SSC JE eligibility criteria are declared by the exam conducting body in the official notification. Candidates who fulfill the eligibility criteria prescribed by the commission can only apply for the exam. A candidate who is satisfying the age limit, educational qualification, nationality, etc. mentioned in the SSC JE eligibility will be considered eligible.

Candidates who are in their final year can apply but only if they have acquired the required educational qualification or experience on or before 2 September 2023. If a candidate fails to fulfill the SSC JE Eligibility 2023 at any point of time in the recruitment process, his/her candidature will be cancelled. So, they should read the notification carefully.

Eligibility 2023 consists of the essential SSC JE specified by the Staff Selection parameters Commission (SSC) in the official notification. Candidates who are going to appear in SSC JE 2023 must go through the information carefully to know the detailed eligibility criteria.

SSC JE Qualification

The minimum educational qualification for SSC JE civil/ mechanical/ electrical is a diploma or B.Tech degree in the relevant fields. Candidates must have obtained their degree certificates on or before 2 September 2023 to fill SSC JE application form.

If a candidate fails to submit the relevant documents on or before the due date, he/she will be debarred from the recruitment process. Check SSC JE Educational Qualification for all the organizations below:

Percentage Required for SSC JE

As per SSC JE eligibility, there is no percentage criteria that candidates must meet in order to apply for the exam. Candidates should only ensure that they have completed their course and obtained their degree/diploma certificate. The officials have not set any percentage limit in SSC JE eligibility.

SSC JE Age Limit 2023

The age limit for SSC JE is between 30 and 32 years, depending on the position applied for as on 1 January 2023. Candidates should be aware that the upper age limit varies depending on the position and department/organization they are applying for. The following table gives the details of SSC JE age limit for various posts and departments.

SSC JE Age Relaxation

SSC JE age relaxation is decided and is applicable as per the government of India guidelines. It varies for different categories so, aspirants must check it











carefully. Candidates can check the category-wise SSC JE age relaxation in the table below:

Category	Relaxation
Scheduled Caste/ Scheduled Tribe	5 years
Other Backward Caste	3 years
Persons with Disabilities (PwD)	10 years
PwD + OBC	13 years
PwD + SC/ST	15 years
Ex-Servicemen	3 years after the deduction of the military service rendered from the actual age
Defence Personnel disabled in operation during hostilities with any foreign country or in a disturbed area and released as a consequence thereof.	3 years
Defence Personnel disabled in operation during hostilities with any foreign country or in a disturbed area and released as a consequence thereof (SC/ST).	8 years

SSC JE Nationality

Candidates must check the national section before submitting the application form. They must satisfy any of the SSC JE nationality clauses provided below:

- Either a citizen of India or a subject of Nepal or Bhutan.
- A Tibetan refugee came to India before 1 January 1962 to stay permanently in India.
- An Indian who migrated from Pakistan, Burma, Sri Lanka, East African countries of Kenya, Uganda, the United Republic of Tanzania, Zambia, Malawi, Zaire, Ethiopia, and Vietnam to permanently settle in India.
- A candidate shall be a person in whose favor a certificate of eligibility has been issued by the Government of India.
- An applicant for whom a certificate of eligibility is required may be admitted to the examination, but the offer of employment will not be made until the applicant has received the required eligibility certificate from the Government of India.

Key Points related to SSC JE Eligibility 2023

Candidates are provided with some important information regarding SSC JE eligibility criteria. They











must be aware of the following points to prevent any problem during the recruitment process.

- All the candidates must note that the candidates should not have more than one living wife or more than one husband when he/she is already married. Such marriage will be accepted under personal law only.
- Only male candidates can apply for the post of Junior Engineer in the Border Roads Organization (BRO).
- The date of birth entered by the candidate in the online application form and the date of birth as entered in the Matriculation/Secondary Examination Certificate will be accepted by the Commission for determining the age, and no subsequent request for its modification will be considered or permitted. will be given.
- Candidates seeking appointment on the basis of reservation to SC/ST/OBC/EWS/PwD, etc. must have a caste/community certificate.
