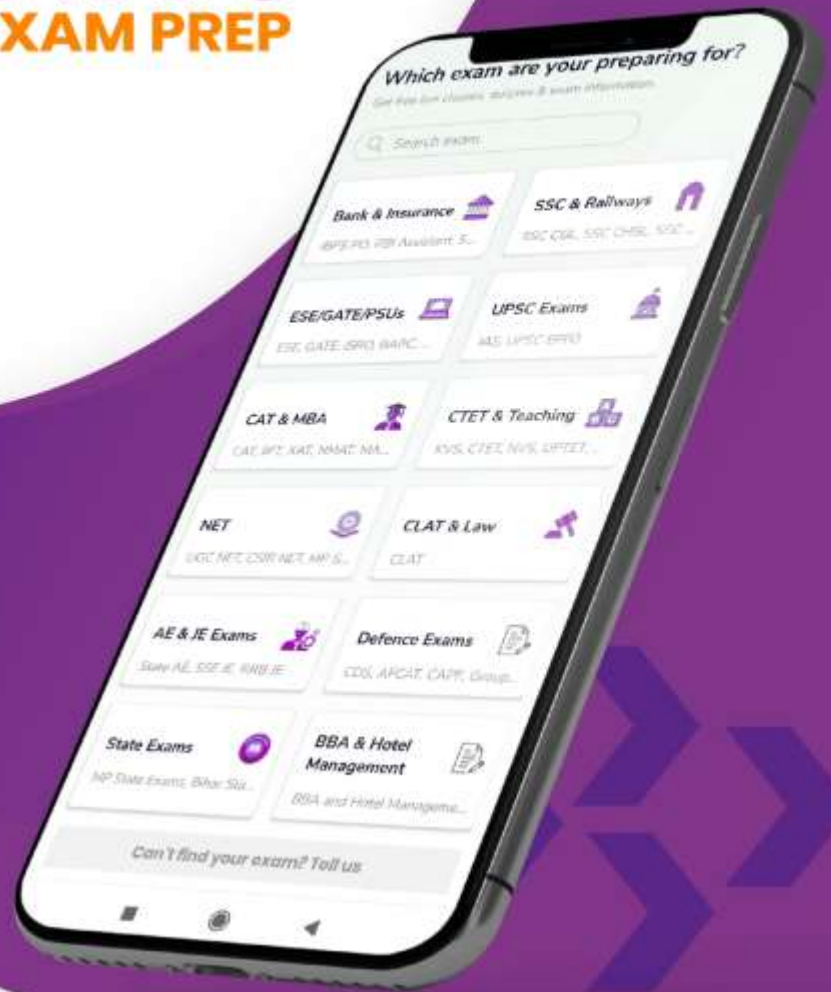
