Banking & Financial Awareness

- Which bank has raised Rs 3,101 crore of funds via additional tier-1, or perpetual, bonds at a coupon of 8.10% _____ State Bank of India.
 - Note:
 - The AT-1 bonds had a base issue of ₹3,000 crore and received total bids worth ₹5,920 crore and also include a call option after 10 years.
 - Perpetual bonds (AT-1 bonds) are considered riskier than other debt instruments, as they can be written down before equity, leading to losses for investors.
- 2. The Insurance Regulatory and Development Authority of India has selected Tata AIG General Insurance as the lead non-life insurer for which Indian state _____ Maharashtra. Note:
 - As lead insurer the company will collaborate with all non-life and health insurance companies in the state to increase insurance penetration.
 - The concept of a lead insurer to increase insurance penetration in the states was developed by the regulator in line with its vision of "Insurance for all by 2047.
- **3.** In July 2023, India and which country are working on a real-time payment mechanism and trading in local currencies _____ Indonesia.

Note:

- Both countries have also discussed the possibility of cooperation in digital technology, payments systems under central banks, and using local currency.
- The two countries launched an Economic and Financial Dialogue that will focus on enhancing bilateral trade and investment, financial services, and infrastructure development, among others.
- An article published by the Reserve Bank of India (RBI) in its July 2023 bulletin stated that India could become a developed country by which year with an average annual real GDP growth of 7.6% over the next 25 years _____ 2047.

- > India must rebalance its economic structure by strengthening its industrial sector
- Agriculture and services would have to grow at 4.9% and 13% per annum, respectively
- > Collaboration between the government, private sector, civil society and citizens is essential.
- Which fintech organization launched the health insurance plans that will for the first time in India offer monthly subscriptions _____ PhonePe Insurance Broking Services.
 Note:
 - Aim: To reduce the burden by breaking down the premium payments into manageable monthly installments









- These insurance plans come with coverage up to one crore rupees, allow users to choose any hospital room.
- Only platform in the country where customers can pay for Insurance in easy installments through UPI on the PhonePe app
- 6. Which bank would set up a new trustee company as its wholly-owned subsidiary for managing the Corporate Debt Market Development Fund _____ SBI.

- > SBI has a 62.53 percent stake in SBI Funds Management Ltd.
- > The fund will act as a safety net to buy high-quality corporate debts when the bond market gets stress.
- > This will make investors feel more secure.
- It will also improve the trading of these debts by setting up a system that can step in and help during tough market situations.
- According to the Asian Development Bank (ADB), what would be India's GDP growth for the FY 2023-24 ______6.4%.

Note:

- **8.** The Asian Development Bank retained India's economic growth forecast at 6.7 per cent for the next FY (2024-25)
 - The ADB noted that the inflation is expected to continue to fall, and is expected to approach its pre-pandemic levels as fuel and food prices decline
 - The bank forecasted 3.6% inflation this year for developing economies in Asia, and 3.4% in 2024
 - India's economy grew by 7.2% in the 2022-23 fiscal ended in March 2023
- 9. The license of United India Co-operative Bank Limited has been revoked by the Reserve Bank of India, located in which Indian city _____ Bijnor.

Note:

- The bank is not allowed to continue its banking operations, which include taking deposits and returning deposits.
- Result: The bank will stop functioning, and all depositors will be eligible to receive up to Rs 5 lakh as a deposit insurance claim from the Deposit Insurance and Credit Guarantee Corporation.
- **10.** Cognizant Technology Solutions in collaboration with which life insurance organization to launch an innovation and development centre in Chennai _____ Max Life Insurance Co. Ltd.

Note:

- Aims: To drive product innovations, enhance customer experiences, and lead operational excellence for Max Life.
- Cognizant will use expertise in consulting and emerging technologies, including artificial intelligence, automation, and cloud transformation to further enhance the digital experience for customers, as per a release.
- **11.** The government approved the interest rate of what percent recommended by the Central Board of Trustees of the Employees' Provident Fund Organisation for 2022-23 _____ **8.15%.**

Note:

> The Ministry of Labour and Employment has conveyed the approval of the Central Government under para 60(1) of Employees' Provident Fund Scheme, 1952 to credit interest@ 8.15 % for







the year 2022-23 to the account of each member of the EPF Scheme as per the provision under para 60 of EPF Scheme,1952.

12. Which fintech firm has launched an 'Income Tax Payment' feature on its app _____ **PhonePe.** Note:

- Aim: To allow taxpayers to pay self-assessment and advance tax directly from the app using UPI or credit card payments
- > To enable this feature, the company has partnered with PayMate, a B2B payments and service provider.
- Users can get a 45-day interest-free period and earn reward points on their tax payments, depending on their bank
- 13. Which bank has been added to the Second Schedule of the RBI Act, 1934 _____ NongHyup Bank. Note:
 - According to the RBI, NongHyup Bank has been officially included in the regulated list through a prior notification issued on June 20, 2023, and published in the Gazette of India.
 - > It is an agricultural bank headquartered in South Korea.
 - > The bank was established in 2012 owned by the NACF.
- 14. Finance Minister Nirmala Sitharaman informed Parliament that during the fiscal year 2022-23, Public Sector Banks (PSBs) extended loans amounting to what amount to state-backed corporations and public sector undertakings _____ ₹4.12 trillion.

Note:

- Canara Bank took the lead in lending ₹187,813 crore to government-backed entities.
- The top five PSBs Canara Bank, State Bank of India, Punjab National Bank, Bank of Baroda, Canara Bank and Union Bank of India.
- **15.** The Reserve Bank of India (RBI) imposed business restrictions on The National Co-operative Bank Ltd and capped deposit withdrawal of what amount per account in July 2023 _____ Rs 50,000. Note:
 - According to the RBI, the bank is not allowed to issue fresh loans or accept fresh deposits without prior approval from the central bank.
 - Depositors will be entitled to receive deposit insurance claim amount up to Rs 5 lakh from the Deposit Insurance and Credit Guarantee Corporation.
- 16. According to the RBI's data during the financial year 2022-23, banks wrote off bad loans amounting to over what amount, contributing to a total loan write-off of Rs 10.57 lakh crore by the banking sector over the past five years _____ Rs 2.09 lakh crore.

Note:

- This loan write-off to bring down gross non-performing assets or defaulted loans to a 10-year low of 3.9 percent of advances by March 2023
- According to RBI, banks have written off a total of Rs 15,31,453 crore since FY2012-13.

17. The International Monetary Fund (IMF) increased its projection for India's GDP growth in the current fiscal year from 5.9% to what percent _____ 6.1%.Note:

As per World Economic Outlook, In 2023 the growth rate of India's economy is estimated to be 6.1 percent, which is 0.2 percentage points higher than what was predicted in April 2023

According to Danish Leigh, the division chief of the Research department at IMF, India contributes one-sixth of the total global growth this year.









- 18. Which organization has entered into a co-lending partnership with HDFC Bank to provide business capital to micro business units operating primarily in rural areas and the unorganized sector across 10 StatesDvara KGFS.
 - Note:

 - This engagement will enhance our capabilities in empowering micro businesses operating in rural areas.
- **19.** Which bank has overtaken State Bank of India (SBI) to earn top spot on the list of 2023 CRISIL's Greenwich market share Leaders in Large Corporate Banking _____ **HDFC Bank.**

- According to Coalition Greenwich many of the gains for large private sector and foreign banks came at the expense of the smaller banks.
- Indian companies are joining forces with the country's largest banks to help fuel their drive to become bigger, more international and more efficient.
- 20. The Reserve Bank has permitted how many banks operating in the country to open 92 Special Rupee Vostro Accounts (SRVAs) of partner banks from 22 countries _____20.

- Aim: To promote bilateral trade in local currencies.
- Minister of State for Commerce and Industry Som Parkash informed that an MoU has been signed between the RBI and the Central Bank of UAE in July 2023
- 21. Which organization has finalized a definitive agreement with Aegon India Holding and Bennett, Coleman & Company Limited to acquire the complete shareholding of the two entities in Aegon Life Insurance Company Limited _____Bandhan Financial Holdings Limited.
 Note:
 - Upon completion, this strategic move will not only expand Bandhan Financial Holdings' presence in the banking and mutual fund sectors but also mark its entry into the country's life insurance sector, according to the company's statement
- **22.** Which fintech organization has introduced the MoneySaver Export Account(MSEA), catering specifically to Indian exporters _____ **Razorpay.**

- The account enables Indian exporters to open a smart account in their preferred foreign country, facilitating local receipt of payments through bank transfers on the Razorpay platform.
- Aims: To alleviate the burden of high transfer costs, chargebacks, and payment failures, making it a valuable asset for exporters.
- 23. According to the RBI's index measuring the adoption of online transactions, digital payments in the country witnessed a year-on-year growth of what percent until March 2023 _____ 13.24%.
 Note:
 - The RBI's Digital Payments Index (RBI-DPI) showed a rise from 377.46 in September 2022 and 349.30 in March 2022 to 395.57 by the end of March 2023.
 - > The increase in the RBI-DPI index across all parameters indicates substantial growth in payment infrastructure.

Note:

- Aims: To establish a Digital Bank equipped with state-of-the-art capabilities, focusing on omnichannel experiences and data-driven hyper-personalization
- Objective: To enable smooth digital journeys, offering customers unmatched convenience and efficiency.
- 25. Which bank's report predicts that India is on track to become the world's third-largest economy by FY28SBI Ecowrap.

Note:

- There is a growing agreement among experts that India's GDP in Q1FY24 is set to exceed 8%, leading to a GDP growth rate surpassing 6.5% in FY24.
- The incremental increase in India's economy between 2022 and 2027 is greater than the entire current size of Australia's economy, which stands at \$1.8 trillion.
- 26. Name the world's largest asset manager that teaming up with Mukesh Ambani-led Jio Financial Services (JFS) to enter India's asset management sector ______ BlackRock.

- As per RBI norms, any entity looking to acquire over 5 per cent stake in a bank needs to seek prior approval from the regulator.
- The Mahindra group is in the financial services sector primarily through its arm Mahindra & Mahindra Financial Services a non-banking finance company.

Note:

- > Petrapole is the major land port for bilateral trade with the neighboring country.
- > The Indian government has been promoting Rupee trade with several countries to reduce dependence on the US Dollar and strengthen regional currency and trade.
- According to Kamlesh Saini, the manager of the Land Ports Authority of India the value of the shipment is Rs 1.23 crore.

 - ▶ He later went on to win 11 consecutive polls.
 - He represented the Puthupally assembly constituency and was the longest-serving MLA in the state assembly.

 - ICC cannot be a substitute for the national courts but is available when a country cannot perform investigations.
- 3. World Brain Day is celebrated globally on which date every year to promote education, research, and support for individuals affected by brain-related conditions _____ July 22. Note:

> World Brain Day's 2023 theme is "Brain Health and Disability: Leave No One Behind."

- > The World Federation of Neurology (WFN) was founded on July 22, 1957.
- > This international movement strives to close the information gap and increase public awareness of impairments to brain health.


